3. Mere fulfilling the essential qualification/experience does not guarantee selection.
4. Candidates employed in Govt. Service/Semi-Govt. Autonomous Bodies of State/Central Govt. should submit a "No Objection Certificate" from their employer.
5. Above post is contractual for the duration offered may or may not be renewed subject to satisfactory performance and requirement.
6. Age will be reckoned from last date of receipt of application.
