Shri S. M. Routray, Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India attended the meeting as a representative of Secretary, MoH&FW,Govt. of India. Dr. S. C. Mahapatra, Dean, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, Prof. Sachidanand Mohanty, Medical Superintendent, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar & Shri P. K. Ray, Dy. Director (Admin.), AIIMS, Bhubaneswar attended the

Prof. Gitanjali Batmanabane, Director, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar and Member-Secretary of the Institute Body welcomed Hon'ble President of the Institute Body to preside over the 5th meeting

The President called the meeting to order. It was noted that the quorum was complete. Thereafter, with permission from the President, the Member-Secretary gave a presentation on the different activities undertaken by the Institute since the last meeting of the IB. All the members of the IB as present have appreciated the developments of the Institute and expressed their satisfaction that Institute is doing well. Some of the members have made the following

Prof. Samir Kumar Brahmachari, Former DG, CSIR & Secretary, DSIR, Govt of India: -1. AIIMS Bhubaneswar must have a Unique Selling Proposition (USP) which must be different from the other AIIMS including AIIMS New Delhi. The institute should try to create and maintain a USP for which it will be known and respected. Prof. Brahmachari said that the we should take advantage of the large number of patients coming to our hospital and use their hospital health information and biological samples for research purposes. Stating that "data is the new oil" he urged the Director to print a consent in the OPD ticket as well as the IPD ticket which would state that the patient permits the institute to use his/her information and samples for research after following international ethical criteria and norms. This he said would permit researchers to conduct research in various areas relevant to the population of the region. He also urged the use of Hospital Infection data as the metrics by which each ward, OT and ICU will be assessed. This information on a daily basis will be a very powerful tool to gauge the performance of the hospital.

He also encouraged the institute to have an integrated Electronic Medical Records (EMR) by joining hands with IIT or NIT and have the data in the cloud as it would permit patients to use their data at any time if they needed it. He also said that numerous start-ups were providing these services which will be cost-effective as well as in keeping with the Make in India theme. Under the same theme, he said a repository of Digital Health should be started under a Dept. of Health Informatics which should be set-up at AIIMS Bhubaneswar.

Prof. Brahmachari said the institute should go in for bio-banking of tissues and stem cells. The Director informed him that a skin bank was coming up in the new Burns' Unit and that the SFC had approved funds for biobanking under the Centre of Excellence for Clinical Microbiome

Research. He also said that at the present time, there were about 7 conditions for which US FDA had approved the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI), and that we should use it. He said AI was being used to a large extent in Digital Ophthalmology and we should try and start with that. Prof. Brahmachari also said that genomics has substantially contributed to the practice of anesthesia and cancer treatment and that clinicians must take advantage of the advances in this field while managing patients. He urged us to use the "P4H Health Continuum mode" that is predictive, preventive, personalized and participatory, which can reduce the burden of chronic diseases by harnessing technology and an increasingly better understanding of environment-biology interactions, evidence-based interventions and the underlying mechanisms of chronic diseases.

Prof. Brahmachari urged that we should plan to establish a School of Integrated Biology, since specialties and basic sciences can no longer work in isolation. This would be a very futuristic school which would put the institution on a higher pedestal.

- 2. Dr. Rajiv Garg, DGHS, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India: The DGHS has appreciated the developments and achievements of the Institutes which he termed as commendable in a short of time. He stated that the Institute is shaping up in right direction and very soon it will be one of the best institutes in India.
- 3. Shri Anubhav Mohanty, Hon'ble MP (Lok Sabha): Shri Mohanty stated that the AIIMS Hospital is truly serving the health care needs of the people of Odisha. He praised the level of patient care by the doctors and Nursing Staff of AIIMS Bhubaneswar. He has volunteered to use his MP-LAD fund for further development of the Casualty Department.
- 4. **Prof. Madhusudan Chakraborty, Former Director, IIT, Bhubaneswar:** Prof. Chakraborty has stated that he has been involved with the Institute as a member of IB from the beginning and expressed his appreciation for the quick development of the Institute.
- 5. Dr. K. Jagadeesan, Founder Chairman & Chief Surgeon, K. J. Hospital Research & Post Graduate Centre, Chennai: Dr. K. Jagadeesan said he was happy with the progress of the institution. He said that every newborn baby at the hospital and its centers should be tested for inborn errors of metabolism. He said that biochemical tests as well as genetic testing was inexpensive and if each newborn was tested at birth and any defect was detected, treatment in the form of life-style modifications to diet, or medications if necessary could be started early on, potentially saving large sums of money if it were to be detected later on.
