The quotation duly filled up with the schedule of quantities along with all necessary documents, in a sealed envelope superscripting the name of work shall be submitted to **the office of the Executive Engineer(Electrical), Room No. 327, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Academic building, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, At-Sijua, Patrapada, Pin-751019, Land No-0674 2476500 By 02/03/2026 (15:00 hours)** and the same will be opened On **03/03/2026 (15:30 hours)** at the office of the Executive Engineer(Elect), **3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Academic building, AIIMS Bhubaneswar** in presence of the committee members and representatives of the Agency who may wish to be present at the time of opening. If the last date of submission is a holiday then the last date will be considered as the next working day. However, the opening time will remain unchanged.
- II. **Bidders who fulfill the following requirements shall be eligible to apply:**  
The consulting firms/Institutions/Govt. approved testing agencies having satisfactorily completed **Similar Work(s) in** Central Government/State Government Department/ Central Autonomous Body/ State Autonomous Body/ Central Public Sector Undertaking/ State Public Sector Undertaking/ City Development Authority/ Municipal Corporation of City formed under any Act by Central/ State Government and published in Central/ State Gazette during last seven years ending previous day of last date submission of quotation. & shouldn't have been debarred .
- III. **Similar work means:**  
**“Civil and Structural work”**
- IV. Intending Bidder(s) is/are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids, the means of access to the site and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies, and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.
- V. Works Should be executed as per CPWD specifications.
- VI. The department shall not supply any materials for the work. All T&P for the work shall be arranged by the contractor.
- VII. Payment shall be made as per rule and as per actual measurement at the site after completion of work.
- VIII. Payment will be made after statutory deduction as per prevailing rules.
- IX. The time allowed for completion of job shall be **15 (Fifteen-Days)** from the date of award of work.

X. The Engineer-in-charges reserves the right to accept in full or in part or reject any bid and to annul the process and reject all bids at any time without assigning any reason or incurring any liability to the bidders. #### XI. Goods and Services Tax (GST).

- (a) GENERAL REMARKS ON TAXES & DUTIES: In view of GST Implementation from 1st July 2017, all taxes and duties including Excise Duty, CST/VAT, Service tax Entry Tax, and other indirect taxes and duties have been submerged in GST. Accordingly, reference of Excise Duty, Service Tax, VAT, Sales Tax, Entry, or any other form of indirect Tax except of GST mentioned in the bidding document shall be ignored.
- (b) Bidders are required to submit a copy of the GST Registration certificated while submitting the bids wherever GST (CGST & SGST/UTGST or IGST) is applicable.
- (c) “GST shall mean Goods and Services Tax charged on the supply of material(s) and services. The term ‘GST’ shall be construed to include the integrated Goods and Services Tax (hereinafter referred to as “IGST”) or central Goods and Services Tax (hereinafter referred to as “CGST”) or State Goods and Services Tax (Hereafter referred to as “SGST”) or Union Territory Goods and Services Tax (hereinafter referred to as “UTGST”).
- (d) **Quoted price/rate(s) should be inclusive of all taxes and GST** (i.e. IGST or CGST and SGST /UTGST applicable in case of interstate supply or intrastate supply respectively and cess on GST if applicable) on the final service. However, GST rate (including cess) to be provided in the respective places in the Price Bid. please note that the responsibility of payment of GST (CGST & SGST or IGST or UTGST) lies with the supplier of goods/services (service provider) only. Supplier of Goods/Service (Service provider) providing taxable service shall issue an invoice/Bill, as the case may be as per rules/regulation of GST. XII. Agency will be fully responsible for labour payments, accident, mis happening, damages, & other labour welfare & safety measures. AIIMS, Bhubaneswar will not be responsible in any case.

XIII. **Earnest Money Deposit.** The bidder shall be required to submit the Earnest Money Deposit the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt or Demand Draft from any Nationalized/Schedule Bank duly pledged in the name of the "All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhubaneswar". Document received without submitting of EMD will be rejected.

XIV. The NIQ should be submitted in **02 (two) parts i.e. Technical Bid & Financial Bid**. The Technical Bid and the financial Bid should be sealed by the bidder in 02 (Two) separate Covers superscripted with name of work in both the envelopes as **“Technical Bid” and “Financial Bid” respectively. Both sealed envelopes should be kept in a main/bigger envelope superscripted as “NIQ for Creation of chamber for valve point in fire hydrant line near trauma building, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar at risk and cost of determined tender.”**. All the document(s) should be properly tagged with page reference.

**XV.** The bidder(s) should also furnish their office address along with contact number on all the three Envelope(s) for reference.

**XVI.** First the Technical Bid(s) shall be opened **On 03/03/2026 (15:30 hours)** Financial bid of bidders will be opened, whose Technical bid is found to be eligible. After the evaluation of the bid(s), AIIMS Bhubaneswar will be award the contract to the lowest evaluated responsive bidder.

**XVII. (a)** *Security Deposit 2.5% of the gross amount of the bill shall be deducted as per GCC-2023 from the Bills of the Contractor.*

*(b) The Income Tax as applicable shall be deducted from the Bill unless exempted by the Income Tax Department.*

*(c) The quoted Rates shall be inclusive of GST.*

*(d) Labour CESS @ 01% will be deducted from the Bill.*

*(e) Water charges @ 1% of the gross bill amount will be deducted if water supply is taken from AIIMS departmentally.*

*(f) Electrical charges as per actual meter reading shall be deducted from the bill. If connection is taken directly without installation of meter with prior permission from Executive Engineer (Electrical), then amount as per the usage shall be deducted from the gross bill amount as suggested by Executive Engineer (Electrical).*

*(g) All the work shall be completed within stipulated date as per the work Order given by the Institute. All the aspects of safe installation shall be the exclusive responsibility of the Contractor. If the contractor fails to complete the work on or before the stipulated date, then a penalty at the Rate of 1 % per month of delay to be computed on per day basis of the total order value shall be levied subject to maximum of 10% of the total order value*

**Preamble**

WHEREAS, the Principal/Owner has floated the NIQ (**AIIMS/BBSR/ENGG. / NIQ. /07/2026**) (here in after refer red to as **“NIQ/Bid”**) and intends to award, under laid down organizational procedure, contract for: **“Creation of chamber for valve point in fire hydrant line near trauma building, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar at risk and cost of determined tender.”**. Herein after referred to as the **“Contract”**.

**AND** WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the Land, Rules & Regulations, Economic use of resources and of fairness/ transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Agency(s).

**AND** WHEREAS to meet the purpose afore said both the parties have agreed to enter to this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as **“Pact”**), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the NIQ/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, inconsideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under: -

**Article - 1: Commitment of the Principal/Owner.**

1. The Principal/Owner commit itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:
  - (a) No employee of the Principal/Owner, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the NIQ, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
  - (b) The Principal/Owner will, during the NIQ process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the NIQ process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential/additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the NIQ processor the Contract execution.
  - (c) The Principal/Owner shall endeavor to exclude from the NIQ process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.
2. If the Principal/Owner obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal

offence under the Indian Penal Code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (P C Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

**Article - 2: Commitment of the Bidder(s)/Agency(s)**

1. It is required that each Bidder/Agency (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standard and makes, and report to the Government/Department all suspected acts of **fraud or corruption or Coercion or Collusion** of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the NIQ process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.
2. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the NIQ process and during the Contract execution: -
  - (a) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal/Owner's employees involved in the NIQ process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind what so ever during the NIQ process or during the execution of the Contract.
  - (b) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to cartelize in the bidding process.
  - (c) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act. Further the Bidder(s)/Contract(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal/Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
  - (d) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly, Bidder(s)/Agency(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a NIQ but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participating a NIQ on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel NIQ for the same item.
  - (e) The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to, or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the Contract.
3. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.
4. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm indulge in fraudulent practice **means a willful misrepresentation or omission of facts or submission of fake/forged documents in order to induce public official to act in reliance thereof, with the purpose of obtaining unjust advantage by or causing damage to justified interest of others and/or to influence the procurement process to the detriment of the Government interests.**
5. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm use Coercive Practices (means the act of obtaining something, compelling an action or influencing a decision through intimidation, threat or the use of force directly or indirectly, where potential or actual injury may be fall upon a person, his/her reputation or property to influence their participation in the NIQ process).

**Article - 3: Consequences of Breach.**

Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal/Owner under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal/Owner shall have the following

rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder(s)/Agency(s) and the Bidder/Agency accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal/Owner's absolute right: -

1. If the Bidder(s)/Agency(s), either before award or during execution of Contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Article-2 above or in any other form, such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal/Owner after giving 14 days notice to the agency shall have powers to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Agency(s) from the NIQ process or terminate/determine the Contract, if already executed or exclude the Bidder/Agency from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/Owner. **Such exclusion may before vigor for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.**
2. **Forfeiture of Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit :** If the Principal/Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the NIQ process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Agency has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article-3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder/Agency.
3. **Criminal Liability:** If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder or Agency, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Agency which constitutes corruption within the meaning of IPC Act, or if the Principal/Owner has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

#### **Article - 4: Previous Transgression.**

1. The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 05 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the NIQ process.
2. If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the NIQ processor action can be taken for banning of business dealings/holiday listing of the Bidder/Agency as deemed fit by the Principal/Owner.
3. If the Bidder/Agency can prove that he has resorted/recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/ Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

#### **Article - 5: Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Agency/Sub-agency.**

1. The Bidder(s)/Agency(s) undertake(s) to demand from all sub-agency a commitment in conformity with this Pact. The Bidder/Agency shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Sub-agency/sub-vendors.
2. The Principal/Owner will enter in to Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Agency.
3. The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the NIQ, or violate its provisions at any stage of the NIQ process, from the NIQ process.

#### **Article - 6: Duration of the Pact.**

1. This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed the edit. It expires for the Agency/Vendor 6 months after the completion of work under the agency till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more, and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.
2. If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.

#### **Article - 7: Other Provisions.**

1. This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the **Bhubaneswar** of the Principal/Owner, who has floated the NIQ.
