Letter has been sent to the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and Director, AIIMS, New Delhi on 6th June 2016 for conduction of above Examination and Counselling by AIIMS, New Delhi. d) Intramural Grants discussed in Standing Academic Committee, approved in Standing Finance Committee Meeting and Governing Body Meeting. Projects received from faculty member of various discipline and are under review.
	The clinical Departments have been functional since September, 2013. Total 301 Junior Resident positions in various departments have been approved by MoH & FW, GOI vide letter No. A.11013/0112010-SSH dated 6th Aug 2013 (Annexure – 1). In view of above facts, the Standing Academic Committee and Governing Body already approved Post Graduate courses in 7 clinical departments which will start in January 2017. Proposal for starting of PG courses (MD/MS and M.ch) in some other departments at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.

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b) B.Sc (Hons.) Courses in a) Medical Laboratory Technology, b) Operation Theatre Technology and c) Medical Technology in Imaging & Therapy (MTIT) are likely to start from academic session July 2016. Letter has been sent to the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, (GoI) and Director, AIIMS, New Delhi, on 6th June 2016 and reminder on 20th June 2016 for conducting of above examination and counselling by AIIMS, New Delhi.

The candidates selected for above course will not get any stipend during the study period. They have to work for 2 years in AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, after completion of the course, failing which they have to pay Rs. 2 lakhs as compensation. This bond has to be executed from all the students at the time of joining. During this post course training period (2 years) they will get Rs. 18,000/- per month consolidated salary.

c) Intramural project for faculty: A committee will be constituted by the Director for evaluation of projects received from faculty members of various departments.

The committee consisting of the following members:-

- One from medical backgrounds outside the Institute ex. ICMR (RMRC) as Chairman
- One member from Clinical sciences
- One member from Basic Sciences/Life Sciences
- Dean
- Members Secretary of the Research Committee

The committee will evaluate the research projects. Assistant Professor and Associate Professor in their 1st year can apply for these intramural grants. One department will get only one project per year as per the recommendation of the evaluation committee.

The research committee will prepare the guide lines and submit to the Director for the approval.

Commencement of MD/MS/DM/Mch in the following clinical discipline from the July 2018 session or later

The Standing Committee Mccting decides to follow the following guidelines to start Post Graduate Courses (MD/MS/MCh/DM) in any department:-

- 1. Department should have minimum of 3 years standing
- $2.\ Headed$ by Professor/Addl. Prof with minimum of 05 years (Post DM/MCh) and/or 08 years post MD/MS experience
- 3. Professor 2 PG per year
- 4. Addl. Prof. 1 PG per year
- 5. Department to start PG should have minimum of 3(three) faculty members.
- 6. No department can start PG in more than one branch at a time.
- 7. DNB courses in any subject is not allowed in this institute
- 8. Sponsored candidate can be taken from Army, PSU, Central/State Govt. etc.

Since the number of faculty members are less than 3 in the department of Radiotherapy/Ophthalmology, Post Graduate courses will start in the concerned department only when above guideline are fulfilled.

Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/A1 Post Graduate Courses (MD) in Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation

The faculty of the Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation department presented the data and justification before the SAC for starting MD in Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation. Earlier the committee consisting of external experts after due inspection and analysis have approved starting of MD courses in Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation.

The member of the SAC deliberated about the presentation and recommendation of the committee of the external experts and **approved 01 (one) seat per year from July 2018 session** or earlier after the approval of the GB subject to fulfilment of all the criteria discussed above during the 3rd SAC meeting held on 24th June 2016.

Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/A2/A4 DM (Onco Anaesthesia) /DM (Neuro Anaesthesia) in Anaesthesiology

The Standing Academic Committee complemented Dr. Sukdev Nayak Professor and HOD for his vision to start different courses in the department of Anaesthesiology but did not approve to start these super speciality courses at present. The SAC suggested expand / diversify the department in these areas.

The request for starting DM (Neuro and Onco Anaesthesiology) was not accepted as there is no separate department and adequate trained staff for subspecialty at this stage.

Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/A3 MD (Palliative Medicine) Courses in Anaesthesiology

The request to start Post Graduate courses Palliative care was not accepted as there is no separate department.

Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/B <u>Increase in number of Post Graduate seats in MD Anaesthesiology</u>

Since one Additional Professor has joined the department of Anaesthesiology, one PG seat is increased from January 2017 session. ie 2(two) to 3(three) per year.

Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/A5 MS in Orthopaedics

Dr. Sujit Tripathy, Associate Professor presented the data from 2013 with audio visual presentation and justified with the patient load, Infrastructure and faculty strength for starting of MS Orthopaedics 02(two) seats per session from July 2018 session or earlier if GB approves the same.

The Hon'ble Members of the SAC deliberated the issue in detail after going through all the detail approved 1(one) /2(two) seats per year and recommended to commence from July 2018 or earlier subject to fulfilment of all the above criteria.

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Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/A6 D.M. in Pulmonary Medicine

Dr. P. R. Mohapatra, Professor and HOD presented the data from 2013 with audio visual presentation with the patient load, Infrastructure and faculty strength for starting of DM in Pulmonary, Critical Care and Sleep Medicine.

The Hon'ble Members of the SAC deliberated the issue in detail after going through all the details suggested to the HOD, Deptt. of Pulmonary Medicine to start only MD in Pulmonary Medicine. However HOD, Pulmonary Medicine expressed that he is not interested in starting MD Course and wanted DM course only. Looking at the criteria committee recommended one DM seat in pulmonary Medicine from July 2018 or earlier subject to fulfilment of all the above criteria.

Head, Department of . Pulmonary Medicine should look at the Medical Council of India (MCI) guideline, where exemption was given to start DM courses and write to SAC / GB for further information.

Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/A7 <u>Post Graduate Courses (MD) in Dermatology & Venereology</u>

Dr. C. S. Sirka, faculty of Dermatology & Venereology department presented an audio visual presentation. He also highlighted some new aspects of Dermatology & Venereology, special clinics on Fungus, Acne, Allergy and Dertmatosurgery. Department is also admitting cases of medical emergencies like Pemphigus, SLE, Dermaomyositis, Erthroderma due to eczema and psoriasis, severe cutaneous drug reactions like SJS, TEN, Lepra reactions and AIDS with opportunistic infections.

The Hon'ble Members of SAC deliberated the issue by going through Annexure VI of the agenda, procedures and recommended one MD seat per year from July 2017 session or earlier subject to fulfilment of all the criteria, if GB approves the same. Department should also get one more faculty either by deputation or by regular interview for commencing the above course..

Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/A8 Post Graduate Courses (MD) in Psychiatry

Dr. Biswa Ranjan Mishra, Assistant Professor presented the data from 2013 with audio visual presentation about the patient load, Infrastructure and faculty strength and justified for starting MD Psychiatry 02 seats per session from July 2018 session.

The Hon'ble Members of the SAC deliberated the issue in detail and suggested that the Post Graduate course can be started subject to:-

- Recruitment of adequate faculty post like Professor/Additional Professor.
- Recruitment of Clinical Psychologist.

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- Starting of deaddiction unit/centre.
- Recruitment of Psychiatry social worker.

One Post Graduate seat per year is approved in principle from July 2018 session or earlier if GB approves the same subject to fulfilment of all of the above criteria

MCh in Neurosurgery

Dr. Ravi Sahu, Addl. Prof. of the Neurosurgery department presented the data and justification before the SAC for starting MCh in Neurosurgery. Earlier the committee consisting of external experts after due inspection and analysis, have approved starting of MCh courses in Neurosurgery.

The member of the SAC deliberated the data and recommendation of the committee of the external experts and approved **01(one)** seat per year from July 2017 session or earlier after approval of the GB subject to fulfilment of all the criteria. MCh course will be of 3 years duration and candidate must have MS in General Surgery. 6 years MCh course is not allowed at this stage. Additional sponsored candidate (s) can be enrolled for MCh as per the above criteria since there is no financial implication on the part of the Institute.

Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/A10 MCh Courses in Pediatric Surgery

The faculty of the department of Pediatric Surgery presented the data and justification before the SAC for starting MCh in Pediatric Surgery. Earlier the committee consisting of external experts after due inspection and analysis, have approved starting the MCh courses in Pediatric Surgery.

The member of the SAC deliberated the data and recommendation of the committee of the external experts and approved 01(one) seat per year from July 2018 session or earlier after approval of the GB subject to fulfilment of all the criteria. The duration MCh course 3 years post MS. 6 years MCh course is not recommended at this stage.

Agenda No. SAC: 03/05/A11 <u>Post Graduate Courses (MD) in Pediatrics</u>

The faculty of the Pediatrics department presented the data and justification before the SAC for starting MD in Pediatrics. Earlier the committee consisting of external experts after due inspection and analysis, have approved starting of MD courses in Paediatrics.

The member of the SAC deliberated the data and recommendation of the committee of the external experts and approved 01(one)/2(two) seat per year from July 2017 session or earlier after approval of the GB subject to fulfilment of all the criteria (s). However shortage of faculty position need to addressed by taking additional faculty on deputation or direct recruitment for commencing the above course.

- Sponsored candidates can be taken in rare speciality and super speciality departments. However, they have to appear and qualify for the same entrance examination as per the course conducted by AIIMS, New Delhi. AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, will have no financial responsibility. However, they have to pay all the fees/ hostel charges as applicable.
- Permission for admission to B.Sc (Nursing) course under IGNOU for nursing staff of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar:-

It was discussed in SAC and decided that AIIMS, Bhubaneswar need to collect and go through all the guideline prevailing at AIIMS, New Delhi for issue of NOC This has to be placed before next SAC for its approval.

It was also decided to start 2 (two) years B.Sc (Nursing) Post Basic for 30 (thirty) students per year. 50% candidates (15 in number) will be reserved for in-service candidates from AIIMS. Bhubaneswar, with 5 years service in AIIMS, Bhubaneswar and / or similar Govt. Institute. The remaining 50% will be for external candidates. A common entrance test will be conducted by AIIMS, Bhubaneswar and a separate merit list will be prepared for the candidates of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. Reservation policy will be followed as per Govt. of India rules. For the candidate of the AIIMS, Bhubaneswar the Institute has no financial liability. However, they have to pay the Admission, hostel and other fees as applicable. External candidates are not paid any stipend and they also need to pay all the fees as applicable
