Proposal for approval of ₹ 192.75 crore towards construction of Critical Care Hospital Block (CCHB) at AIIMS Bhubaneswar

The subject matter was deliberated and SFC approved the proposal of revised estimate of ₹ 192.75 crore (₹ 132.75 crore for Engineering Infrastructure + ₹ 60 crore for Medical Equipment & Furniture) towards construction of the Critical Care Hospital Block (CCHB) at AIIMS Bhubaneswar for which Rs. 120 cr will be provisioned under the PM-ABHIM and 72 cr. from Grant in Aid Capital Head of the Institute.

SFC also ratified the Preliminary Estimate in favour of CPWD amounting to ₹ 132.75 crore for the CCHB Project since MoU was signed with CPWD prior to this SFC for expediting the process of construction CCHB.

Chairman emphasised that the construction of Critical Care Block was a top priority item and therefore it should be regularly monitored. The Unit should be appropriately integrated with the existing Emergency/Trauma facilities available in the Insitute. It was informed that the tender for the work will be awarded by first week of March 2023. chairman emphasised that after award of the work the Institute should raise the demand for release of the second installment.

Proposal for procurement of Medical Equipment for the Department of General Surgery at an estimated cost of ₹ 8.20 crore

In view of the justification provided by the Director, keeping in view increase in

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the patient load and availability of sufficient faculty, SFC approved the proposal for procurement of 02 nos. of 4K Laparoscopy Surgery System at an estimated cost of ₹ 6.02 crore excluding GST. The Institute was directed to undertake the procurement through the GEM portal and ensure adherence to all GFRs and other rules in place on the subject while undertaking the procurement. It was also advised that the specifications of the machines should be broad based so as to encourage competition and get better rates.

As regards procurement of 01 no. of Laparoscopic Simulator, the agenda was withdrawn by the Institute. SFC suggested that AIIMS Bhubaneswar can plan to set up of an Integrated Avance Skill Lab instead of procuring machines randomly for training purpose.

Proposal for approval to enhancement of Stipend of B.Sc. Nursing Students for last 06 months of Final Year from ₹ 500/- to ₹ 13,150/- per month

The proposal for enhancement of Stipend of B.Sc. Nursing Students for last 06 months of Final Year (Internship) from ₹ 500/- per month to ₹ 13,150/- per month in accordance with the Order NoA-11013/07/2019-NDated06/07/2022 of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare was approved by SFC.

While payment of stipend during internship is justified, SFC advised that the PMSSY Division should take up the issue of payment of Rs 500 per month of stipend to all students of BSc Nursing with the concerned Division of the Ministry to re ascertain the justification for payment of the same in the present times. The issue should be also placed before the CIB.

DGHS advised that the Institute can start with Cadaveric Liver Transplantation. Once the team gains sufficient experience the procedure can be carried out independently.
