

## **Induction Training Programme at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar**

Department of Community Medicine and Family Medicine has organised an induction training programme for medical officers appointed under Odisha Public Service Commission. These sessions were chaired by faculty members from the Department of CM&FM. Group discussions to enhance participatory approach were also promoted in the training programme.
