AIIMS FIGHTING AGAINST NEONATAL MORTALITY IN COLLABORATION WITH GOVERNMENT OF ODISHA AND UNICEF

Milestone achieved from January to July 2017:- Department of community and family medicine has Implemented project titled-"Techno-managerial Support and Capacity Building of Facility and Community Level Stakeholders for the Implementation of India New-Born Action Plan (INAP), integrated Action Plan against Pneumonia and Diarrhoea (IAPPD) and New Maternal Health (MH Guideline)" in collaboration with Government of Odisha and UNICEF in 17 districts of Odisha . 52 training sessions have been conducted from Jan 2017 to July 2017 in 16 Districts of Odisha till date. 1515 participants have been trained under this program which includes district level officials (CDMO,ADMO, District Level Staff, Medical Officer, Staff Nurses, Health Workers & CDPO). These training were conducted by recourse persons from AIIMS Bhubaneswar (department of CM & FM,OBG, paediatrics and Neonatology) with support from state government officials and faculty from various government and private medical colleges.
