


Department of Community Medicine and Family Medicine: Epidemic Management Training Program (EMTP)

EMTP was conducted by the department in collaboration with SIHFW, Odisha from 3rd to 6th April 2018. (Batch 8) and from 30th May to 2nd June. The 8th batch was attended by 17 (seventeen) medical officers and 9th batch was attended by 13 medical officers from different districts of Odisha. The medical officers were trained in standard operating procedures (SOPs) for different disease as well as specific measures to control the spreading the population. A hands-on training on various diagnostic techniques like interpretation of ECG and spirometry was taught. Each EMTP course is of four days duration wherein 2 days are allotted for management of infectious diseases with epidemic potentials and 2 days for management of modern day epidemics (NCDs). New sessions on primary care management of stroke, interpretation of common radiological findings and first hand exposure of imaging in nuclear medicine was introduced for the first time for 9th batch of EMTP training.

The courses are conducted under the leadership and guidance of Course Director, Prof (Dr.) Vikas Bhatia, Dean, Professor and Head, Department of Community Medicine and Family Medicine, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. Various resource persons for conducting training sessions are invited from Dept. of Community Medicine and Family Medicine, Cardiology, Internal Medicine, Neurology, Pulmonary Medicine, Psychiatry etc. at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.



Another round of EMTP was conducted from 30th May to 2nd June 2018 which was attended by 13 medical officers from all over Odisha.

Hypertension and Diabetes Screening Camp in Biju Patnaik Open Air Ashram, Jamujhari, Khurdha

On 11th May, the “Screening camp for NCDs” was conducted in the Biju Patnaik Open Air Ashram by CMFM department of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. All the prisoners (approximately 100) were screened for NCDs. The positive patients were referred to CHC Medhashal to avail medicine free of cost. They also received behavioural counselling about “How to prevent NCDs”. Dr Manish Taywade (Assistant Professor, CMFM) and Dr. Priyamadhaba Behera (Senior Resident, CMFM) participated in this camp.

Kandhamal is an inaccessible and the tribal district contributing majority of diarrhoea cases in Odisha. In discussion with state govt. of Odisha and UNICEF, Community Medicine and Family Medicine department of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar provided the technical support for Intensified Diarrhoea Control Month (IDCM)- 2018 in Kandhamal district of Odisha. IDCM consists of a set of activities to be implemented in an intensified manner from 20st June to 19th July 2018 for prevention and control of deaths due to diarrhoea across the state. These activities mainly include intensification of advocacy & awareness generation activities for diarrhoea management, strengthening service provision for diarrhoea case management, establishment of ORS-Zinc corners, prepositioning of ORS by ASHA in households with under-five children and awareness generation activities for hygiene and sanitation. The planning of the program was done with discussion with district authorities (CDMO, DPM, ADMOFW etc.), the training of Medical officers (MOs), Health Supervisors (HS), Health Worker Female (HWF) and ASHA sathi were conducted during 5th-9th June, 2018. District level orientation meeting for IDCM was held on 12th June, 2018 at Sadbhabana, Sabhagruha, collectorate, Phulbani under the chairmanship of the district magistrate, Kandhamal. This program was successful under guidance of Dr. Vikas Bhatia (Head of Department, CMFM) and Dr. Arvind Kumar Singh (Assistant Professor, CMFM).




