From the Director's Desk

Dear Friends,

Now it the time to write few paragraphs for current "News Letter". I am happy that the quarterly newsletter Dhauli is being published regularly, and this is the 4th issue.

Last 3 months are revealing. 30 Faculty members joined during this period, making the total faculty 69, which is the largest number amongst the 6 AIIMS. In April, Departments of Pharmacology and Forensic Medicine were taken in to possession. On 4th June, we started our out-patient services for public, and 100-140 patients attend OPD daily. We are also performing some investigation like hemogram, Blood Sugar, ECG etc. We are not able to perform X-rays. On 18th of June, Mr Keshav Desiraju, IAS, Hon'ble Secretary inaugurated our day care ward with 10 bed for cancer patient needing admission for chemotherapy.

On 4th of April, I attended curriculum development meeting held at AIIMS, Bhopal. In April there were several meetings at MoH&FW, for Nursing curriculum development, Oncology Committee and Protocol Development Committee. These committees are supposed to help new AIIMS for streamlining the need.


On 23rd May, first Adhoc Selection Committee meeting was held at AIIMS, New Delhi, under the chairmanship of Prof. R.C. Deka, Director, AIIMS, New Delhi, the minutes are prepared and approved. On 27th May, first meeting of Adhoc Finance Committee was held under the chairmanship of Mr. Keshav Desiraju, IAS, Secretary, at MoH&FW, Govt of India, New Delhi. Since then we have advertised for faculty posts and Senior and Junior Resident posts. A walk-in interview was held for 20 posts in Nursing, on 27th Jun 2013. More than 400 nurses attended the written test. These are steps which indicate the function of real institute has taken places as it is expected.

Regular academic activities for faculty have started. There are weekly faculty presentation on Saturday from 08.00-09.00AM. A Basic Life Support (BLS) course was organised for Faculty on 30th May and for the students on 31st May 2013.



A group of seven faculty members conducted a health camp at Tarkabahali of M.Rampur block, in remote Kalahandi district of Odisha on 24th June. The health camp was organized by Sri Ramkrishna Ashram. Around 450 patients were provided consultation and medicines for various ailments. Faculty members of the institute also conducted free Health Camp Bhakta Dasia Pitha, near Pipilli. These activities have shown the community commitment by the Institute faculty.

As Director, I attended several important meetings at Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt of India. One important event was the Orientation at Janpath Hotel from 29th, 30th April and 1st May. On 2nd May Hon'ble Secretary took a meeting on how to start minimum number of beds in Aug and simplified the purchase procedure for starting hospital need and for starting 2nd year class. I had delivered several guest lectures at AIIMS, Rishikesh (08th Apr, 28th April) at AIIMS, Bhopal on 4th April, at NM Engineering College of institute of Management studies at Bhubaneswar, on Ethics. Overall, last 3 months have seen a very positive growth at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, which is a very good sign of making a good Institute.

From the Dean's Office

Activities pertaining to the MBBS student:

The MBBS students utilize the time more efficiently following shifting to their respective hostels within the AIIMS Bhubaneswar campus. Not only they focus more on their studies as teaching hour is increased by one hour but also they engage themselves in various sports activities during their leisure time.

The students have prepared their own food menu for the whole week and accordingly the food is being served to them in the newly created Dining Hall.

Meanwhile Second Mid Semester examination was conducted from 4th to 10th April and the results was published on time. A good number of students have done well in the examination. More equipment was procured for smooth functioning of the ongoing curriculum.

The Library Committee has procured more books for Central Library as second batch of MBBS students and first batch of B.Sc Nursing students will be joining the Institute shortly.

Activities of the Faculty members:

More number of faculty members have joined in the recent past. There are now 27 Departments and 69 faculty members in AIIMS, Bhubaneswar as on 30th June 2013.

Overall the faculties are engaged in preparation of various upcoming events in the AIIMS, BBSR campus besides their routine teaching-learning activities. The pre- and para-clinical departments are also engaged in preparation for the next session. The clinical faculties now provide Institutional out-patient services at AIIMS campus as well as they visit Tangi and Mendahasal CHCs to provide specialist services to the people in need. The faculties are also actively engaged to initiate the functioning of the hospital in near future.

The faculty members present their respective research activities on 4th Friday of every month and on every Saturday.

Dr Siddhartha Satapathy, Department of Hospital Management, AIIMS, New Delhi delivered a lecture on Biomedical waste management.

Mr Ashok Kumar Panda, Program facilitator, was a resource person of a workshop entitled "Motivation, effective communication, gap perception and image management" for the faculty members of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar organized by our office.



Constitution of various committees/cell:

Three new cells has been constituted in the recent past namely Examination cell, Research cell and Medical education cell.



The Examination cell is chaired by Prof Debashish Hota. The other members are Dr.Chandra Sekhar Sirka, Dr. P Bhaskar Rao & Dr.Anusha Venkataraman. The Cell is engaged in conduction of Professional MBBS examination and conduction of various entrance examinations for recruitment to various posts.

The Research Cell is chaired by Prof D. K Parida. The member faculty are Dr.Baijayantimala Mishra, Dr. Sujit Kumar Tripathy, Dr. Amit Ghosh, Dr. Swayam Pragyan Parida, Dr. Biswa Mohan Padhy. The Research cell is actively engaged in formulation of standard operating procedure (SOP) for smooth conduction of research in the Institute. The cell also took initiative to collect and deposit research projects for ICMR grant. So far, 25 research projects from various Departments of AIIMS, BBSR have been received by Research Cell.





The Medical Education Cell is headed by Prof P. R. Mohapatra. The member faculty are Dr.Sonu H Subba, Dr. Srujana Mohanty, Dr. TS Mishra, Dr. Manish Goyal, Dr. Sucheta Parija & Dr.Rashmi Ranjan Das. The Cell will be instrumental for conduction of faculty development programs in Institute as well as at State and National level.

The Institutional Ethics committee has also been formed and the members have met once, and are in the process of formulation of draft format for submission of research proposals.

Dean's office team is planning to ensure smooth induction of new batch of MBBS and BSc (Nursing) students next month. We are sure that First MBBS students will do well in the forthcoming First Professional Examination and enter into Second Professional with flying colors.



“DR K” - ARCHITECT OF URBAN INDIA WITH ODISHA CONNECT **- Dr. K Pushpalatha, Asst. Professor in Obstetrics and Gynaecology**

Otto H. Königsberger (13 October 1908 – 3 January 1999) was a German architect who worked mainly in urban development planning in Africa, Asia and Latin America. Königsberger was born in Berlin in 1908, and trained as an architect at the Technical University, graduating in 1931. In 1933, he won the Schinkel Prize for Architecture for a design for the Olympic Stadium in Berlin. Königsberger was forced to leave the country with the rise of Nazi party. In 1953 he became the head of Development Planning Unit of University College, London, where he worked as a professor until his retirement in 1978.

Koenigsberger's journey in India: He spent the first nine years at Mysore State serving as Chief Architect and Planner, a post created for him by the Nazim, Mirza Ismail, who had recognised his talent in Europe. Eventually he was involved in the creation of several new towns including the new capital of Orissa, Bhubaneshwar and Gandhidham in Gujarat. He carried out hospital and housing projects as well as Indian Institute of Science (1943–44) and the design of Victory Hall(1946), Bangalore. He worked with Nehru government, as the first Director of Housing, in the development of the new capital of Punjab, Chandigarh. He was assigned the task of developing housing policies and programmes for the huge numbers of refugees flooding into India at that time. It is said that Koenigsberger locked his finest British architects up in a guesthouse briefly in Simla to ensure the timely completion of new city plan. In 1951 he wrote to a colleague: 'The longer I did planning work in India the firmer became my conviction that master-plans and reports are not enough. It is necessary to create a live organisation, preferably anchored in the structure of local government, which constantly deals with planning problems and keeps the basic conception of the plan alive'.

Human side:

A Nigerian student is thought of appraising him of the problems of Third World architects training in Britain by her quotes which stated as follows, "I have studied architecture in the UK and learned about snow loads and local building regulations . . . but this is of no use to me in Nigeria!". Eventually he taught town planners in the developing world to dynamically adapt their plans, and involve local communities and techniques, as opposed to imposing a static master plan based on Western ideas – an approach he called Action Planning. He was affectionately called as "Dr K" in his peak career period. His kind, compassionate and helping nature blurred international borders. The Otto Koenigsberger Scholarship was established in 1989 by University College London to encourage young professionals from developing countries to study urban planning in the UK. Dr Arcot Ramachandran, under-secretary general of the UN and chief executive of the UN Centre for Human Settlements was the first to donate funds to the scholarship. Otto's wife Renate is recognised for her unflinching support to him throughout their life together.




