It consists of background information on medical ethics, a model for making ethical decisions and an in-depth discussion of a number of contemporary issues like the role of ethics in clinical trials and guidelines for drug development, patenting and publication.

Many a times in our clinical practice we might have encountered the following questions:

- Is the action I am taking legally right?
- Am I adhering to the tenets of the Hippocratic Oath?
- Does my work conform to the ethical boundaries in scientific research and publishing?
 Am I respecting the GCP guidelines for clinical trials?
