INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS FOR NIQ

- I.** The quotation duly filled up with the schedule of quantities along with all necessary documents, in a sealed envelope superscripting the name of work shall be submitted to **the office of the Executive Engineer (Electrical), Room No. 327, 3rd floor, Academic building, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, At- Sijua, Pin-751019 up to 17:00 PM hours on 06.02.2026** and the same will be open at **11:00 AM hours on 07.02.2026** at the **office of the Executive Engineer (Elect), 3rd floor, Academic building, AIIMS Bhubaneswar** in presence of the committee members and representatives of the Agency who may wish to be present at the time of opening. If the last date of submission is a holiday then the last date will be considered as the next working day. However, the opening time will remain unchanged.
- II.** Intending Bidder(s) is/are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids, the means of access to the site and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies, and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.
- III.** Works Should be executed as per CPWD specifications.
- IV.** The department shall not supply any materials for the work. All T&P for the work shall be arranged by the contractor.
- V.** Payment shall be made as per rule and as per actual measurement at the site after completion of work.
- VI.** Payment will be made after statutory deduction as per prevailing rules.
- VII.** The time allowed for completion of job shall be **30 Days** from the date of award of work.
- VIII.** The Engineer-in-charges reserves the right to accept in full or in part or reject any bid and to annul the process and reject all bids at any time without assigning any reason or incurring any liability to the bidders. This notice may also be seen at website www.aiimsbhubaneswar.nic.in.

IX. Goods and Services Tax (GST).

- (a) **GENERAL REMARKS ON TAXES & DUTIES:** In view of GST Implementation from 1st July 2017, all taxes and duties including Excise Duty, CST/VAT, Service tax Entry Tax, and other indirect taxes and duties have been submerged in GST. Accordingly, reference of Excise Duty, Service Tax, VAT, Sales Tax, Entry, or any other form of indirect Tax except of GST mentioned in the bidding document shall be ignored.
- (b) Bidders are required to submit a copy of the GST Registration certificated while submitting the bids wherever GST (CGST & SGST/UTGST or IGST) is applicable.

(c) "GST shall mean Goods and Services Tax charged on the supply of material(s) and services. The term 'GST' shall be construed to include the integrated Goods and Services Tax (hereinafter referred to as "IGST") or central Goods and Services Tax (hereinafter referred to as "CGST") or State Goods and Services Tax (Hereafter referred to as "SGST") or Union Territory Goods and Services Tax (hereinafter referred to as "UTGST").

(d) **Quoted price/rate(s) should be inclusive of all taxes and GST** (i.e. IGST or CGST and SGST /UTGST applicable in case of interstate supply or intrastate supply respectively and cess on GST if applicable) on the final service. However, GST rate (including cess) to be provided in the respective places in the Price Bid. please note that the responsibility of payment of GST (CGST & SGST or IGST or UTGST) lies with the supplier of goods/services (service provider) only. Supplier of Goods/Service (Service provider) providing taxable service shall issue an invoice/Bill, as the case may be as per rules/regulation of GST. Further, returns and details required to be filed under GST laws & rules should be timely filed by the supplier of Goods /services (Service provider) with requisite details.

X. Agency will be fully responsible for labour payments, accident, mishappening, damages, & other labour welfare & safety measures. AIIMS, Bhubaneswar will not be responsible in any case.

XI. The NIQ should be submitted in **02 (two) parts i.e. Technical Bid & Financial Bid**. The Technical Bid and the financial Bid should be sealed by the bidder in 02 (Two) separate Covers superscripted with name of work in both the envelopes as "**Technical Bid**" and "**Financial Bid**" respectively. **Both sealed envelopes should be kept in a main/bigger envelope superscripted as "NIQ for "Repairing of Sensor Door of OT in Hospital Campus, AIIMS Bhubaneswar."**. All the document(s) should be properly tagged with page reference.

XII. The bidder(s) should also furnish their office address along with contact number on all the three Envelope(s) for reference.

XIII. First the Technical Bid(s) shall be opened **13:30 AM hours on 09.02.2026** . Financial bid of bidders will be opened, whose Technical bid is found to be eligible. After the evaluation of the bid(s), AIIMS Bhubaneswar will be award the contract to the lowest evaluated responsive bidder.

XIV.

- a. The Income Tax as applicable shall be deducted from the Bill unless exempted by the Income Tax Department.
- b. The quoted Rates shall be inclusive of GST.
- c. Water charges @ 1% of the gross bill amount will be deducted if water supply is taken from AIIMS departmentally.
- d. Electrical charges as per actual meter reading shall be deducted from the bill. If connection is taken directly without installation of meter with prior permission from Executive

Engineer (Electrical), then amount as per the usage shall be deducted from the gross bill amount as suggested by Executive Engineer (Electrical).

e. All the work shall be completed within 30 days from the date of issue of work Order by the Institute. All the aspects of safe installation shall be the exclusive responsibility of the Contractor. If the contractor fails to complete the work on or before the stipulated date, then a penalty at the Rate of 1 % per month of delay to be computed on per day basis of the total order value shall be levied subject to maximum of 10% of the total order value.

XV. Mode of Payment

- a) The 100% payment shall be released after due verification of final bill by Engineering-in Charge or his representative after completion of work. A deduction of 2.5% towards Security Deposit shall be made from the bill and shall be released after the completion of warranty or as per the clause no. 17 of CPWD GCC 2019 and other deduction towards taxes as per Government of India/AIIMS rule will be made from the bill. No provision is given for RA bill payment in this contract.
- b) Warranty for the items mentioned in BOQ sl no 1,2,3 is 6 months and items mentioned in BOQ sl no 4,5,6 is One (01) Year or OEM warranty whichever is higher.
- c) It will be mandatory for the bidders to indicate their bank account number and other relevant e-payment details so that payment could be made through RTGS/ Other mechanism.

Scope of Work

Project Title: Repairing of Sensor Door of OT in Hospital Campus, AIIMS Bhubaneswar.

1. Objective

The scope of this work is to carry out Servicing and repair of defective Sensor Door of OT in Hospital Complex.,

2. Major Components of Work

(A) Servicing Parts

- Remove dust and debris from tracks, sensors, and control boxes.
- Examine the door frame for damage or signs of stress.
- Ensure door opens and closes smoothly without hesitation or noise.
- Test motion sensors and activation devices for proper response.
- Test safety sensors (like presence beams) to verify the door stops or reverses if something is in the way.
- Check sensor sensitivity and adjust range if required.
- Ensure safety sensors (presence sensors, beam sensors) are functioning correctly.
- Clean sensors to ensure unobstructed operation.
- Inspect and lubricate moving parts (rollers, hinges, tracks, gears, pulleys).
- Inspect and adjust door closing/opening speed and force settings.
- Inspect and rectify wiring for wear, loose connections, or corrosion, replace if required
- Check fuses, replace if required
- Verify the door reverses or stops immediately if it encounters an obstacle.
- Record all findings, work performed, and parts replaced.
- Provide servicing checklist or report.

(B) Repairing Part

- Check door hanger rollers and guides for wear and replace if necessary.
- Check Automatic door controller and replace if required.
- Check automatic door motor and replace if required.

(C) SITC of CTVS Sliding Door Automation Kit

- Supply, installation, testing, and commissioning of an automation kit on the existing door (Door Make: Venus), including hand and foot sensor operation, complete in all respects.
- The door shall be provided with a proximity sensor for automatic operation.
- The system shall ensure proper functioning of proximity sensors for both entry and exit operations.
- Safety sensor / infrared presence sensor to prevent door closing in case of obstruction.
- Manual operation in case of power failure.
- Dual proximity / motion sensors for entry and exit.
- The microprocessor-controlled automation system shall provide smooth, silent operation with adjustable opening/closing speed, hold-open time, and sensor sensitivity
- If any additional materials are required during the execution of the work, they shall be considered

part of the scope of work, and no extra payment shall be made by AIIMS.

- **Safety and Quality**

- Before supply materials at site it shall be of approved brand and make by the Engineer-in-Charge.
- Ensure compliance with safety standards.
- The agency will ensure strict adherence to safety norms during repair and electrical work of the sensor door.

- 3. **Completion Timeline**

- The entire scope of work is to be completed within the time frame stipulated by AIIMS Bhubaneswar.

Preamble

WHEREAS, the Principal/Owner has floated the NIQ (**AIIMS/BBSR/ENGG. /01/2026**) (here in after referred to as **“NIQ/Bid”**) and intends to award, under laid down organizational procedure, contract for: **“Repairing of Sensor Door of OT in Hospital Campus, AIIMS Bhubaneswar”**. Herein after referred to as the **“Contract”**.

AND WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the Land, Rules & Regulations, Economic use of resources and of fairness/ transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Agency(s).

AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose afore said both the parties have agreed to enter to this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as **“Pact”**), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the NIQ/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, inconsideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under: -

Article - 1: Commitment of the Principal/Owner.

1. The Principal/Owner commit itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:
 - (a) No employee of the Principal/Owner, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the NIQ, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
 - (b) The Principal/Owner will, during the NIQ process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the NIQ process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential/additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the NIQ processor the Contract execution.
 - (c) The Principal/Owner shall endeavour to exclude from the NIQ process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.

2. If the Principal/Owner obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal Code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (P C Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

Article - 2: Commitment of the Bidder(s)/Agency(s)

1. It is required that each Bidder/Agency (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standard and makes, and report to the Government/Department all suspected acts of **fraud or corruption or Coercion or Collusion** of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the NIQ process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.
2. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the NIQ process and during the Contract execution: -
 - (a) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal/Owner's employees involved in the NIQ process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind what so ever during the NIQ process or during the execution of the Contract.
 - (b) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to cartelize in the bidding process.
 - (c) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act. Further the Bidder(s)/Contract(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal/Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
 - (d) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly, Bidder(s)/Agency(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a NIQ but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participating a NIQ on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel NIQ for the same item.
 - (e) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to, or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the Contract.
3. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.
4. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm indulge in fraudulent practice **means a willful misrepresentation or omission of facts or submission of fake/forged documents in order to induce public official to act in reliance thereof, with the purpose of obtaining unjust advantage by or causing damage to justified interest of others and/or to influence the procurement process to the detriment of the Government interests.**
5. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm use Coercive Practices (means the act of obtaining something, compelling an action or influencing a decision through intimidation, threat or the use of force directly or indirectly, where potential or actual injury may be fall

upon a person, his/her reputation or property to influence their participation in the NIQ process).

Article - 3: Consequences of Breach.

Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal/Owner under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal/Owner shall have the following rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder(s)/Agency(s) and the Bidder/Agency accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal/Owner's absolute right: -

1. If the Bidder(s)/Agency(s), either before award or during execution of Contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Article-2 above or in any other form, such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal/Owner after giving 14 days notice to the agency shall have powers to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Agency(s) from the NIQ process or terminate/determine the Contract, if already executed or exclude the Bidder/Agency from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/Owner. **Such exclusion may be for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.**
2. **Forfeiture of Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit :** If the Principal/Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the NIQ process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Agency has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article-3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder/Agency.
3. **Criminal Liability:** If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder or Agency, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Agency which constitutes corruption within the meaning of IPC Act, or if the Principal/Owner has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

Article - 4: Previous Transgression.

1. The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 05 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the NIQ process.
2. If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the NIQ processor action can be taken for banning of business dealings/holiday listing of the Bidder/Agency as deemed fit by the Principal/Owner.
3. If the Bidder/Agency can prove that he has resorted/recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/ Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Article - 5: Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Agency/Sub-agency.

1. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) undertake(s) to demand from all sub-agency a commitment in conformity with this Pact. The Bidder/Agency shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Sub-agency/sub-vendors.
2. The Principal/Owner will enter in to Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Agency.
3. The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the NIQ, or violate its provisions at any stage of the NIQ process, from the NIQ process.

Article - 6: Duration of the Pact.

1. This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed the edit. It expires for the Agency/Vendor 6 months after the completion of work under the agency till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more, and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.
2. If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pact as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.

Article - 7: Other Provisions.

1. This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the **Bhubaneswar** of the Principal/Owner, who has floated the NIQ.
2. Changes and supplements need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been unmade.
3. If the Agency is a partnership or a consortium, this Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partners holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In the case of a Company, the Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by board resolution.
4. should one or several provisions of this Pact turnout to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
5. It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Agreement/Pact, any action was taken by the Owner/Principal in accordance with this **Agreement/Pact or the interpretation thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.**

Article - 8: LEGAL AND PRIOR RIGHTS.

All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. For the sake of brevity, both the Parties agree that this Integrity Pact will have precedence over the NIQ/Contract documents with regard any of the provisions covered under this Pact.
