A. For Senior Residents

- i. **Essential Qualification:** MBBS/ BDS degree with one year of internship from a recognised Institute and having MD/MS/MDS in the subject concerned.
- ii. For Non-Medical Candidates (in the subjects of Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology and Microbiology only), candidate should possess M.Sc Degree in the subject concerned and Ph.D in the same subject /allied from a recognized University/Institute.
- iii. **Upper Age Limit (as on 24th June, 2013): 33 years.** Relaxable for SC/ST candidate up to a maximum period of five years, in the case of OBC candidates up to a maximum period of three years.
- iv. In the case of Orthopaedic Physical Handicapped (OPH) candidates age relaxation upto maximum period of 5 years for General Category, 8 years for OBC category and 10 years for SC/ST category candidates.
- v. The upper age limit for candidates with DM/M.Ch degree will be 35 years. The age limit is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates.
- vi. Candidates who have already completed 3 years of senior residency (non-academic) are not eligible.
- vii. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PH shall be applicable as per Govt. of India rules.

- viii. **Approximate consolidated upper limit of monthly remuneration:** Rs. 55,000/-inclusive of NPA. NPA will not be paid to non-medical candidates.

FOR SENIOR RESIDENCY IN “TRAUMA AND EMERGENCY”, ALL CLINICAL DEPARTMENTS WITH MD/MS DEGREE WILL BE ELIGIBLE.

- ix. **Mode of selection:** MCQ based written examination will be followed by an interview. The distribution of marks is as follows: 80% for written MCQ examination and 20% for personal interview.

B. For Junior Residents, Demonstrators/Tutors

- i. **Essential Qualification:** MBBS/BDS from a recognised Institute with one year of internship and registration under any state or MCI/DCI. For non-medical candidates Master's Degree in appropriate subject.
- ii. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PH shall be applicable as per Govt. of India rules.
- iii. **Approximate consolidated upper limit of monthly remuneration:** Rs. 50,000/-inclusive of NPA for medical graduates. NPA will not be paid to non-medical candidates.
- iv. **Mode of selection:** For medical candidates, selection will be made on the basis of aggregate percentage of marks obtained in MBBS and interview. The non-medical candidates, selection will be made on the basis of aggregate percentage of marks obtained in Master's Degree in appropriate subject and interview.
- v. Priority will be given to those who are applying for the first time.
- vi. The candidates who have graduated within two years before the start of Junior Residency will be preferred.
- vii. Those candidates who have already done 3 Years of Junior Residency (Non-Academic) will not be considered.

The original certificates i.e. MBBS/BDS Degree Certificate, Internship Completion Certificate, Medical Registration Certificate, Date of Birth Certificate, Caste Certificate of the candidates who opt/select for the post of Junior Resident (Non-Academic) will be retained in the Academic Section of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. The same will not be returned to the candidate before completion of tenure of the post. If any candidate who joins the post and leave/resign/terminate before the completion of the tenure, he/she may do so by giving one month's notice as per rules or by depositing pay and allowances with the Institute for the period of which notice falls short of one month or so. All original certificates will be returned after obtaining all no dues certificates from the concerned Department/Sections of the Institute.

C. Application fee: (for SR, JR, Demonstrator/Tutor): General / OBC Category: Rs.1,000/- and for SC/ST Category: Rs.800/- as applicable. Payment to be made through demand draft/ pay order in favour of “AIIMS, Bhubaneswar” payable at Bhubaneswar.

D. Application Procedure: The applications for the above non-academic positions should be submitted on-line for which the candidates should visit the Institute's website www.aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in. In addition, the candidates should also submit a print out of application submitted on-line duly signed in each page along with the self-attested

photo copies of all relevant certificates relating to age, qualifications and experience(s) with a self-attested coloured passport size photograph and the requisite application fee i.e. bank draft/pay order by speed post/courier so as to reach this Institute in the following address on or before the last date of the submission of application i.e. 30.06.2013 (by 5.00 PM). Persons working in the Govt./ Govt organizations/ corporations/ autonomous institutes etc should submit the print out of their online application through proper channel only. The Institute will not be held responsible for the postal/courier delay.
