It is the time for the new July-Sept 2013 issue of the Dhauli. It has been a very eventful period. On 15th Jul we celebrated our 1st Foundation day, His Excellency Governor of Odisha, Dr. SC Jamir was the Chief Guest and Mr Sanjay Kumar Srivastava, IAS, AS and FA, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt of India, was the Guest of Honour. Blood donation camp and tree plantation were done to commemorate the event. His Excellency Governor of Odisha also presented the best student and the best teacher awards. On 20th July, Institute organized a CME on 'Role of Ethics in Biomedical Research'. It was inaugurated by Dr. VM Katoch, Secretary, DHSR and DG ICMR. There were 5 guest speakers Prof. YK Gupta and Prof.Renu Saxena from AIIMS, New Delhi, and Prof RN Mishra from SGPGI, Dr. Sauren Das from Delhi and Prof. Siddharth Dash from SCB Medical College, Cuttack. Over 80 delegates participated. On 06th August we organized a half day symposium on Organ and Body Donation. On 11th August a cadaver dissection workshop was organized by Neurosurgery and Anatomy departments. Two guest faculty, Dr.Sumit Sinha, Addl Prof. AIIMS, New Delhi, and Dr. RK Mishra, from Lucknow, conducted the workshop. On 17th August we had one day symposium on Palliative Care, Prof Sushama Bhatnagar from AIIMS, New Delhi, was the guest faculty and Prof Sukdev Nayak was the organizing Chairman.

In August 100 medical students 2013 batch, joined after three rounds of counselling at Delhi between July and August. AIIMS, Bhubaneswar was a favorable destination after AIIMS, New Delhi. In Sept 60 B.Sc. (Hon) Nursing students joined the Institute and with that the total students' strength in our campus became 210. For MBBS 2013 batch student, orientation programme was conducted from 12-16th August and for the Nursing student, Orientation programme was from 4-6th Sept 2013.

On 20-21st Sept the 1st Annual Day function was celebrated. Day one was started by Scientific Programme from 09.00AM to 03.00 PM followed by inauguration at 06.30PM. Mr Sanjay Kumar Srivastava, IAS, AS&FA, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, was the Chief Guest and Prof AK Banerji, Former chief of Neuroscience Centre AIIMS, New Delhi, was the Guest of Honour. Sri. Sandeep Kumar Nayak, IAS, Joint Secretary also attended the celebrations. There were debate, music and rangoli competitions among the 5 medical college students of twin cities. During inauguration, gold medals were awarded to the students securing highest mark in 1st MBBS examination, July 2013, Prof JM Senapati and Sri NK Mahapatra gold medal award to students securing highest mark in Physiology and Biochemistry respectively. Director's Gold Medal was awarded to the student securing highest marks in 1st MBBS Professional Examination. 10 students




got Honours for securing 75% mark in various subjects. Inaugural function was followed by 2 hours of cultural programme, organized by the students and the faculty of the Institute. Overall the annual function was a great success.

During this period ground floor with 4 lecture theaters were taken to possession. Nursing college started in Sept and ground floor containing the mini auditorium complex and 1st floor with faculty room, lab and lecture theatre were taken to possession. Also during these 3 months guest house and dining hall was completed and taken over. Faculty and Students are having their food in new Dining Hall, since Sept 2013.

Between July and Sept, our new OPD started with 300-450 patients attending our Out Patient Clinic daily. Afternoon clinic for specialized problems started from August 2013. Brig AP Mohanty joined as Medical Superintendent on 1st Jul 2013 and Mr. Ravindra Pattar joined as Financial Advisor on 1st August 2013. During this period we have placed order for over 25 Crore equipments, which are under procurement and installation. Thus, over last 3 months from July till Sept 2013 we had a lot of activities in campus, including 1st MBBS Examinations, joining of two batches of new students, celebration of our 1st Foundation Day and 1st Annual Day. We also conducted 5 different scientific conferences. Thus, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, is progressing inch by inch over last 1 year. I thank our faculty, students, officers and employee for their significant contribution for the growth and development of the Institute.

MESSAGE

It gives me great pleasure to write for the quarterly news letter of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhubaneswar. As the first Medical Superintendent of this apex health institute I feel proud and am aware that the clientele has a high expectation for better health care of this part of eastern India.

In a short span of just over a year the AIIMS hospital has been able to provide OPD services which has swollen to 300-450 patients per day. Around fourteen departments are functioning in the OPD including some super speciality afternoon clinics. Various medical equipments are already installed and started functioning like digital X-ray, ultrasound, blood counters, autorefractometer, optical coherence tomography, polysomnography, lung spirometry, ECG etc. A day care centre for providing chemotherapy drugs to cancer patients is functioning already. The hospital will start the indoor facility shortly and will also have casualty services and three operation theatres functioning, initially and the expansion will be continuous.

I sincerely hope, the faculties and paramedical staffs will deliver their best in keeping the standard of AIIMS and try to fulfil the aspirations of the patients and their relatives.

Introduction to AIIMS Finance

AIIMS Bhubaneswar has been established by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare under PMSSY to become a centre of excellence to provide state of the art, health care facilities in the state and the region. The Ministry of Health is constantly supporting with the funds as grants-in-aid to the Institute under plan scheme.

AIIMS Bhubaneswar receives funds under the head of account grants-in-aid general (410031), grants-in-aid for creation of capital assets (410035) and grants-in-aid salaries (410036). The grants-in-aid so received are to be utilized based on certain set of principles in the form of General Financial Rules (GFR). The rules from 206 to 215 of GFR 2005 details about the provision, utilisation and accounting of grants-in-aid received from Govt. of India.

It is pertinent to mention that the accounts for the financial year 2012-13 have already been prepared and the audit of the same is in progress. It is the constant endeavour of the Institute that general financial rules are complied in letter and spirit during utilisation of the funds received from Govt. of India.

Initially expenditure was sluggish. However, it is picking up pace with various developmental activities being under taken including recruitment of faculties etc. The budget for the year 2013-14 is approximately Rs.60 Crores.

As AIIMS Bhubaneswar is committed to start 200 – 250 bedded Hospital by Jan 2014, many tenders for procurement of equipments, consumables and services have been floated for operationalisation of IPD activities. It is worthwhile to mention that under minimum operational requirements, 109 items tendered amounting to Rs. 21.98 Crores are under process and tenders based on the repeat order of institutions of national importance amounting to 16.46 Crores are also in the process of procurement.

Apart from this, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare is also supplying equipments through central procurement by M/s HLL who is a procurement support agent. Whatever the case may be such procurement of goods & services are done on the principle of efficiency, economy & transparency by fair and equitable treatment by suppliers and promotion of public procurement.

In spite of shortage of staff, the departments are striving to put all out efforts to start IPD activities in time. It is constant endeavour of the Finance Section to resolve financial issues as early as possible to realise the primary objective of AIIMS Bhubaneswar to provide state of art of health care to the people.

Construction of AIIMS Bhubaneswar and it's Sub-Systems

Construction of AIIMS Bhubaneswar is in progress. Since starting of Medical College with few rooms in college building in Sep 2012, a number of floors, buildings have been put to use. These are mainly four floors of medical college building, ground floor with lecture theatre in ground floor of administrative building. The independent day function was celebrated in the courtyard of the administrative building. Similarly the ground and first floor of nursing college building has been used and annual day function with a lot of joy was celebrated in the new mini-auditorium complex in the ground floor. In OPD block of hospital building ground floor of B and C block has also been put to use and OPD is running there since Sept 2013. Gradually other areas of building like laboratories, blood bank, other floors of OPD and even IPD are in various stages of completion and will be made operational very soon. Similarly in housing side Director's bungalow, guest house has been taken over. The new Dining hall has also been in use. Two floors of PG-II hostel has been occupied and nursing students are staying there.

During last one year even without any basic maintenance staff like plumber, electrician, beldar and khalasi engineers are looking after day to day maintenance to avoid any inconvenience to the occupants along with their original assignment i.e main construction work and are putting their best effort in the making of the institute.

In the building after civil construction services play a great role for optimal function of the building. AIIMS being predominately a hospital building following services are planned and are being executed. The execution of services need a high level of coordination and supervision as most of the services are interdependent.

Mainly following major services are planned for:

- Water Supply
- Sewerage disposal system
- Electrical System
- Telephone system
- LAN system
- Hot water system
- Air Conditioning system
- Solar Power system
- Fire-fighting system
- Fire alarm system
- Irrigation system
- CCTV system

In future issues details of each sub-system will be provided to appreciate the task in the hands of the engineering unit.



20th July 2013: A CME on "Ethics in Clinical Research" was organised by AIIMS Bhubaneswar

CME on "Ethics in Clinical Research" was organised by AIIMS Bhubaneswar on 20th July, 2013. The theme of the CME was to spread awareness regarding ethics in practice and research among medical professionals. Prof. V.M. Katoch, Director General, ICMR, and secretary Research Cell, Govt. of India was invited as Chief Guest. Prof. P.K. Sahoo, Vice Chancellor, Utkal University also graced the occasion. Invited speakers were Dr. Renu Saxena, Dr. Y.K. Gupta, Dr. S.C. Dash, Dr. S. Kar, Dr. Siddharth Das and Dr. Sauren Das. The CME covered various topics related to medical ethics which included ethics in medical research, role of ethical committee, History of medical ethics, drug development and trials, good clinical practice, ethics in clinical trials and patenting, medical negligence, community based research and writing of research paper.

Prof.A.K.Mahapatra, Director, Dr.Ambika Prasad Mohanty, Medical Superintendent and members of the faculty, AIIMS, BBSR, discussed various aspects of organ transplantation like the Kidney, Cornea, Heart, Lungs and Liver. Dr.Chandamoyee Mohanty, Professor and Head, Department of Anatomy, AIIMS, BBSR, elaborately discussed about body donation. OPD Block shifted to B&C Block in the ground floor of Main Hospital Building



After running for a couple of months from a temporary building in the campus, the OPD block aptly shifted to its original block in the main hospital building of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar . Regular OPD services are now being provided in the disciplines of Neurosurgery, General surgery, General Medicine, Eye, ENT, Pulmonary Medicine, Skin & VD, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Orthopaedics, Paediatrics and Paediatric Surgery, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Psychiatry. Immunization, pathological investigations Ultrasonography, Cardiotocography and ECG are presently being done in the OPD in regular basis.

Activities of the Department of Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation (PMR)



The Dept of PMR is functioning since April 2013 and has experienced and qualified specialists. Daily OPD in PMR caters services to about 40 to 50 patients with physical disabilities, deformity correction, plaster work, minor surgeries, rehabilitation services like Physio and Occupational therapy. A well-equipped Physiotherapy Section under PMR was established on 24th July 2013. Patients with back and neck pain, musculo-skeletal disorders, joint stiffness, neurological problems and paralytic patients are treated here by mobilization exercises and strengthening of muscle power by modern machineries and trained Physiotherapist with equipment

like Short-wave diathermy, Interferential Therapy (IFT), Long wave diathermy, Ultrasound therapy, Transcutaneous Electrical Nerve Stimulation (TENS) and Laser therapy. Daily attendance in Physiotherapy reaches about 40 to 50 patients at present.



Activities of the Department of Pulmonary Medicine

The Dept of Pulmonary Medicine is functional since Apr 2013 and has one Professor and two Assistant Professors as faculties. They are treating all cases coming to OPD daily. Besides treating Tuberculosis and Asthma cases they are also running a sleep clinic and lung cancer clinic in afternoon. The department is having a spirometry machine for lung function tests, a polysomnography for sleep studies. Other equipments like videos bronchoscope will be procured shortly. A DOTS Centre for free distribution of Anti-tubercular drugs will open shortly.

Activities of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology

The Department have turn out of around 750 to 800 patients monthly in Obstetrics and Gynaecology OPD. It is running bi-weekly speciality clinics for high risk pregnancy and infertility in the afternoons. This OPD is providing antenatal care services and gynaecological consultations. As a part of high risk pregnancy management, antenatal fetal monitoring using cardiotocography (Fig. 1) and fetal growth monitoring using doppler ultrasonography is being provided (Fig. 2). In infertility clinic patients are benefited by ovulation induction followed by follicular growth monitoring with transvaginal ultrasonography. In gynaecological OPD patients are offered services with regard to cervical cancer screening using high definition digital video colposcope. Cancer patients are getting multidisciplinary care from day care radiotherapy/chemotherapy department along with gynaecological follow up.

Activities of the Department of Radio-Diagnosis

The Department of Radio-Diagnosis has two senior faculties. Besides having ultrasound machine, the dept has just installed a portable X-ray machine and a digital X-ray (Digital Radiography - DR) machine. The digital X-ray machine has superior resolution compared to both conventional radiographs and Computed Radiography (CR) systems, and the digital image can be transmitted to the specialists on line for reporting. Other imaging modalities like CT scan, MRI and high-end (3D/4D) Ultrasound machine are in the supply pipe-line.

Activities of the Department of Ophthalmology

The Dept of Ophthalmology, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar has been functioning since April 2013, and has been running a very busy outpatient. The routine comprehensive eye care examinations are met with modern instruments like autokeratonefractometer (ARK) and non-contact tonometer (NCT) to rule out refractive errors and for screening of glaucoma suspects. The paediatric eye care services and orthoptic exercises for strabismus are also taken care. The retinal disorders like diabetic retinopathy, DME, AMD, CSR, macular hole, retinal dystrophies can be evaluated with the advanced OCT. (Optical coherence Topography) available at our centre.



12th July 2013: Prof. Sandeep Kumar, Director, AIIMS, Bhopal, visited AIIMS Bhubaneswar. He delivered an interesting talk on “From Wholism to Reductionism to System Biology” for the members of the faculty of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.


