Subject: Revision of tuition fee for the undergraduate programmes

Sir,

With a view to further strengthen the IITs, Chairperson of IIT Council, after examining the report of the Committee on funding of IITs and the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the IIT Council (SCIC) for revision of tuition fee in IITs, has approved revision of tuition fee in the IITs to Rs. 2 lakh a year from the academic year 2016-17, subject to the following for protecting the interests of the socially and economically backward students:

a) The SC/ST/PH students shall get complete fee waiver.

b) The most economically backward students (whose family income is less than Rs. 1 lakh per annum) shall get full remission of the fee.

- c) The other economically backward students (whose family income is between Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 5 lakh per annum) shall get remission of 2/3rd of the fee,
- d) All students shall have access to interest free loan under the Vidyalaxmi scheme for the total portion of the tuition fee payable.
- Further, all IITs are requested to utilize funds accrued through the increased student fee for the purpose of building good quality infrastructure with the assistance of the Higher Education Funding Agency (HEFA).
- The Directors of all IITs are requested to take action accordingly.

Revision of fees in the National Institutes of Technology Subject:-(NITs) as per decision of the Council of NITs.

With a view to further strengthen the National Institutes of Technology (NITs), the Council of HITs in its 9th meeting held on 1st October, 2015 deliberated on the proposal of adopting a funding mechanism for creation of Capital Assets, Research Grants and covering of recurring expenditure through enhancement of fees of students. The Council after detailed deliberation unanimously decided to enhance the ruition fee being charged by the NITs from existing ₹70,000/- to ₹1,25,000/- per student per annum from the ensuing academic year.

The Chairperson of the Council of NITs has approved revision of tuition fee in the NITs to \$1,25,000/ per student per annum from the academic year 2016 - 2017, subject to the following for protecting the interests of the socially and economically backward students:-

The SC / ST / PH students shall, or complete fee waiver

The most economically backward students (whose family income is less (b) than ₹1.00 lakh per annum) small get full remission of the fee.

The other economically backward students (whose family income is (0) between ₹1.00 lakh to ₹5.00 bid; per annum) shall get remission of 2/3rd of the fac.

The revised fee would be spot which for students taking admission (d) starting from academic year 10:6 - 2017 onwards. The students currently studying, got admitted prior to academic session 2016 -2017 would continue to pay the assisting rates. ..contd./-

- 3. The revision of fee is in accordance with provisions under Section 32 (2) (b) of National Institutes of Technology, Science Education and Research Act, 2007 and 37 (i) of the First Statutes, which empowers the Council to determine the fees which shall be common for all NITs.
- 4. The NITs are requested to enarge the common fee as per recommendations of the Council of NITs from the academic year 2016 2017.
- 5. This issues with the approval of the competent authority.

Waiver of Tuition fee for SC/ST students in 30 NITs - regarding

Sir / Madam,

This Ministry is in receipt of several requests received from many National institutes of Technology (NiTs) regarding waiver of tultion fee for SC/ST students of UG/PG/Research Scholar.

- 2. In this regard, MHRD letter no.F.23 1/2002.TS I dated 11th March, 2003 (copy enclosed), wherein para3 (f) specifically mentioned that the tuition fee for both post graduate (including final year students of dual degree programs) and research students in the IITs be reduced to Rs.5000 per annum with no provision for waiver except 100% waiver for SC/ST scholars. The same was also be applicable to NITs to ensure student of weaker section were participating in the enrolment in the Higher Studies and Research to reduce the gap in the shortage of faculty and also increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio percentage.
- 3. This Ministry vide its letter no F 21 35/2009.TS III dated 23.06.2009 (copy enclosed) has further directed all NITs that there will be no change in the existing exemptions to tuition fee for SC/ST students. Thereafter, Director of all newly established NITs was also instructed to ensure the strict compliance of aforesaid Ministry's letter and take necessary action accordingly.
- It was also reiterated in the recent Ministry's order dated 05.05.2014 (copy enclosed) that there will be no change in the existing exemptions to tuition fee for SC/ST students.
- 5. It is therefore, requested to take necessary action and ensure strict compliance of above Ministry's direction.
