2. The indenting Bidder must read the Terms & conditions of tender documents of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar carefully. He/She should only submit the bid if he/she considers himself/herself eligible and he/she is in possession of all the documents required.
3. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee at 5% (five) of the tendered amount within the period stipulated in Schedule-F.
4. The Bid documents consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the **set of terms & conditions of the contract** to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website www.aiimsbhubaneswar.nic.in Or <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>. 5. The bid for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 75 days from the date of opening of technical bid.
6. The competent authority on behalf of ED, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves the right to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.

1. The intending bidders should have satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified in this NIT.
- (ii) Should have average Annual Financial Turnover of construction/ maintenance works of at least 50% of this estimated cost put to tender during the immediate last three consecutive financial years.
- (iii) Should not have incurred any loss (profit after tax should be positive) in more than 02 (Two) Years during available last five consecutive balance sheet, duly audited and certified by Chartered Accountant.
2. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of Tender document carefully. He should submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the certificates / documents required.
3. Information and Instructions for bidders for e-tendering posted on website shall form part of bid document.
4. The bid document consisting of Plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> or www.aiimsbhubaneswar.nic.in free of cost.
5. **For E-tendering Queries contact CPPP Help Desk.**
6. The intending bidders must have valid class-III digital signature to submit the bid.
7. The bid can be submitted through CPP portal by uploading the mandatory scanned documents as specified in the form of JPG/PDF format or any other format as permissible by the e-tendering portal within the period of bid submission.
8. Contractor must ensure to quote the percentage rate in Performa of quoting rates. In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0". Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (Zero).
However, if a tenderer does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section/sub head in percentage rate tender or each item in item rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
9. GST on all materials as well as GST on Work Contract etc., or any other taxes applicable in respect of this contract shall be payable by the Contractor. Percentage rate quoted by him shall be inclusive of such taxes, levies etc and Government/AIIMS will not entertain any claim for reimbursement whatsoever in respect of the same. Further the percentage rate quoted by the contractor shall be inclusive of labor welfare cess, water charges (if applicable), electricity charges (if applicable) and the same shall be recovered from the contractors' bills where applicable.

10. After submission of bid online, the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
 11. The Technical Bid shall be opened first on due date & time as mentioned above.
 12. Financial bids shall be considered only for bidders for whom EMD and other documents are found in order and who are found to be eligible to bid for work. **On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process in CPP portal. After opening of bids he will receive the competitor bid sheets.**
 13. If any information furnished by the applicant is found incorrect at a later stage, he shall be liable to be debarred from tendering/ taking up works in AIIMS. If discrepancy is noticed between the eligibility documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the bidder, the bid shall become invalid.
 14. AIIMS reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.
 14. **FRAUD AND CORRUPTION:**
 - 14.1 The Engineer-in-Charge will reject a proposal for award if he determines that the bidder recommended for award has been engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question. He will report to the Officer Inviting Bid / next higher authority.
 - 14.2 Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited & the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
 - 14.3 The Contractor shall be debarred for One year as decided by the AIIMS, Bhubaneswar Authority for the following reason-
 - (i) If the contractors submit false work experience certificates, as required. The department reserves the right to verify the particulars furnished by the applicant independently.
 - (ii) If the contractor persistently neglects to commence the work and does not carry out the contractual obligations of the contract.
 - (iii) Violates any important conditions of contract.

(GENERAL RULES & DIRECTIONS of e-NIT)

1. Online percentage rate bids are invited on behalf of Executive Director, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar in Two (02) Bid system (Technical & Financial bid) from approved and eligible contractors registered in appropriate class of Public Works Organizations like CPWD, DoP, BSNL, MES, Railways etc. & Odisha State PWD and ancillary departments or PSUs for the following work(s) :-

Name of Work: Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for Painting Works at Hospital Complex, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar for the Year 2025-26.

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bid. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

- 1.1. The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 67,36,392.00/- (Rupees Sixty Seven Lakh Thirty Six Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Two only)**. The estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

- 1.2. Intending Bidder is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority of having satisfactorily completed similar works. Bidders are instructed to visit the site before participating the tender. The Bidders are instructed to visit the site to know the nature of work before participating in the tender.

- 1.2.1. **Eligibility Criteria.** Contractors who fulfill following requirement shall be eligible to apply: -

- a) Three (03) similar works, each of value **not less than 40%** of estimated cost put to tender or Two (02) similar works each of value **not less than 60%** of estimated cost put to tender or one (01) similar **(Civil)** work of value **not less than 80%** of estimated cost put to tender in **last 07 (Seven) Years** ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tender is invited.

i. Similar work means” General Civil Engineering works”.

2. Agreements shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed format. Bidders shall quote their percentage rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be 02(Two) Years *to be reckoned as per Schedule-F*.
4. The site for the work is available.
5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of the various type of items to be executed and the set of terms & conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents.
6. After submission of bid online, the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. Conditional Bids shall not be considered and will be out-rightly rejected at the very first instance.
8. **Preparation & Submission of Tender through Online.** The tender should be submitted/uploaded online in CPP portal in 02(Two) Bids i.e Technical Bid and Financial Bid.
9. **Earnest Money Deposit.** The bidder shall be required to submit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for an amount of **2% of Estimated cost** in the following forms: -
 - (i) Banker's Cheque/ Account Payee Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) of a Scheduled Bank in favor of **All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhubaneswar** payable at **Bhubaneswar**

(ii) Bank Guarantee including e- Bank Guarantee from a Scheduled Bank ***duly pledged in the name of the "All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhubaneswar"***. The Bank Guarantee including e- Bank Guarantee submitted as Earnest Money shall be valid for a period of 90 days for single bid works and 180 days for two bid system or more from the date of submission of the tender.

Scanned copy of the Original EMD must be uploaded with the Bid. The physical copy of original EMD shall be submitted in the office of EE(Civil) within the period of bid submission. The EMD given by all the tenderers except the L1 shall be refunded immediately after expiry of stipulated bid validity period or after acceptance of the successful bidder, whichever is earlier. The EMD of successful bidder shall be returned after the successful submission of Performance Guarantee by him. As per SOP No.5/1 of CPWD SOP-2024, the MSME firms registered in NSIC under PP policy are exempted from payment of EMD for supply of Goods & Services only. **As this is a works related tender, Bids received without EMD will be rejected.**

10. The bid submitted shall become invalid if:

- (i) The bidder is found ineligible.
- (ii) The bidder does not upload all the documents and NIT (ink signed/digitally signed) as stipulated in the bid document.
- (iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of AIIMS.
- (iv) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be treated as lowest tenderer.

11. Performance Guarantee. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish a **Performance guarantee of 05% (Five Percent) of tendered amount** after receiving letter of award, ***in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank duly pledged in the name of the "All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhubaneswar"*** which shall be kept valid for a period of 180 days beyond completion of all the contractual obligations. The Performance Guarantee can be forfeited by order of this Institute in the event of any breach or negligence or non-observance of any condition of contract or for unsatisfactory performance or non-observance of any condition of the contract. ***PG will be released after full and final settlement of Bill, without any interest.*** In case the contractor fails to deposit the said Performance Guarantee within the period including the extension period if any, EMD will be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor.

12. Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost, all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and terms and conditions.

13. The competent authority on behalf of the Executive Director, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidder shall be summarily rejected.

14. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.

15. The Competent Authority, The Executive Director, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidder shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted. Some of the items of the Schedule of Quantities may be executed partially or may not be executed at all depending upon the site requirement which will be decided by Engineer in charge.

16. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the AIIMS, Bhubaneswar responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted as an officer in any capacity between the grades of

Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazette officer in the AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.

17. No Engineer of Gazette Rank or other Gazette Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
18. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance **for a period of 75 days** from the date of opening of bids.
19. The Agency may submit Post Card Size Colored Photographs showing different stages of construction activities at his own Cost.
20. This notice inviting bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of "The Notice Inviting bid, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the bid as uploaded at the time of invitation of bid and rate quoted online at the time of submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
21. Statutory tax recoveries i.e Income Tax, Labour Cess, CGST, SGST etc as applicable at the time of payment shall be recovered from contractor's bill as per Govt. Rules/Guidelines.
 - (a) 2.5% of the gross amount of each running and final bill till the sum deducted will amount to security deposit of 2.5 % of tendered amount of the work will be deducted from the Bills of the Contractor.
 - (b) Electrical charges as per actual meter reading shall be deducted from the bill. If connection is taken directly without installation of meter with prior permission from Executive Engineer (Electrical), then amount as per the usage shall be deducted from the gross bill amount as suggested by Executive Engineer (Electrical).
 - (f) Water Charges @ 1% of the Gross Bill Amount will be deducted, if water Supply is taken from the piped water supply of AIIMS, BBSR as per CPWD guidelines.
22. The condition of the contract shall be governed by CPWD GCC Maintenance -2023 and corrected up to latest correction slip.
23. The Agency shall be solely responsible for compliance to the provisions of various Labor and industrial laws, such as, wages, allowances, compensations, EPF, Bonus, Gratuity, ESI etc. relating to personnel deployed by it at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar site. For any accident caused to the labours, the institute shall not be liable to bear any expense in this regard. The Agency shall make payment of wages to workers engaged by it by the stipulated date irrespective of any delay in settlement of its bill by AIIMS, Bhubaneswar for whatever reason. The Agency shall also be responsible for the insurance of its personnel.
24. **Defect Liability Period:**
The DLP for this work is 12 months. During this period the agency is responsible for rectifying any defects or faults that may arise without any extra cost.

25. Termination of Contract.

AIIMS, Bhubaneswar would have the right to terminate the contract, in case the work performance is not up to the standard, or in case there is any violation of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar rules & regulations, or if there is any lapse in compliance of any labour legislation, or if there is any incident of indiscipline on the part of the Tenderer or his staff and the agreement may be terminated. The decision of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar's management in this regard would be final and binding on the Tenderer. In such an event, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar shall have the right to engage any other tenderer to carry out the task.

26. Dispute Settlement.

It is mutually agreed that all differences and disputes arising out of or in connection with this agreement shall be settled by mutual discussions and negotiations if such disputes and differences cannot be settled and resolved by discussions and negotiations then the same shall be referred to the sole Arbitrator appointed by the Executive Director, AIIMS, BHUBANESWAR whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties. The contract shall be governed by laws and procedures established by Govt. of India, within the framework of applicable legislation and enactment made from time to time concerning such commercial dealings/ processing.

27. Arbitration.

The Arbitration shall be held in accordance with the provision of the Arbitration and conciliations Act, 1996 and amended from time to time and the venue of arbitration shall be at Bhubaneswar. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the both parties.

28. Jurisdiction of Courts: The court of the place from where the letter of award of work has been issued shall have the jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract.

29. Payment:

(a) It will be mandatory for the bidders to indicate their bank account number and other relevant e-payment details so that payment could be made through RTGS/ Other mechanism.

(b). GST and other Taxes as applicable shall be recovered/ paid from the contractor's bill as per Govt. of India/AIIMS Rules.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Name of Work : **Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for Painting Works at Hospital Complex, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar for the Year 2025-26**

1. Wherever any reference is made of any Indian Standard, it shall be taken as reference to the latest edition with all amendments /revision issued thereto up to the date of receipt of tenders.
2. Unless otherwise specified, the agreement rates for all items of work of the schedule of quantities are for **all heights, depths, leads and lifts** involved in the execution of work.
3. Other agencies working at site will also simultaneously execute the work entrusted to them and the contractor shall offer necessary co-operation wherever required to other agencies.
4. On account of security consideration, there could be some restrictions on the working hours, movement of vehicles for transportation of materials. The contractor shall be bound to follow all such restrictions and adjust the program for execution accordingly, for which nothing extra shall be paid.
5. No residential accommodation shall be provided to any of the staff engaged by the contractor. The contractor shall not be allowed to erect any temporary set up for staff in the campus.
6. Complaint register, Issue sheet and other records will have to be produced either daily according to the requirement or when asked to do so by the Engineer-in-charge or his authorized representative.
7. When a register gets completed, it will be handed over to the concerned J.E./A.E. It will not be returned to the contractor and the same will remain the property of the department.
8. All required register will be issued by Engineer-in-Charge/Executive Engineer duly marked in chronological order but the contractor will have to arrange all such registers/stationery etc. Nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
9. The contractor shall take immediate action to attend any complaint assigned to him through complaint register/site order book/ verbal instructions from Engineer-in-Charge or his Representative on telephones from occupants. In all cases he shall attend the complaints in the specified duration as mentioned below:-

(a) **Emergent Complaints** - Complaints of emergent nature like fire/natural calamities/ OT, ICU works and during visit of VIPs and as decided by Engineer in charge shall have to be attended immediately.

(b) **Normal Complaints** – Other regular/normal complaints have to be attended within 03 working days. However, in case of seepage and/or other inconveniences like continuous rains/un-availability of site etc, the painting work may be postponed in consultation with JE/AE(C) and this may be noted down in the complaint register. Whenever the delay is noticed, the contractor will be served notice to attend the complaint within two more days failing which a lump-sum amount of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees ONE THOUSAND only) per complaint will be recovered from his bills. This shall be without prejudice to other remedies available to Engineer-In-charge under this contract to take action against the contractor.

10. All T&P, scaffoldings, ladders etc, instruments/meters for maintenance, consumable and Contingent Articles required for execution of the work shall be arranged by the contractor.
11. Staff employed by the contractor should be well behaved, Polite & courteous. Any complaint against staff on behavior should be taken very seriously and such staff should be removed by the contractor immediately from the site and replacement shall be provided immediately.
12. The contractor shall make all safety arrangement required for the labour engaged by him at his own cost. All consequences due to negligence or due to lapse of security/safety or otherwise shall remain with the contractor. The department shall not be responsible for any mishap, injury, accident or death of the contractor's staff. No claim in this regard shall be entertained/accepted by the department. Also Contractor is responsible to the damage caused to any man/material other than his team during execution and AIIMS will not be responsible for that.
13. Contractor shall be fully responsible for any damages caused to govt. property or allotter's property by him or his labour in carrying out the work and shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost.
14. The Contractor has to provide all the tools and equipments for the works including measuring instruments and safety equipments needed. Cost of transportation of material and labour to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar premises shall have to be borne by the contractor.

The following tools and equipments shall be provided by the agency for the use of maintenance works within 15 days of Starting of the work.

- Brush/rollers
- Measurement tape (5m, 20m and 50m)
- Hanging Rope/Jhola.
- Trolleys / Wheel Barrows (for transportation of material within the campus)

- Aluminum g ladders
- Scaffolding materials/table for painting work.
- Putty mixer/paint mixer
- Safety Gloves
- Safety belt
- Safety Helmet
- Tarpaulin sheets.

Apart from the above any other tools which is required for the site condition has to be arranged by the contractor at his own cost.

15. For non-compliance or partial compliance of satisfactory execution of items, the Engineer-in-charge reserves his rights to levy compensation in accordance with the scale of non-conformity and the period for which this non-conformity continues. However, the total amount of this compensation for the whole contract shall not exceed 10% of the tendered value of this contract. This shall be without prejudice to other remedies available to Engineer-in-charge under this contract to take action against the contractor.
16. The contractor or his engineer of the work shall update complaint register regularly.
17. The agency shall restore back the premises and other articles provided by the department to the AIIMS at the time of closure of the contract.
18. In the case of discrepancy between the schedule of quantities, the Specifications and/or the Drawings, the following order of preference shall be observed:-
 - (a) Description of schedule of quantities.
 - (b) Additional specifications and special conditions, if any.
 - (c) Contract clauses of General conditions of contract for Central P.W.D. Works. (IV) CPWD specifications.
 - (d) Architectural drawings.
 - (e) Indian standards specifications/BIS. (vii) Sound engineering practice. Any reference made to any Indian standards specifications in these documents, shall imply to the latest version of that standard, including such revisions/amendments as issued by the Bureau of Indian Standards up to last date of receipt to Tenders. The contractor shall keep at his own cost all such publications of relevant Indian Standards applicable to the work at site.
19. The contractor and/or his authorized agent should see the site order book every day and get the compliance of instruction given by the JE/AE/Engineer-in-charge as per time schedule.
20. The contractor will not pitch up tents for laborers, materials and his stores etc.
21. No permanently /temporary huts/structures shall be constructed by the contractor at the site of work or at any government land/premises. Such structures, if any, found at the site or at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar land shall be demolished and removed at the cost of the agency without any notice.
22. The contractor shall clear the site properly after the completion of the work
23. Major/ Minor complaint shall be decided by the Engineer-in-charge or his representative. The decision of Engineer-in-charge shall be final & binding.
24. The contractor will have to **arrange trolleys/Wheel Barrows** for the shifting of materials within the campus at his own cost.
25. **Inconvenience to the Public.** The Contractor shall not deposit or store any materials at any site without permission of the Engineer in charge. The materials will be stored at such places only with prior approval of the Engineer in charge as there is no obstruction in Traffic or other Agencies.
26. **The provision against Accident & Safety Measures.**
 - (a) The Contractor will take all necessary precautions against a Fire during the course of his work and will ensure the work against Fire at his own cost.
27. He will also take all case against likely damage of Floor, Walls, Doors, Windows or any part of the Building. In case of any damage or loss, the contractor has to make good at his own cost.
28. **Specifications.** The work shall be carried out as per CPWD Specifications Volume I & II 2019 with up to date correction slips. The contractor should be well aware of these specifications before quoting the rates in Financial Bid for the subject tender. In the absence of specifications for any work or material, relevant Indian Standard (ISI) Specification shall be applicable.
29. **Cleaning the Site.** The site described and shown on the plans, shall be cleared off all the rubbish of all kinds etc. complete. After completion of the work and the site shall be handed over in neat and clean condition.
30. **Security Rules.** The Contractor shall follow at Site Security rules regarding removal of materials from site, issue of materials from site, issue of materials from stores, issue of Identity Card etc., as may be framed from time to time by the Engineer. It is to note that the Security Section is empowered to carry out the checks.

31. **Care in case of occupied buildings.** Tenderer may also note that when the subject work is to be carried out in the premises of occupied residential and other buildings which are already under occupation, all care shall be taken to protect personal and/or Government materials fixtures, appliances, equipment's etc. In case of any damage to any of the existing arrangements, contractor is liable to do such work to its original and/or shall be liable to pay the cost of such damages/losses. The work shall be carried in close co-ordination with occupants of these buildings without any hindrance and interruption.
32. **Inspection of Work.** Engineer or any person appointed by them shall have access and right to inspect the work, or any part thereof at all times and places during the progress of the work. The inspection and supervision is for the purpose of assuring owner and/or Engineer in charge and their representative will extend to contractor all desired assistance in interpreting the plans and specifications, all such assistance shall not relieve contractor from any responsibility for the work. Contractor without delay shall correct any work, which proves faulty.
33. **Wastage.** The contractor should note that wastage of any items shall not be paid extra. The items shall be paid based on the executed work at site. All coefficients shall be as per relevant IS code.
34. The contractor shall be responsible for the procurement of all the materials required to complete the work.
35. The contractor shall be deemed to have examined the Contract documents, to have generally obtained his information in all matters whatsoever that might affect the carrying out the works at the quoted rates and to have satisfied himself to the sufficiency of the tender. Any error in description or quantity or any other aspect in quoted rates or omission there from shall not vitiate the contract or release the contractor from executing the work comprised in the contract as per drawing and specification at the scheduled rates. He is deemed as an experienced contractor to know the scope, nature and magnitude of works and the requirements of material and labour and the type of work involved, etc. and as to what all work he has to complete in accordance with contract document whatever be the defects, omissions or errors that may be found in the contract document. The contractor shall be deemed to have visited the site and its surroundings to have satisfied himself as to the nature of all existing structures, if any and also to the nature and means of transport and communication to have access to and regress from the site.
36. All materials issued in the works shall be subjected to inspection and tests if required by Engineer in charge. Samples required for approval and testing must be supplied with sufficient time allowed for testing and approval. Materials shall be tested on site if required by Engineer in Charge and they may be rejected if found not suitable or not in accordance with the specification or Test certificate or any approval given earlier. The contractor shall carry out necessary test as per the direction of Engineer in charge in approved NABL/ Govt. laboratories. **The expenses towards all such tests are to be borne by the contractor at his own cost.** Tests shall be conducted as per relevant Indian Standard Specifications.
37. All Electrical Connections/Wirings etc. (if required) for the work shall have to be taken from the nearest source with prior permission from Executive Engineer (Electrical). All expenses on this account shall be borne by the contractor. The electrical expenses shall be charged based on the meter reading. If connection is taken directly without installation of meter, then then amount as per the usage of electrical equipment shall be deducted from the gross bill amount as suggested by Executive Engineer (Electrical).
38. Water if available may be supplied to the contractor by the department subject to the following conditions: -
- (i) **The water charges @ 1 % of the gross bill amount shall be recovered on gross amount of the work done if it is taken departmentally.**
- (ii) The contractor(s) shall make his/their own arrangement of water connection and laying of pipelines from existing main of source of supply at his own cost.
- (iii) The Department do not guarantee to maintain uninterrupted supply of water and it will be incumbent on the contractor(s) to make alternative arrangements for water at his/ their own cost in the event of any temporary break down in the Government water main so that the progress of his/their work is not held up for want of water. No claim of damage or refund of water charges will be entertained on account of such break down.
39. The contractor shall engage necessary staffs/ technical person as per Clause 32 of Schedule 'F' as per this tender document. The name, qualification and technical experience of the contractor representative shall be submitted to the Engineer in charge before start of the work. Violation of this clause will lead to non-compliance and recovery will be made as per Clause 32 of Schedule 'F'.
40. Required safety measures is to be adopted before starting chipping works of the walls so that any inconvenience may not be faced by the patient/ medical staff.
41. The contractor must deploy his manpower in the night time to complete the work if the circumstances do not permit to work in official time. However, if the work is carried out in more than one shift or at night, no claim on this account shall be entertained. In such situations, the Contractor shall make available to the department in proper means of transport such as vehicle at his own cost.

Preamble

WHEREAS, the Principal/Owner has floated the Tender (NIT No. **AIIMS/BBSR/Engg./005 /2025-26** (herein after refer red to as “**Tender/Bid**”) and intends to award, under laid down organizational procedure, contract for **Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for Painting Works at Hospital Complex, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar for the Year 2025-26.**

AND WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the Land, Rules & Regulations, Economic use of resources and of fairness/ transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s).

AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose afore said both the parties have agreed to enter to this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as “**Pact**”), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

The Tendered Value which has been accepted by Competent Authority for **Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for Painting Works at Hospital Complex, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar for the Year 2025-26** is Rs _____/- (Rupees _____ only).

NOW, THEREFORE, inconsideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under: -

Article - 1 : Commitment of the Principal/Owner.

1. The Principal/Owner commit itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:

(a) No employee of the Principal/Owner, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the Tender, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.

(b) The Principal/Owner will, during the Tender process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the Tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s)

confidential/additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the Tender processor the Contract execution.

(c) The Principal/Owner shall endeavor to exclude from the Tender process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.

2. If the Principal/Owner obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal Code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption Act,1988 (P C Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

Article - 2 : Commitment of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)

1. It is required that each Bidder/Contractor (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standard and makes, and report to the Government/Department all suspected acts of **fraud or corruption or Coercion or Collusion** of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the tendering process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.

2. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the Tender process and during the Contract execution:-

(a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal/Owner's employees involved in the Tender process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind what so ever during the Tender process or during the execution of the Contract.

(b) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to cartelize in the bidding process.

(c) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act. Further the Bidder(s)/Contract(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal/Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.

(d) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly, Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a tender but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participates in a tender on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel tender for the same item.

(e) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to, or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the Contract.

The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm indulge in fraudulent practice **means a willful misrepresentation or omission of facts or submission of fake/forged documents in order to induce public official to act in reliance thereof, with the purpose of obtaining unjust advantage by or causing damage to justified interest of others**

and/or to influence the procurement process to the detriment of the Government interests.

5. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm use Coercive Practices (means the act of obtaining something, compelling an action or influencing a decision through intimidation, threat or the use of force directly or indirectly, where potential or actual injury may be fall upon a person, his/her reputation or property to influence their participation in the tendering process).

Article - 3 : Consequences of Breach.

Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal/Owner under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal/Owner shall have the following rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) and the Bidder/Contractor accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal/Owner's absolute right :-

1. If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s), either before award or during execution of Contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Article-2 above or in any other form, such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal/Owner after giving 14 days' notice to the contractor shall have powers to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the Tender process or terminate/determine the Contract, if already executed or exclude the Bidder/Contractor from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/Owner. **Such exclusion may before vigor for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.**

2. **Forfeiture of EMD/Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit :** If the Principal/Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Contractor has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article-3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder/Contractor.

1. **Criminal Liability:** If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder or Contractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Contractor which constitutes corruption within the meaning of IPC Act, or if the Principal/Owner has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

3. If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted/recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/ Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Article - 5 : Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Sub-contractors.

1. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all sub-contractors a commitment in conformity with this Pact. The Bidder/Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Sub-contractors/sub-vendors.

2. The Principal/Owner will enter in to Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.

3. The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process, from the Tender process.

Article - 6 : Duration of the Pact.

1. This Pact begins when both the parties have legally sign edit. It expires for the Contractor/Vendor 12 months after the completion of work under the contractor till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.

2. If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.

Article - 7 : Other Provisions.

1. This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the **Bhubaneswar** of the Principal/Owner, who has floated the Tender.

2. Changes and supplements need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.

3. If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partner holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In case of a Company, the Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by board resolution.

4. Should one or several provisions of this Pact turnout to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intensions.

5. It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Agreement/Pact, any action taken by the Owner/Principal in accordance with this **Agreement/Pact or interpretation thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.**

Article - 8 : LEGAL AND PRIOR RIGHTS.

All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. For the sake of brevity, both the Parties agree that this Integrity Pact will have precedence over the Tender/Contact documents with regard any of the provisions covered under this Pact.
