The Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar, invites E-Bids in Two Bid System (i.e. Technical Bid and Financial Bid) from eligible Manufacturers /Companies / Firms online through e-procurement solution portal of AIIMS Bhubaneswar <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> as per terms and conditions contained in this document for **UG Canteen Service at Dining Hall-02 (DH-02) at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar** as per the Specifications mentioned in the Technical Bid.

The duration of the contract shall be initially for a period of 1(ONE) year from the date of award of contract and extendable up to another 1 (one year) on mutually agreeable terms & conditions. First three months being on trial period and on satisfactory completion of the trial basis the contract will automatically be extended for the remaining months of the year. On satisfactory performance extension will be made for another 1 (one) year. However, in case of any defaults or negligence under such contract the canteen committee may suggest to the AIIMS Bhubaneswar authority to impose fine or penalty against the contractor or termination of the contract.

The Bidder is expected to examine all Instructions, Terms and Conditions, Forms, and Specifications in the bidding document. The bid should be complete and in the prescribed format as per the requirement of the bid document. **The bid should not be conditional.** Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding document or submission of a bid not responsive to the bidding documents in all respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the bid.

The Procurement of goods and services under this tender will be regulated as per the applicable provision of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), order 2017 and revised order on 04.06.2020 and 16.09.2020 of MoC&I (DIPP), Govt. of India and the condition of prior turnover and prior experience may be relaxed for start-ups (as defined by Department for Industrial Policy and promotion) subject to meeting of quality& Technical Specification.

1. Exemption from EMD: Following categories of Sellers shall however, be exempted from furnishing Bid Security:

2. Firms registered with NSIC (for sale of Medical Service/Instrument/ Apparatus) are exempted from submission of EMD (subject to the financial limits indicated in the NSIC certificate). Govt. of India/State Government departments/Undertakings are also exempted from EMD. 1.BID RELATED DOCUMENTS

1.1 Clarification of Bidding documents

1.1.1 The Tender Inviting Authority shall not be responsible for individually informing the prospective bidders for any notices published related to this bid. Bidders are requested to browse e-Tender portal or website of the Tender Inviting Authority for information/general notices/amendments to bid document etc. on a day to day basis till the bid is concluded before submission of bid.

The purchaser will respond in writing (through e-mail) to any request for clarification, provided that such request is received within the last date of receipt of Representation.

1.2. Amendments in Bidding Documents:

(i) At any time prior to the dead line for submission of Bid, the Tender Inviting Authority may, for any reason, modify the bid document by amendment and publish it Central Public Procurement Portal (<https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>).

(ii) At any time till **2 (two) days before** the deadline for submission of bids, the AIIMS Bhubaneswar may, for any reason, whether at own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the bidding document through amendment. All amendments will be uploaded on the website regularly. AIIMS, BBSR shall not be responsible to notify the amendments to individual bidders. All amendments by the AIIMS, BBSR till **2 (two) days before** the deadline for submission of bids, shall be binding on the participatory bidders.

2.Instructions to Bidders (ITB)

2.1 The Bidders must go through the complete Tender Document for details before submission of their Bids. The bid submitted by Bidder and all subsequent correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged between Bidder and the Procuring Entity shall be written in English or the Official Language. However, the language of any printed literature furnished by Bidder in connection with its bid may be written in any other language provided a translation accompanies the same in the bid language. For purposes of interpretation of the bid, translation in the language of the bid shall prevail. Instructions to Bidders shall form part of this bid document and consequent contract out of this bid.

2.2 The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and AIIMS, Bhubaneswar will in no case be held responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

2.3 **Bid Validity:** The validity of the Bid/ Tender Document shall be for **180 days** from the date of opening of the bid.

2.4 **Bidder' Eligibility:** Tender should be quoted only by the original contractor/Agent/Vendor.

2.5 The bidder must be a natural person, private entity, or public entity (State-owned enterprise or institution).

2.6 The bidder must not be a Joint Venture/ Consortium (an association of several persons, firms, or companies - hereinafter referred to as JV/C).

2.7 The bidder must not be insolvent, in receivership, bankrupt or being wound up, not have its affairs administered by a court or a judicial officer, not have its business activities suspended and must not be the subject of legal proceedings for any of these reasons.

2.8 The bidder must not be convicted (within three years preceding the last date of bid submission) or stand declared ineligible/ suspended/ blacklisted/ banned/ debarred by appropriate agencies of Government of India from participation in Tender Processes of all of its entities.

2.9 The bidder must not be of the near relations of executives of Procuring Entity involved in this Tender Process.

2.10 Any bidder having a conflict of interest, which substantially affects fair competition, shall not be eligible to bid in this tender. Bids found to have a conflict of interest shall be rejected as nonresponsive.

2.11 Any bidder (as defined in paragraph 6 of the Order No. F.No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23.07.2020 issued by Ministry of Finance Department of Expenditure Public Procurement Division) from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as prescribed in the aforesaid order. Proof of such registration should be enclosed with the bid documents.

2.12 Post implementation of the contract regarding Maintenance, Cleanliness & Hygienic conditions are to be checked by a committee consists of 2 (Two) Dieticians and Faculty in-charge. **During the inspection, the Manager deployed by the H-1 Bidder is to be present and to reply and implement the observations raised by the Committee.**

2.13. **Bidder Turn Over Criteria:** The minimum average annual financial turnover of the Bidder of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be **Rs.300,00,000/- (Rupees Three Core only)**. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the Bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2.14. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2.15.If the Bidder is a **Micro or Small Enterprise** as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications.

2.16.If the bidder is a Start-up/ Stand-up, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.

2.17.Bidders are required to quote strictly as per specification of the Service. Deviation if any to specification, must be brought out clearly giving deviation statement in **Annexure-IV**.

3.Terms of Two Bid System:

The tender shall be submitted in 2 (Two) parts online:

A.Technical Bid:

All required documents to be submitted online. Additionally, the Original documents in hard copy as sought in the Tender also need to be submitted.

B.Financial Bid:

i. Financial Bid is to be submitted on line. The Financial Bid of bidders, who qualify at Technical Bid Evaluation, will be opened thereafter. While submitting Financial Bid following points need to be taken care of by the bidder.

ii. The menu and rates of Canteen services are fixed by the management.

iii. The Rates are to be quoted in the given format as per Annexure-VII.

iv. The percentage of GST must be mentioned clearly.

v. The rates should be quoted in Indian Rupees in figures as well as in words. If discrepancy observed in quoted GST among bidders for a particular item, then decision will be taken as per GST confirmation only.

vi. If a firm quotes NIL charges / consideration, the bid shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered.

vii. After due evaluation of the bids, Institute will award the contract to the responsive Bidder who has quoted the highest rate per square meter (H-1).

4.Original Documents required:

5.Withdrawal, Substitution and Modification of Tender:

No bid will be allowed to be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and expiration of the period of validity. Withdrawal of a bid during this period will result in forfeiture of the bidder's bid security (EMD).

6.Public Procurement (Preference to MSEs/Start-ups/Stand-up India

Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):

- i. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued 3 / 7 by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry.
- ii. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods/services. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service.

If H-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within H 1 - 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match H-1 price and contract will be awarded on the margin of Purchase Preference.

Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy:

- iii. For Micro and Small Enterprises Order 2012 in Public procurement will be as per the guidelines laid down by the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 issued by Department of Expenditure amended from time to time.

Procurement outside GeM:

- iv. As per the Circular No. F.6/18/2019-PPD issued by Ministry of Finance, Dept. of Expenditure dated **23 Jan 20** and DO No.214/CEO-GeM/2020 dated 10.11.2020 regarding procurement of goods/ services outside GeM, bidders are required to submit documents in support of their registration with GeM i.e., Unique GeM Seller Id. with their bid.
- v. However, the bidder who is not registered with GeM at the time of submitting the tender needs to submit an undertaking on firm's letter head that GeM seller Id. will be provided at the time of award of contract positively failing which their contract will be treated as null & void and will be dealt suitably.
- vi. An undertaking also to be given in company letter head that **"Such already registered suppliers should be boarded on GeM as and when the item or service gets listed on GeM"**.

Bid Opening:

- vii. The Technical Bid will be opened as per schedule mentioned in E-Tender Schedule. The bidder(s) or their authorised representative(s) may remain present at the scheduled date and time. In case the scheduled date is declared Holiday, the tender shall be opened on next working day at same time.

8.Evaluation of Bid :

- i. The tender will be evaluated on the basis of who has quoted the highest rate per square meter (H-1).
- ii. The menu and rates of Canteen services are fixed by the management.
- iii. Award of Bid will be guided as per Purchase preference clause under MSE as above.

9.Terms & Conditions:

- (i) The AIIMS, Bhubaneswar invites bid for selection of Canteen contractor to run **(I) One canteen (II) One Cafeteria and (III) One Shop attached to it in Dining Hall - 02.**
- (ii) The duration of the contract shall be initially for a period of One year from the date of award of contract and extendable up to another 1 (one year) on mutually agreeable terms & conditions. However, in case of any defaults or negligence under such contract, the committee may suggest to the AIIMS Bhubaneswar authority to impose fine or penalty against the vendor (Service Provider) or termination of the contract.
- (iii) Service providers having adequate experience in running same/similar type of Canteen/ Cafeteria/ Shop in only Government departments, reputed Public Sector Undertakings may apply along with sufficient proof of their experience and ability of running the canteens.

PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

A	The Vendor must have minimum 3 years of experience in the field of Canteen services at different Govt./ reputed public sector Educational Institutions. Supporting documents to be provided. (Mandatory) 1. Organization served, 2. Duration, 3. No. of plates served each of B/f, Lunch & Dinner, 4. Satisfactory Performance Certificate from the Organization.
B	Experience certificate/Continuity certificate/ Last Serving certificate / Copy of work order showing tenure of contract with contract value/any other document in support of providing the canteen services from the currently served Govt./ Reputed Private Institutes duly sealed and signed to be submitted from the Administrative head of the Institute and / or any authorized official of the institute
C	Average Annual Turnover Certificate from the Chartered Accountant for last three years i.e. 2022-2023, 2023-2024 & 2024-25. (Annual turnover per year should be minimum Rs.3.00 Crores each year) from Canteen services from the Educational Institutes mentioned at Para-A, only.
D	The bidder must have successfully executed/completed Canteen Services, over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years: - 1. Three similar completed services with experience of serving not less than 300 plates of each Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner on each day; or 2. Two similar completed services with experience of serving not less than 400 plates of each Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner on each day; or 3. One similar completed service with experience of serving not less than 500 plates of each Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner on each day at the canteen at Govt./ Public Sector Undertaking. Certificate to that extent in the organization's letter head with issuing officers contact details should be provided.

10.SCOPE OF WORK AND GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- i. The selected Caterers have to serve the food in the dining hall and packed food in the Academic Block, Hospital and Hostels as and when required. Space for cooking will be provided in the Dining Hall. The Contractor shall bear all the expenses towards the purchase of raw materials, serving of meals, collection of leftovers, disposal of dirt, purchase of brooms, floor/ area sanitizer like phenyl etc. for maintaining cleanliness of highest standard. Utensils, cooking gas required for cooking, and other crockery and cutlery shall have to be arranged by the contractor. The Contractor shall make his own arrangement for cooking gas, crockery, cutlery, glasses and other kitchen Service. Good quality paper made disposables should be used by the Contractor for serving tea/ coffee etc. instead of plastic materials. The Contractor shall use the commercial cooking gas cylinder and ISI marked Gas Stove for the purpose of cooking.
- ii. **The quality of service will be evaluated every month as per the checklist. Penalty of Rs. 5,000/- will be put on the vendor if the percentage of score remains below 80%.**
- iii. **The contract may be terminated by the Contractor after giving a notice of 03 (Three) months** whereas AIIMS, Bhubaneswar can terminate the contract after giving **one-month notice period.**
- iv. No compensation will be allowed due to fluctuation in the market rates of material and labour. There will be no escalation of rates of the different items as quoted during the contract period. The rates quoted by the contractor shall remain unchanged during the contract period.
- v. The Contractor, whose tender is accepted, has to sign an agreement on non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only) with AIIMS, Bhubaneswar within **30** days of issuance of Work order, failing which the earnest money deposited by him will be liable to be forfeited and treating the work order as cancelled.
- vi. The contract comprises the necessary arrangement of all raw materials required for preparation of breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks, beverages, sweets, preparation of items mentioned in Appendix A & B and serving the prepared food to UG students (**Approx. 800 Nos.**) including provision of all materials, Service for preparation and serving of articles. This will also include transportation, cost of materials and labour charges. The contractor shall make his own arrangement for safe preservation (in refrigerator) of materials and accommodation for his staff etc. No employees of the contractor shall be allowed to reside in canteen premises. No staff member of the contractor is allowed to enter the hall premises between **12 AM and 5.00 AM. Any violation shall be dealt with a penalty of Rs. 20,000/- per instance in order to ensure no anti-social and criminal activity takes place after canteen timings.** Repeated offences shall be dealt strictly including cancellation of contract as per the discretion of the competent authority, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. In case of inescapability, a permission for the same should be taken from the competent authority.
- vii. The contractor shall maintain the quality of preparation of food, fresh availability of items, constant supply of cold drinking water & other beverages as per the canteen management committee requirement.
- viii. **A dietician will be nominated by the Competent Authority of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, to monitor and ensure the quality of food being served by the caterer. A monthly report regarding the quality of the food, hygiene standard maintained by the caterer, performance and other such complaints, if any, received from the inmates will be submitted by the dietician to Administration.**
- ix. The contractor shall maintain the working hours of Canteen as laid down by the Canteen Committee. The contractor will keep the premises clean as per the instructions of the canteen committee on its own cost. The garbage as generated will be suitably disposed of through mechanized manner and no garbage will be piled up for more than one day.

- x. The contractor shall maintain FULL HYGIENIC CONDITIONS in the Canteen, in the storage, preparation and serving of eatables and in keeping the floor, furniture, utensils, crockery, cutlery neat and clean, so as to maintain the standards and aesthetic values in the Canteen. Contractor should make arrangements for visible storage of prepared food in hygienic condition. The canteen and its premises shall be kept clean and tidy. The garbage, peel-offs etc. should be disposed of as per norms of Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation at the cost of the Contractor/ Caterer. **Smoking, tobacco chewing and intake of liquor is strictly prohibited.** Any violation will attract a fine of Rs. 5,000/- per instance.
- xi. The staff and the Caterer will have to be provided uniforms with ID cards by the Contractor during working hours and they will be required to wear the uniforms and cap during working hours positively. Such persons should be free from contagious disease and maintain proper wearing of clean uniforms. No staff member below 18 years of age should be appointed by the Contractor as it is prohibited under the Law.
- xii. The contractor shall carry out the work in accordance with this contract. The Canteen should run in the name of '**AIIMS, Bhubaneswar Canteen (DH-2)**' and no other name should be used.
- xiii. The Canteen Committee or its members shall have every right to inspect the Canteen without any notice and can seal the canteen in case of violation of terms and conditions. The staff of the canteen shall be the sole staff of the contractor and no relationship of master and servant shall exist between AIIMS, Bhubaneswar and such staff.
- xiv. The Canteen should run during **the timings from 7.00AM to 11.00 PM**
- xv. The decision of the Competent Authority of the Institute with regard to any matters pertaining to the Canteen shall be final.
- xvi. The Canteen Contractor shall handover charge of all furniture, fixtures, fittings etc., in good condition to the Institute when the contract is closed.
- xvii. The Canteen Contractor shall pay the cost of damage, if any, caused to the premises, fixture, fittings etc., during the period of contract.
- xviii. The Canteen Committee may also authorize any other person of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar to inspect the central canteen.
- xix. The contract will be in force from the date of leasing the Canteen and expire on completion of contract period and no notice by Institute is necessary, otherwise a hefty penalty of Rs. 50,000/- may be charges per day till the Bank Guarantee (BG) gets exhausted and the eviction proceedings may be resorted to subsequently. The Canteen Contractor shall leave the Canteen premises with his employees immediately after completion of the specified date and shall not re-enter.
- xx. The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Bhubaneswar permits the Contractor to utilize the electrical and sanitary fittings, furniture, for the purpose of carrying out their obligations under this Agreement. However, any extra requirement to be arranged by the Vendor/ Contractor.
- xxi. AIIMS, Bhubaneswar reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof. The tenders which do not fulfil all or any of the above conditions or incomplete in any respect shall be liable to be rejected. Executive Director, AIIMS, BBBSR has the full and exclusive right to cancel the tender at any point of time without assigning any reasons thereof.
- xxii. The vendor must maintain a feedback register.

- i. Limited salad will be provided during lunch and dinner. It will comprise of lemon and any of the three (Tomatoes, cucumbers, onions, beetroots, carrots). Pickle to be provided with every meal. Mouth freshener (Fennel seeds and sugar) to be kept at entrance.
- ii. Seasonal Chutney will be served with items like samosa, kachori, all types of chats etc.
- iii. Menu as decided by the mess/canteen committee will be strictly followed. Price of each item must be displayed on board in the designated places.
- iv. Extra items e.g. extra bowls of curd, non-veg. items and special vegetarian dishes etc. over and above the decided mess menu can be sold at extra prices decided in by the Mess/Canteen committee in consultation with the caterer.

16.ASSIGNMENT & SUBLETTING:

- i. The contractor shall not assign the contract or any part thereof or any benefit or interest therein or there under without written consent of the Institute. The whole of the charge included in the contract shall be executed by the Contractor. The Contractor shall be responsible for the acts, defaults and neglects of its employees, or workmen. All the workers as engaged by the contractor will be solely his employees and the contractor will ensure compliance of all labour laws as applicable including payment of minimum wages. He will also comply all other laws of the land as applicable. AIIMS, Bhubaneswar will have no liabilities in this connection. **The Contractor will take care of all fire safety measures without fail.**
- ii. The Canteen premises (inside and outside) should not be used for any other purpose except for running the canteen and that the walls and surroundings of the canteen should not be used for display of wall posters, writings etc. The contractor is responsible for minor repair and replacement works with electrical fittings, sanitary items without any expenses to the Institute. **The contractor shall not be involved in transporting the cooked food from AIIMS, BBSR premises to any other organizations/ places.**
- iii. The Contractor should not transfer the management to any other individual or agency. The manager of the Canteen should be present at the premises and supervise the day-to-day affairs of the Canteen and shall not give scope for any complaints whatsoever. However, the canteen committee will regularly inspect the canteen premises and any deficiencies as detected by them should be addressed immediately, failing which penalty will be imposed upon the contractor.
- iv. The Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar (Odisha, India) has the full and exclusive right to accept or reject, any or all Bids, abandon/ cancel the Tender process, and issue another tender for the same or similar service at any time before the award of the contract without assigning any reasons thereof. It would have no liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for such action(s).

- v. The Contractor will use Electronic Billing Machine for Token system to be displayed and used on daily basis. Electronic payment facility and cash facility to be used by the Contractor for easy payments by the users.
- vi. The contractor shall employ skilled and experienced persons in running the canteen. No child labour will be employed by the Contractor in the canteen and the Institute shall be at liberty to object to and require the Contractor to remove from canteen any person employed by contractor in running the canteen who in the opinion of the Institute is unbecoming of being employed in the canteen. Such persons shall not again be employed in the canteen without the specific permission of the Canteen Committee.

17.PAYMENT DETAILS:

The payment for food served during the contract period shall be directly collected by the vender from the beneficiaries. Credit if any allowed to anyone will be the sole responsibility of the vendor. AIIMS, Bhubaneswar is no way shall be held responsible for any credit transactions.

18.COMPLIANCE OF STATUTORY LIABILITIES:

- i. **The Caterer has to pay a rent per Square meter of utilized area as per Govt. of India norms. The caterer will have to deposit the Electricity and Water charges as per actual unit consumption. The electricity and water charges have to be deposited positively on monthly basis without fail.** Otherwise penalty of 10% penalty over the dues pending shall be imposed per month and after 03 consecutive months of default, the decision of the competent authority shall be final and binding on the vendor.
- ii. The contractor shall ensure that wages paid to his employees confirm to the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act and other social security like EPF, ESIC etc. The Contractor shall also ensure adequate rest and working hours as per norms etc. to all his employees.
- iii. The contractor shall be totally responsible for all statutory liabilities including those relating to Weights and Measures and Prevention of Food Adulteration.
- iv. The licensee shall obtain and arrange a 3rd party insurance policies to cover all the incidents, workmen and all the kitchen equipment involved in the outsourcing of services, against any mishap. The insurance policy shall be obtained every year by the contractor till the date of completion of contract.

19.SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE:

All disputes related to canteen lease, rent, electric bill, management, maintaining hygiene and abiding rules and regulation as per the Govt. of India guidelines by the AIIMS authorities. If amicable settlement fails and as required, an Arbitrator shall be appointed on mutual consent within the Institute by authorities of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. Any legal dispute if so arise shall be subject to jurisdiction of courts in Bhubaneswar only.

20.ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1.Validity of Tender: The validity of the Bid Tender Document shall be for 180 (One hundred and eighty) days from the date of last date of submission of the bid.

- i. **E-Tenders should be quoted only by the Original Bidder.** Bidders are required to quote strictly as per specifications of the tender. Deviation if any to specification, must be brought out clearly giving deviation statement as per **Annexure-IV**
- ii. **No deviation is accepted. Bidders may send representation to consider the deviation/suggestion in specification/brand/quantity on or before the last date of receipt of representation. Changes if any, will be issued as Final Corrigendum/ addendum. No further deviation will be accepted for evaluation in Technical stage or any further. Annexure-IV.**
- iii. Replacement and repair will be undertaken for the defective Services at no extra cost.
- iv. No guarantee can be given as to the minimum quantity which will be drawn against this contract but the contract holder firm will have to supply quantity as may be ordered during the currency of the contract.
- v. The Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar has full authority to take into account the performance of bidder and they should submit latest performance certificate from any other Govt. Hospitals/ Institutions/PSUs to testify the proper dealing of canteen services & performance.

21.POWER TO IGNORE MINOR DEVIATIONS:

- i. AIIMS Bhubaneswar reserves right to ignore any trivial nature of deviation(s) in tender documents as decided by the competent authority while processing the tender. The Institute may also seek any clarification/ documents to substantiate the claim of the bidder at the later stage if felt necessary. However, the bidder can't claim it as a matter of right and will be bound to comply the Terms & Conditions of the tender without citing the ground of trivial deviation/ seeking of the clarification/ documents in support of the cancellation of his/ her bid.
- ii. After due evaluation of the bid, Institute will award the contract to the responsive Bidder who has quoted the Highest price for the canteen services.
- iii. The Bidder shall not be allowed to transfer, assign, pledge or sub-contract its rights and liabilities under this contract to any other agency/ies without prior written consent of the Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar. If it is found that the firm has given sub-contract to another Agency, the contract shall stand cancelled & the performance security deposit of such Bidder shall be forfeited by AIIMS Bhubaneswar.
- iv. The AIIMS Bhubaneswar shall not be responsible for any financial loss or other damage or injury to any item or person deployed/supplied by the Supplier Agency during the course of their performing the duties to this office in connection with the Canteen Service at Dining Hall-02 (DH-02) at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.
 - v. If the bidder denies/ fails to execute the contract/ order after being awarded for the same or to submit the Performance Security, the bid security (EMD) shall be forfeited and the vendor will be debarred for a period of two years from participating in future tenders of the Institute.
 - vi. The purchaser will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question.
 - vii. The Tender Document and associated correspondence are subject to copyright laws and shall always remain the property of the Procuring Entity and must not be shared with third parties or

reproduced, whether in whole or part, without prior written consent of AIIMS Bhubaneswar authorities.

viii. The Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar (Odisha, India) has the full and exclusive right to accept or reject, any or all Bids, abandon/ cancel the Tender process, and issue another tender for the same or similar Goods at any time before the award of the contract without assigning any reasons thereof. It would have no liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for such action(s).

22. RISK PURCHASE & PENALTY:

i. In case the bidder on whom the service order has been placed, fails to make supplies within the delivery schedule and the purchaser has to resort risk purchase, the purchaser (AIIMS, Bhubaneswar) may recover from the bidder the difference between the cost calculated on the basis of risk purchase price and that calculated on the basis of rates quoted by bidder. In addition, Liquidated damage will also be recovered for the items defaulted; calculated from the date of service order issued till the supply of the item(s) through risk purchase. The amount will be recovered from any of his subsequent/pending bills or Security Deposit. Black listing of the firm may be initiated depending upon the circumstances of the default/merit of the case.

ii. The quantity for supply will be as per the requirement of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar and is subject to increase/decrease at the discretion of the competent authority of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.

iii. The selected contractor shall also provide the name and mobile number of a key person, who can be contacted at any time, even beyond the office hours and on holidays. The person should be capable of taking orders and making arrangement for supply of the desired items even at short notice to AIIMS Bhubaneswar. The selected manufacturer should submit two working e-mail IDs for all official correspondence which will be registered in the vendor directory. Any changes in the Mail IDs must invariably be informed immediately to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.

23.LAW GOVERNING THE CONTRACT AND JURISDICTION:

The contract shall be governed under Indian Contract Act 1872 and instructions thereon from the government of India. The Court of Bhubaneswar shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract.

24.PERFORMANCE SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Security Deposit of Rs. 30,00,000 in favour of "AIIMS Bhubaneswar" by way of "Irrevocable Performance Bank Guarantee or Fixed Deposit Receipt" (in favour of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar) from Nationalized/Commercial Bank which is refundable. The performance security shall remain valid for a period of 14 months from the date of contract LoA. Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or impairs or derogates the bid in any respect.

i. After due evaluation of the bid(s), Institute will award the contract to the responsive bidder who has quoted the Highest Price.

ii. Conditional Bids will be treated as unresponsive and therefore shall be rejected.

iii. The Institute reserves the right to accept in part or in full or reject any or more Tender/offer without assigning any reasons or cancel the tendering process and reject all Tender at any time prior to award of contract, without accepting any liability, whatsoever.

iv. In the event of the claims in the on-line documents are materially missing or of substantial error or unqualified for want of required qualifications, the bid shall be rejected. However, minor/ trivial nature of deviations in the submission of documents may be ignored or may be allowed to be rectified by obtaining required clarification by the Tender Inviting Authority so as to ensure qualification of maximum number of competitive offers to the final round.

v. The Bidder shall be responsible for properly uploading the relevant documents in the e-Tender portal in the specific location and the Tender Inviting Authority shall not be held liable for errors or mistakes done while uploading the on-line Bid.

- vi. In respect of items where single bid has been received, the same may be re-Tendered.
- vii. **A latest certificate of GST payment should be enclosed.**

25.FORCE MAJEURE :

- (a) If, at any time during the subsistence of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any war or hostility, act of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fire, floods, exception, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockout or act of God (hereinafter referred to as events) provided notice of happening of any such eventuality is given by party to other within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof.
- (b) Neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and deliveries have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive.
- (c) Further, that if the performance in whole or in part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days, AIIMS, BBSR may, opt to terminate the contract.

26.DEBARMENT FROM BIDDING:

- (a) A bidder shall be debarred if he has been convicted of an offence
- (i) under the prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 or
 - (ii) the Indian Penal Code or any other law for the time being in force, for causing any loss of life or property or causing a threat to public health as part of execution of a public procurement contract.
- (b) A bidder debarred or any successor of the bidder shall not be eligible to participate in a procurement process of any procuring entity for a period not exceeding three years commencing from the date of debarment. Department of Commerce (DGS&D) will maintain such list which will also be displayed on the website of DGS&D as well as Central Public Procurement Portal.
- (c) A procuring entity may debar a bidder or any of its successors, from participating in any procurement process undertaken by it, for a period not exceeding two years, if it determines that the bidder has breached the code of integrity. The Ministry/Department will maintain such list which will also be displayed on their website.
- (d) The bidder shall not be debarred unless such bidder has been given a reasonable opportunity to represent against such debarment.

27.CODE OF INTEGRITY:

No official of the bidder shall act in contravention of the codes which includes

(a) Prohibition of:

- (i) Making offer, solicitation or acceptance of bribe, reward or gift or any material benefit, either directly or indirectly, in exchange for an unfair advantage in the procurement process or to otherwise influence the procurement process.
- (ii) Any omission, or misrepresentation that may mislead or attempt to mislead so that financial or other benefit may be obtained or an obligation avoided.
- (iii) Any collusion, bid rigging or anti-competitive behaviour that may impair the transparency, fairness and the progress of the procurement process.
- (iv) Improper use of information provided by the procuring entity to the bidder with an intent to gain unfair advantage in the procurement process or for personal gain.
- (v) Any financial or business transactions between the bidder and any official of the procuring entity related to tender or execution process of contract; which can affect the decision of the procuring entity directly or indirectly.
- (vi) Any coercion or any threat to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or its property to influence the procurement process.
- (vii) Obstruction of any investigation or auditing of a procurement process.

- (viii) Making false declaration or providing false information for participation in a tender process or to secure a contract.
- (b) disclosure of conflict of interest:
- (i) Disclosure by the bidder of any previous transgressions made in respect of the provisions of sub-clause with any entity in any country during the last three years or of being debarred by any other procuring entity.
- (ii) The purchaser will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, Fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question.
- (ii) The Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar, Odisha, India has the full and exclusive right to accept or reject, increase or decrease order, square meter area, any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof and also to cancel the Rate contract at any time without assigning any reason.

28.Cartel Formation :

Any bidder who is participating in this bid is to ensure that he is not aligned with any bidder with a partnership firm and also in a financial sharing business. This leads to cartel formation, in this case Buyer has every right to disqualify both the bidders.

29.PENALTY CLAUSE

In case of violation of the following rules, the penalty charges on the Caterer shall be followed. In addition to the penalties mentioned at “Scope of Work”

- i. Non-availability of complaint register on the counter/ discouraging students from registering complaints a fine of **Rs.1,000/-** (Rupees one thousand only) on every occasion.
- ii. For single complaints of insects and/or foreign object cooked or found in dish of any food items would invite a fine of **Rs.2,000/-** (Rupees two thousand only) on the caterer.
- iii. For single complaints of uncleaned utensils in a day would lead to a fine of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) on the caterer.
- iv. If Canteen Committee agrees that certain meal was not cooked properly and also about the quality of food then a fine of **Rs.5,000/-** (Rupees Five thousand only) would be imposed on the caterer.
- v. Fine on any discrepancy (personal hygiene of workers, misbehaviour by workers etc.) will lead to fine of **Rs.2,000/-** (Rupees two thousand only) on caterer for every instance.
- vi. Absence of the proprietor or his representative in the Canteen Meeting on prior information will attract a fine of **Rs.5,000/-** (Rupees five thousand only) on caterer.
- vii. In case it is found that three such fines do not have any effect in abiding by the terms and conditions mentioned in the contract, the contract may be terminated finally after serving fifteen days notice by the Administration of AIIMS BHUBANESWAR to the Contractor. The notice during the trial period will be only one week.
- viii. Using of brands not mentioned in the contract without prior permission and adulteration shall invoke a hefty fine as decided by the committee.
- ix. Severity of hygiene failure shall be assessed and decided by the committee and fined appropriately. In case of gross failure/negligence a severe penalty will be imposed.
- x. Under no circumstances, food cooked at the DH (2) & Shops of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar shall be supplied to outside.
- xi. The successful vendor will engage adequate manpower with proper justifications and the same must be communicated to authority after award of the tender.

30. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

The Service provider will submit Monthly Feedback duly signed by the Committee in the prescribed format duly signed by the Food Safety Committee to the Helpdesk (S&P Dept.) and submit it by 5th of every month for record purpose.

If some problem exists for consecutive months, then the Caterer will be served with warning for Contract termination and penalty of Rs. 50,000/-.

If same problem exists for another month, then termination of contract notice shall be served.

- (i) The AIIMS, Bhubaneswar invites bid for selection of Canteen contractor to run **(I) One canteen (II) One Cafeteria and (III) One Shop attached to it in Dining Hall - 02.**
- (ii) The duration of the contract shall be initially for a period of One year from the date of award of contract and extendable up to another 1 (one year) on mutually agreeable terms & conditions. However, in case of any defaults or negligence under such contract, the committee may suggest to the AIIMS Bhubaneswar authority to impose fine or penalty against the vendor (Service Provider) or termination of the contract.
- (iii) Service providers having adequate experience in running same/similar type of Canteen/ Cafeteria/ Shop in only Government departments, reputed Public Sector Undertakings may apply along with sufficient proof of their experience and ability of running the canteens.

33. PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

A	The Vendor must have minimum 3 years of experience in the field of Canteen services at different Govt./ reputed public sector Educational Institutions. Supporting documents to be provided. C	Average Annual Turnover Certificate from the Chartered Accountant for last three years i.e. 2022-2023, 2023-2024 & 2024-25. (Annual turnover per year should be minimum Rs.3.00 Crores each year) from Canteen services from the Educational Institutes mentioned at Para-A, only.
D	The bidder must have successfully executed/completed Canteen Services, over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years: - 3. Three similar completed services with experience of serving not less than 300 plates of each Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner on each day; or 4. Two similar completed services with experience of serving not less than 400 plates of each Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner on each day; or 3. One similar completed service with experience of serving not less than 500 plates of each Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner on each day at the canteen at Govt./ Public Sector Undertaking. Certificate to that extent in the organization's letter head with issuing officers contact details should be provided.

34.SCOPE OF WORK AND GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

(i) The selected Caterers have to serve the food in the dining hall and packed food in the Academic Block, Hospital and Hostels as and when required. Space for cooking will be provided in the Dining Hall. The Contractor shall bear all the expenses towards the purchase of raw materials, serving of meals, collection of leftovers, disposal of dirt, purchase of brooms, floor/ area sanitizer like phenyl etc. for maintaining cleanliness of highest standard. Utensils, cooking gas required for cooking, and other crockery and cutlery shall have to be arranged by the contractor. The Contractor shall make his own arrangement for cooking gas, crockery, cutlery, glasses and other kitchen Service. Good quality paper made disposables should be used by the Contractor for serving tea/ coffee etc. instead of plastic materials. The Contractor shall use the commercial cooking gas cylinder and ISI marked Gas Stove for the purpose of cooking.

(ii) **The quality of service will be evaluated every month as per the checklist provided. Penalty of Rs. 5,000/- will be put on the vendor if the percentage of score remains below 80%.**

(iii) **The contract may be terminated by the Contractor after giving a notice of 03 (Three) months whereas AIIMS, Bhubaneswar can terminate the contract after giving one-month notice period.**

(iv) No compensation will be allowed due to fluctuation in the market rates of material and labour. There will be no escalation of rates of the different items as quoted during the contract period. The rates quoted by the contractor shall remain unchanged during the contract period.

(v) The Contractor, whose tender is accepted, has to sign an agreement on non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only) with AIIMS, Bhubaneswar within **30** days of issuance of Work order, failing which the earnest money deposited by him will be liable to be forfeited and treating the work order as cancelled.

(vi) The contract comprises the necessary arrangement of all raw materials required for preparation of breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks, beverages, sweets, preparation of items mentioned in Appendix A & B and serving the prepared food to students (**Approx. 800**) including provision of all materials, Service for preparation and serving of articles. This will also include transportation, cost of materials and labour charges. The contractor shall make his own arrangement for safe preservation (in refrigerator) of materials and accommodation for his staff etc. No employees of the contractor shall be allowed to reside in canteen premises. No staff member of the contractor is allowed to enter the hall premises between **12 AM and 5.00 AM. Any violation shall be dealt with a penalty of Rs. 20,000/- per instance in order to ensure no anti-social and criminal activity takes place after canteen timings.** Repeated offences shall be dealt strictly including cancellation of contract as per the discretion of the competent authority, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. In case of inescapability, a permission for the same should be taken from the competent authority.

(vii) The contractor shall maintain the quality of preparation of food, fresh availability of items, constant supply of cold drinking water & other beverages as per the canteen management committee requirement.

(viii) **A dietician will be nominated by the Competent Authority of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, to monitor and ensure the quality of food being served by the caterer. A monthly report regarding the quality of the food, hygiene standard maintained by the caterer, performance and other such complaints, if any, received from the inmates will be submitted by the dietician to Administration.**

(ix) The contractor shall maintain the working hours of Canteen as laid down by the Canteen Committee. The contractor will keep the premises clean as per the instructions of the canteen committee on its own cost. The garbage as generated will be suitably disposed of through mechanized manner and no garbage will be piled up for more than one day.

(x) The contractor shall maintain FULL HYGIENIC CONDITIONS in the Canteen, in the storage, preparation and serving of eatables and in keeping the floor, furniture, utensils, crockery, cutlery neat and clean, so as to maintain the standards and aesthetic values in the Canteen. Contractor should make arrangements for visible storage of prepared food in hygienic condition. The canteen and its premises shall be kept clean and tidy. The garbage, peel-offs etc. should be disposed of as per norms of Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation at the cost of the Contractor/ Caterer. **Smoking, tobacco chewing and intake of liquor is strictly prohibited.** Any violation will attract a fine of Rs. 5,000/- per instance.

(xi) The staff and the Caterer will have to be provided uniforms with ID cards by the Contractor during working hours and they will be required to wear the uniforms and cap during working hours positively. Such

persons should be free from contagious disease and maintain proper wearing of clean uniforms. No staff member below 18 years of age should be appointed by the Contractor as it is prohibited under the Law.

(xii) The contractor shall carry out the work in accordance with this contract. The Canteen should run in the name of '**AIIMS, Bhubaneswar Canteen (DH-2)**' and no other name should be used.

(xiii) The Canteen Committee or its members shall have every right to inspect the Canteen without any notice and can seal the canteen in case of violation of terms and conditions. The staff of the canteen shall be the sole staff of the contractor and no relationship of master and servant shall exist between AIIMS, Bhubaneswar and such staff.

(xiv) The Canteen should run during **the timings from 7.00AM to 11.00 PM**

(xv) The decision of the Competent Authority of the Institute with regard to any matters pertaining to the Canteen shall be final.

(xvi) The Canteen Contractor shall handover charge of all furniture, fixtures, fittings etc., in good condition to the Institute when the contract is closed.

(xvii) The Canteen Contractor shall pay the cost of damage, if any, caused to the premises, fixture, fittings etc., during the period of contract.

(xviii) The Canteen Committee may also authorize any other person of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar to inspect the central canteen.

(xix) The contract will be in force from the date of leasing the Canteen and expire on completion of contract period and no notice by Institute is necessary, otherwise a hefty penalty of Rs. 50,000/- may be charges per day till the Bank Guarantee (BG) gets exhausted and the eviction proceedings may be resorted to subsequently. The Canteen Contractor shall leave the Canteen premises with his employees immediately after completion of the specified date and shall not re-enter.

(xx) The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Bhubaneswar permits the Contractor to utilize the electrical and sanitary fittings, furniture, for the purpose of carrying out their obligations under this Agreement. However, any extra requirement to be arranged by the Vendor/ Contractor.

(xxi) AIIMS, Bhubaneswar reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof. The tenders which do not fulfil all or any of the above conditions or incomplete in any respect shall be liable to be rejected. Executive Director, AIIMS, BBBSR has the full and exclusive right to cancel the tender at any point of time without assigning any reasons thereof.

(xxii) The vendor must maintain a feedback register.

(xxiv) Seasonal Chutney will be served with items like samosa, kachori, all types of chats etc.

(xxv) Menu as decided by the mess/canteen committee will be strictly followed. Price of each item must be displayed on board in the designated places.

(Format of Integrity Pact) PRE CONTRACT INTEGRITY PACT

Between

AIIMS Bhubaneswar under Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India hereinafter referred to as “ The Buyer” which expression shall mean and include, unless the context otherwise requires, his successors in office and assigns of the **First Part**.

And

M/s _____, a company/ firm/ individual (status of the company) and having its registered office at represented by Shri __, hereinafter referred to as “The Bidder/Contractor” which expression shall mean and include, unless the context otherwise requires, his successors and permitted assigns of the **Second Part**.

WHEREAS the Buyer proposes to procure under laid down organizational procedures, contract/s for ----- (Name of the Tender/ goods/ services) and the Bidder/Contractor is willing to offer against NIT

No.

WHEREAS the Bidder/Contractor is a private company / public company/Government undertaking/partnership/consortium/joint venture constituted in accordance with the relevant law in the matter and the Buyer is a Public Sector Enterprise.

NOW, THEREFORE,

1. To avoid all forms of corruption by following a system that is fair, transparent and free from any influence/prejudiced dealings prior to, during and subsequent to the currency of the contract to be entered into with a view to:-

(a) Enabling the Buyer to obtain the desired said (Tender/ goods/ services) at a competitive price in conformity with the defined specifications by avoiding the high cost and the distortionary impact of corruption on public procurement, and enabling the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) to abstain from bribing or indulging in any corrupt practice in order to secure the contract by providing assurance to them that their competitors will also abstain from bribing and other corrupt practices and the Buyer will commit to prevent corruption, in any form, by its officials by following transparent procedures.

Commitments of the Employee:

1. The Buyer undertakes that no official of the Buyer, connected directly or indirectly with the contract, will demand, take a promise for or accept, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favour or any material or immaterial benefit or any other advantage from the Bidder/Contractor, either for themselves or for any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for an advantage in the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting or implementation process related to the contact.

2. The Buyer will, during the pre-contract stage, treat all the Bidders/Contractors alike, and will provide to all the Bidders/Contractors the same information and will not provide any such



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information to any particular Bidder/Contractor which could afford an advantage to that particular Bidder/Contractor in comparison to other Bidders/Contractors.

3. All the officials of the Buyer will report to the appropriate Authority any attempted or completed breaches of the above commitments as well as any substantial suspicion of such a breach. In case any such preceding misconduct on the part of such official(s) is reported by the Bidder to the Buyer with full and verifiable facts and the same is prima facie found to be correct by the Buyer, necessary disciplinary proceedings, or any other action as deemed fit, including criminal proceedings may be initiated by the Buyer or Independent External Monitor and such a person shall be debarred from further dealings related to the contract process. In such a case while an enquiry is being conducted by the Buyer the proceedings under the contract would not be stalled.

Commitments of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)

1. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commits themselves to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practices, unfair means and illegal activities during any stage of its bid or during any pre-contract or post-contract stage in order to secure the contract or in furtherance to secure it and in particular commit themselves to observe the following principles during participation in the tender process and during contract execution: -

(a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not offer, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, gift, consideration, reward, favor, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the Buyer, connected directly or indirectly with the bidding process, or to any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for any advantage in the bidding, evaluation, contracting and implementation of the contract.

(b) The Bidder/Contractor further undertakes that it has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly any bribe, gift consideration, reward, favor, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the Buyer or otherwise in procuring the Contract or forbearing to do or having done any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the contract or any other contract with Buyer for showing or forbearing to show favor or dis-favor to any person in relation to the contract or any other contract with Buyer.

(c) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) shall disclose the name and address of agents and representatives and Indian Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) shall disclose their foreign principals or associates.

(d) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) shall, when presenting their bid, disclose any /all payments made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries, in connection with this bid/award of the contract

(e) The Bidder, either while presenting their bid or during pre-contract negotiations or before signing the contract, shall disclose any payments made, is committed to or intends to make to officials of the Buyer or their family members, agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the contract and the details of services agreed upon for such payments.



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- (f) The Bidder/Contractor will not collude with other parties interested in the contract to impair the transparency, fairness and progress of the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting and implementation of the contract.
- (g) The Bidder/Contractor will not accept any advantage in exchange for any corrupt practice, unfair means and illegal activities.
- (h) The Bidder/Contractor shall not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information provided by the Buyer as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained in electronic data carrier. The Bidder/Contractor also undertakes to exercise due and adequate care lest any such information is divulged.
- (i) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commit to refrain from giving any complaint directly or through any other manner without supporting it with full and verifiable facts.
- (j) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) shall not instigate or cause to instigate any third person to commit any of the actions mentioned above.
- (k) If the Bidder/Contractor or any employee of the Bidder/Contractor or any person acting on behalf of the Bidder/Contractor, either directly or indirectly, is a relative of any of the officers of the Buyer, or alternatively, if any relative of an officer of the Buyer has financial interest/stake in the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) firm (excluding Public. Company listed on Stock Exchange), the same shall be disclosed by the Bidder/Contractor at the time of filling of tender.
- (l) The term 'relative' for this purpose would be as defined in Section 2(77) of the Companies Act 2013.
- (m) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) shall not lend to or borrow any money from or enter into any monetary dealings or transactions, directly or indirectly, with any employee of the Buyer.
- (n) The representative of the Bidders/Contractors signing Integrity Pact shall not approach the Courts while representing the matters to IEMs and he/she will wait their decision in the matter.
- (o) In case of Sub-Contracting, the bidder shall take the responsibility of the adoption of Integrity Pact by the Sub-Contractor.

Previous Transgression

2. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) declares that no previous transgression occurred in the last three years immediately before signing of this Integrity Pact, with any other company in any country in respect on any corrupt practices envisaged hereunder or with any Public Sector Enterprise in India or any Government Department in India.

Earnest Money (Security Deposit)

3. The provision regarding Earnest Money/Security Deposit as detailed in the Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) and Instruction to Bidders (ITB) section of the Bid Document is to be referred.

Sanctions for Violations

4. Any breach of the aforesaid provisions, before award or during execution by the Bidder/Contractor or any one employed by it or acting on its behalf such as to put their reliability or credibility in question. shall entitle the Buyer to take action as per the procedure mentioned in



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the “[Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings](#)” attached as **Appendix to Integrity pact** and initiate all or any one of the following actions, wherever required: -

- (i) To immediately call off the pre contract negotiations without assigning any reason or giving any compensation to the Bidder/Contractor. However, the proceedings with the other Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) would continue.
- (ii) The Earnest Money Deposit (in pre-contract stage) and/or Security Deposit/Performance Bond (after the contract is Signed) shall stand forfeited either fully or partially, as decided by the Buyer and the Buyer shall not be required to assign any reason thereof.
- (iii) To immediately cancel the contract, if already signed, without giving any compensation to the Contractor. The Bidder/Contractor shall be liable to pay compensation for any loss or damage to the Buyer resulting from such cancellation/rescission and the Buyer shall be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from the money(s) due to the Bidder/Contractor.
- (iv) To encash the Bank guarantee, in order to recover the dues if any by the Buyer, along with interest as per the provision of contract.
- (v) To debar the Bidder/Contractor from participating in future bidding processes of AIIMS Bhubaneswar, as per provisions of “Guidelines on Banning of Business Dealings” of AIIMS Bhubaneswar. (**Appendix to Integrity pact**), which may be further extended at the discretion of the Buyer.
- (vi) To recover all sums paid in violation of this Pact by Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) to any middleman or agent or broker with a view to securing the contract.
- (vii) In cases where irrevocable Letters of Credit have been received in respect of any contract signed by the Buyer with the Bidder/ Contractor, the same shall not be opened/operated.
- (viii) Forfeiture of Performance Security in case of a decision by the Buyer to forfeit the same without assigning any reason for imposing sanction for violation of this Pact.
- (ix) The Buyer will be entitled to take all or any of the actions mentioned at para 6.1 (i) to (x) of this Pact also on the Commission by the Bidder/Contractor or any one employed by it or acting on its behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Bidder/Contractor), of an offence as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 or any other statute enacted for prevention of corruption.
- (x) The decision of the Buyer to the effect that a breach of the provisions of this Pact has been committed by the Bidder/Contractor shall be final and conclusive on the Bidder/Contractor. However, the Bidder/Contractor can approach the Independent External Monitor(s) appointed for the purposes of this Pact.

Independent External Monitor(s)

5. The Buyer has appointed Independent External Monitors (hereinafter referred to as monitors) for this Pact after approval by the Central Vigilance Commission.

- (i) The task of the Monitors shall be to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this Pact.



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- (ii) The Monitors shall not be subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and perform their functions neutrally and independently. The Monitor reports to Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar.
- (iii) Both the parties accept that the Monitors have the right to access all the Contract documents relating to the project/procurement, including minutes of meetings, whenever required. The right to access records should only be limited to the extent absolutely necessary to investigate the issue related to the subject tender/contract.
- (iv) As soon as the Monitor notices, or has reason to believe, a violation of this Pact, he / she will so inform Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar and request AIIMS Bhubaneswar to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- (v) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction, to all Project documentation of the Buyer including that provided by the Bidder/Contractor. The Bidder/Contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his / her request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to their project documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractor(s). The Monitor shall be under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder/Contractor/Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality. The Monitor has also signed declaration on 'Non-Disclosure Agreement' and of 'Absence of Conflict of Interest'. In case of any conflict of interest arising at a later date, the IEM shall inform Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar and recuse himself / herself from that case.
- (vi) The Buyer will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the parties. The parties will offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings as and when required.
- (vii) The Monitor will submit a written report to the Executive Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar, within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Buyer/Bidder and should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.

Facilitation of Investigation

6. In case of any allegation of violation of any provisions of this Pact or payment of commission, the Buyer or its agencies shall be entitled to examine all the documents including the Books of Accounts of the Bidder/Contractor and the Bidder/Contractor shall provide necessary information and documents in English and shall extend all possible help for the purpose of such examination.

Law and Place of Jurisdiction

8. This Pact is subject to Indian Law. The place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Buyer, i.e. Bhubaneswar (Odisha). The arbitration clause provided in the tender document/contract shall not be applicable for any issue/dispute arising under Integrity Pact.



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Other Legal Actions

9. The actions stipulated in this Integrity Pact are without prejudice to any other legal action that may follow in accordance with the provisions of the extant law in force relating to any civil or criminal proceedings.
10. Changes and supplements as well as termination notice need to be made in writing. If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium or a joint venture, this pact must be signed by all partners of the consortium/joint venture.

Validity

11. The validity of this Integrity Pact shall be from date of its signing and expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the contract, and for all other Bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded. Any violation of the same would entail disqualification of the bidders and exclusion from business dealings.
12. Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this Pact shall remain valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intention.
13. Issues like Warranty / Guarantee etc. shall be outside the purview of IEMs.
14. In the event of any contradiction between Integrity Pact and its Appendix, the clause in the Integrity Pact will prevail.

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Appendix - 'II'

GUIDELINES ON BANNING OF BUSINESS DEALINGS

Introduction

1. AIIMS Bhubaneswar deals with Agencies viz. parties/ contractors/ suppliers/ bidders, who are expected to adopt ethics of highest standards and a very high degree of integrity, commitments and sincerity towards the Tender undertaken. It is not in the interest of AIIMS Bhubaneswar to deal with Agencies who commit deception, fraud or other misconduct in the tendering process and/or during execution of Tender undertaken. AIIMS Bhubaneswar is committed for timely completion of the Projects within the awarded value without compromising on quality.
2. Since suspension/ banning of business dealings involves civil consequences for an Agency concerned, it is incumbent that adequate opportunity of hearing is provided and the explanation, if tendered, is considered before passing any order in this regard keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case.

Scope

1. AIIMS Bhubaneswar reserves its rights to remove from list of approved suppliers / contractors (if such list exists) or to Suspend/Ban Business Dealings if any Agency has been found to be non / poor performing or have committed misconduct or fraud or anything unethical or any of its action(s) which falls into any such grounds as laid down in this policy.
2. The procedure of (i) Removal of Agency from the List of approved suppliers / contractors; (ii) Suspension and (iii) Banning of Business Dealing with Agencies, has been laid down in these guidelines.
3. These guidelines shall apply to all the units of AIIMS Bhubaneswar.
4. The suspension/banning except suspension/banning under Integrity Pact shall be with prospective effect, i.e. future business dealings.
5. "Investigating Committee" shall mean a Committee appointed by Competent Authority to conduct investigation.

Initiation of Banning / Suspension

1. Action for Suspension / Banning Business Dealings with any Agency shall be initiated by the department responsible for invitation of Bids/Engineer-in-charge after noticing the irregularities or misconduct on the part of Agency concerned.
2. Besides the concerned department, Vigilance Department of each Unit/ Corporate Vigilance may also be competent to initiate such action.

Suspension of Business Dealings

1. If the conduct of any Agency dealing with AIIMS Bhubaneswar is under investigation, the Competent Authority may consider whether the allegations (under investigation) are of a serious nature and whether pending investigation, it would be advisable to continue business dealing with the Agency.



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2. If the Competent Authority, decides that it would not be in the interest to continue business dealings pending investigation, it may suspend business dealings with the Agency.
3. The order of suspension would operate for a period not more than six months and may be communicated to the Agency as also to the Investigating Committee. The Investigating Committee may ensure that their investigation is completed and whole process of final order is over within such period.
4. However if the investigations are not completed within six months, the investigation committee shall put up the proposal to the competent authority for approval of extension of time maximum up to further three months with in which the committee shall conclude the proceedings.
5. The order of suspension shall be effective throughout AIIMS Bhubaneswar in case of Tender falling in the Competency of Executive Director.
6. If the Agency concerned asks for detailed reasons of suspension, the Agency may be informed that its conduct is under investigation. It is not necessary to enter into correspondence or argument with the Agency at this stage.
7. It is not necessary to give any show-cause notice or personal hearing to the Agency before issuing the order of suspension.
8. The format for intimation of suspension of business dealing is placed at **Appendix – III**.

Ground on which Banning of Business Dealings can be initiated

1. If the security consideration, including questions of loyalty of the Agency to AIIMS Bhubaneswar so warrants;
2. If the director /owner of the Agency, proprietor or partner of the firm, is convicted by a Court of Law for offences involving moral turpitude in relation to its business dealings with the Government or any other public sector enterprises, during the last five years;
3. If the Agency has resorted to Corrupt, Fraudulent, Collusive, Coercive practices including misrepresentation of facts and violation of the any provisions of the Integrity Pact provided in the Contract.
4. If the Agency uses intimidation / threatening or brings undue outside pressure on AIIMS Bhubaneswar or its official for acceptance / performances of the job under the contract;
5. If the Agency misuses the premises or facilities of AIIMS Bhubaneswar, forcefully occupies or damages the AIIMS Bhubaneswar's properties including land, water resources, forests / trees or tampers with documents/records etc.
6. If the Agency does not fulfil the obligations as required under the Contract and Violates terms & conditions of the contract which has serious affect for continuation of the Contract.
7. If the Tender awarded to the agency has been terminated by AIIMS Bhubaneswar due to poor performance of the contract in the preceding 5 years.
8. If the Central Vigilance Commission, Central Bureau of Investigation or any other Central Government investigation Agency recommends such a course in respect of a case under



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investigation or improper conduct on agency's part in matters relating to the institute (AIIMS Bhubaneswar) or even otherwise;

9. On any other ground upon which business dealings with the Agency is not in the public interest.

10. If business dealings with the Agency have been banned by the Ministry of Power, Government of India OR any PSU/ any other authority under the MOP if intimated to AIIMS Bhubaneswar or available on MOP Website, the business dealing with such agencies shall be banned with immediate effect for future business dealing except banning under Integrity Pact without any further investigation.

(Note: The examples given above are only illustrative and not exhaustive. The Competent Authority may decide to ban business dealing for any good and sufficient reason).

Procedure for Banning of Business Dealings

1. An Investigating Committee shall be constituted by the authority competent to Ban the dealing comprising members from Purchase/Engineering/Indenting department (convener), Finance, Law and Contract. The level of the committee members shall be Executive Director and above members (as applicable) for Tenders falling in the competency of Executive Director.

2. The order of Banning of Business Dealings shall be effective throughout the AIIMS Bhubaneswar. During the period of Banning of Business Dealings, no Business Dealing shall be held with the Agency.

3. The functions of Investigating Committee in each Unit to be appointed by the competent authority in line with para 3 (iii) shall, inter-alia include:

(a) To study the report of the department responsible for invitation of bids and decide if a prima-facie case for banning exists, if not, send back the case to the Competent Authority.

(b) To recommend for issue of show-cause notice (after vetting by legal dept.) to the Agency by the concerned department as per clause 7.4 "Show Cause Notice".

(c) To examine the reply to show-cause notice and call the Agency for personal hearing, if required.

(d) To submit final recommendations to the Competent Authority for banning or otherwise including the period for which the ban would be operative considering the implications for AIIMS BHUBANESWAR on account of the act/ omission on the part of the agency, intention of the agency as established from the circumstances of the case etc.

Show Cause Notice

1. Once the proposal for issuance of Show Cause Notice is approved by the Competent Authority, a 'Show Cause Notice' (as per format at **Appendix -IV** of these guidelines) shall be issued to the delinquent Agency by the Competent Authority or by a person authorized by the Competent Authority for the said purpose. The Agency shall be asked to submit the reply to the Show Cause Notice within 15 days of its issuance. Further, the Agency shall be given an opportunity for Oral hearing to present its case in person, if it so desires, and the date for Oral Hearing shall necessarily be indicated in the Show Cause Notice.



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2. The purpose of issuing the Show Cause Notice is only that the Agency concerned shall be given an opportunity to explain their stand before any action is taken. The grounds on which action is proposed to be taken shall be disclosed to the Agency inviting representation and after considering that representation, orders may be passed. Such orders require only the satisfaction of the authority that passed the final orders.
3. If the Agency requests for inspection of any relevant document in possession of AIIMS BHUBANESWAR, necessary facility for inspection of documents may be provided. During the conductance of oral hearing, only the regular duly authorized employees of Agency will be permitted to represent the Agency and no outsider shall be allowed to represent the Agency on its behalf.
4. Reply to the Show Cause Notice given by the Agency and their submissions in oral hearing, if any, will be processed by the Committee for obtaining final decision of the Competent Authority in the matter.
5. In case, no reply to Show Cause Notice is received from the Agency within stipulated time, further reminder shall be given with further period of 10 days thereafter if no reply is received action for processing ex-parte against the concerned Agency shall be initiated.

Speaking Order

1. The speaking order (reasoned order) for banning the business dealing with the Agency shall be issued by the Competent Authority or by a person authorized for the said purpose.
2. The decision regarding banning of business dealings taken after the issue of a Show Cause Notice and consideration of representation, if any, in reply thereto, shall be communicated to the Agency concerned along with a reasoned order.
3. The fact that the representation has been considered shall invariably be mentioned in the communication. Also the fact that if no reply was received to the Show Cause Notice shall invariably be indicated in the final communication to the Agency. The format for intimation of banning of business dealing is placed at **Appendix– V**.

Period of banning

1. In case banning is processed for violation of provisions of Integrity pact or due to corrupt or fraudulent practices, the competent authority shall decide on the period of banning on case to case basis depending on the gravity of the case and considering the implications for AIIMS BHUBANESWAR on account of the act/ omission on the part of the Agency, intention of the Agency as established from the circumstances of the case etc. The period of banning shall not be less than 6 months and shall not exceed 2 years and in case termination of contract due to poor performance the period of banning shall be for 5 years. For contracts awarded to JV/Consortium, a constituent of the JV shall be permitted to participate in the bidding process if it has not been banned on grounds of its role and responsibility in the tendering process for which the Joint Venture has been banned in Past. In case if the Joint Venture which has been banned does not indicate the roles and responsibility of individual Partner(s) then, the partner of the banned Joint Venture shall only be allowed to participate in the bidding process if its participation share is less than 35%.



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2. In case the information/documents submitted by Agency in competing for the tender found to be false/forged then AIIMS Bhubaneswar, without prejudice to any other rights or remedies it may possess, shall recover from Agency the cost incurred in carrying out physical assessment for establishing veracity of such information/documents. In case Agency refuses to reimburse such cost to AIIMS BHUBANESWAR then banning period of Agency shall be extended by another one year.

Effect of Banning:

1. As far as possible, the existing ongoing contract(s) with the Agency may continue unless the Competent Authority, having regard to the circumstances of the case, decides otherwise, keeping in view contractual and legal issues which may arise thereof. In case the existing Contracts are allowed to continue, the suspension/Banning of Business Dealing along with default of the Contractor shall be recorded in the experience certificate issued for the Tender.

2. The Agency, (after issue of the order of banning of business dealings) would not be allowed to participate in any future tender enquiry and if the Agency has already participated in tender process as stand-alone OR constituent of joint venture and the price bids are not opened, his techno-commercial bid will be rejected and price bid will be returned unopened. However, where the price bids of Agency have been opened prior to order of banning, bids of Agency shall not be rejected and tendering process shall be continued unless Competent Authority having regard to the circumstances of the case decides otherwise keeping in view the Contractual, Legal issues which may arise thereafter. However, in case the suspension /Banning is due to default of an Agency for the provisions under Integrity Pact and the Agency happens to be Lowest Bidder (L1), the tendering process shall be annulled and fresh tenders shall be invited.

3. During the Suspension/ Banning period, if it is found at any stage that Agency has participated in tender enquiry under a different name then such Agency would immediately be debarred from the tender/contract and its Bid Security/Performance Security would be forfeited. Payment, if any, made shall also be recovered.

4. After Suspension/ Banning order, the Suspended/ Banned Agency shall not be allowed to participate as Sub-Vendor/Sub-Contractor in the tenders.

5. Further, if the Suspended/ Banned agency is an approved Sub-Vendor under any Contract for such Service/component/service, the Main Contractor shall not be permitted to place Tender order/Purchase order/Contract on the Suspended/ Banned agency as a Sub-Vendor /Sub-Contractor after the date of Suspension/ Banning even though the name of the party has been approved as a Sub- Vendor /Sub-Contractor earlier.

6. There would be no bar on procuring the spares and awarding Contracts towards Annual Maintenance (AMC)/ O&M/ Repair Tenders on Agencies pertaining to the packages for which they have been banned provided the Service has been supplied by such Agency.

7. Banning of business dealing shall not be applicable to the Subsidiary Company of the Banned agency provided subsidiary company has not participated on the strength of the Banned agency. However, in case of a default by a Subcontractor, the banning shall be applicable to the Sub-Contractor as well as the Lead Partner of the concerned JV or the Sole bidder as the case may be.

Hosting at AIIMS Bhubaneswar website



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1. The concerned unit shall forward the name and details of the Agency (ies) banned along with period and reasons of banning to the _____ for displaying the same on the AIIMS Bhubaneswar website.

Appeals against the Decision of the Competent Authority

The Agency may file an appeal against the order of the Competent Authority banning of business dealing before Appellate Authority. Such an appeal shall be preferred within 30 (Thirty) Days from the date of receipt of the order of banning of business dealing. Appellate Authority would consider the appeal if convinced may constitute another committee for further investigation. The investigation committee constituted by the appellate Authority shall study the report of the previous investigating committee and replies submitted by the Agency while filing its case for appeal and call the agency for personal hearing, if requested by the agency. Based on the recommendation of the committee Appellate Authority shall pass appropriate Speaking (Reasoned) order in line with Sub-Para 7.5 above which shall be communicated to the Appellate Agency as well as the Competent Authority (as per format enclosed as **Appendix-VI** with these guidelines).

Circulation of the names of Agencies with whom Business Dealings have been banned

The name of the concerned banned agency shall also be shared with MOP and other PSU in the sector and all the units of AIIMS Bhubaneswar.

The provisions of this policy supersede and will have overriding effect on all earlier guidelines, procedures & system issued for the similar purpose.

- (ii) During the period of Suspension, no business dealing shall be held with your firm. No enquiry / bid / tender shall be issued to your firm nor will the bids submitted by your firm be entertained.
- (iii) In cases where tenders have already been issued to you and price bids are yet to be opened, the Price Bid submitted by you shall not be opened and BG/EMD, if any, submitted by you shall be returned.
- (iv) In cases where tenders have already been issued to you and Price Bids have already been opened, the tendering process shall be continued
- (v) In case of ongoing contracts between you & AIIMS BHUBANESWAR, (including cases where contract has already been awarded before the issue of Suspension order) you will be required to continue with the execution and perform as per terms of the contract.



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(vi) In case the Firm is in Joint Venture the following would also be applicable:

Participation of Agency in Joint Venture

1. Tenders in which your firm has been proposed as Joint Venture Partner by any of the bidders and price bids have been opened prior to Suspension of your firm in such cases the tendering process shall not be annulled on this ground and the Agency shall be permitted to continue as Partner in the Joint Venture for such bidding.
2. However, where event of Price Bid opening has not taken place prior to Suspension/Banning of Agency then in such case Agency shall not be permitted to participate as Partner in the Joint Venture.

Banning of joint Venture:

1. As the Joint Venture is Banned, your firm intends to bid as Partner(s) of Joint Venture in bidding process then it shall be permitted to participate in the bidding process if it has not been Banned on grounds of its role and responsibility in the tendering process for which the Joint Venture has been Banned in Past. In case if the Joint Venture which has been Banned does not indicate the roles and responsibility of individual Partner(s) then, the partner of the Banned Joint Venture shall only be allowed to participate in the bidding process if its participation share is less than 35%.
2. Your firm shall not be allowed to participate as Sub-Vendor/Sub-Contractor in the tenders.
3. Further if your firm is an approved Sub-vendor under any Contract for such Service/component/service, the Main Contractor shall not be permitted to place Tender order/Purchase order/Contract on your agency as a Sub-Vendor/Sub-Contractor after the date of Suspension/ Banning even though the name of the party has been approved as a Sub-Vendor/Sub- Contractor earlier.
4. There would be no bar on procuring the spares and awarding Contracts towards Annual Maintenance (AMC)/ O&M/ Repair Tenders on Agencies pertaining to the packages for which they have been banned provided the Service has been supplied by such Agency.
5. Banning of business dealing shall not be applicable to the Subsidiary company of the Banned agency provided subsidiary company has not participated on the strength of the Banned agency.
6. On expiry of the above period of Suspension/Banning, you may approach, (*Indicate the concerned procurement department*), with request for revocation of the order mentioning inter-alia the steps taken by you to avoid recurrence of misconduct which has led to Suspension.

Also the fact that if no reply to the show cause notice was received or request for personal hearing was not made shall invariably be indicated in the communication to the agency. The above order shall mention the



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grounds considering violation of any provision of Integrity Pact, any ground mentioned in Guidelines of Banning of Business Dealings, default by the agency under fraudulent practice / or any unethical practice and / or violation of any provision of Tender / Contract condition having serious implications.)

This order shall have the following effects:

5. Further business dealings with your firm are banned with immediate effect. The order of Banning would operate for a period of ____years/month Competent Authority may extend the period of Banning.
6. During the period of Banning, no Business Dealing shall be held with your firm. No Enquiry/ Bid/ Tender shall be issued to your firm nor will the bids submitted by your firm be entertained.
7. In cases where tenders have already been issued to you and Price Bids are yet to be opened, the Price Bid submitted by you shall not be opened and BG/EMD, if any, submitted by you shall be returned.
8. In cases where tenders have already been issued to you and price bids have already been opened, the Tendering Process shall be continued.
9. In case of ongoing contracts between you & AIIMS BHUBANESWAR, (including cases where contract has already been awarded before the issue of banning order) you will be required to continue with the execution and perform as per terms of the contract.
10. In case the Firm is in Joint Venture the following would also be applicable.

2. In case if the Joint Venture which has been banned does not indicate the roles and responsibility of individual Partner(s) then, the partner of the banned Joint Venture shall only be allowed to participate in the bidding process if its participation share is less than 35%.



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3. Your firm shall not be allowed to participate as Sub-Vendor/Sub-Contractor in the tenders. Further if your firm is an approved Sub-vendor under any Contract for such Service/component/service, the Main Contractor shall not be permitted to place Tender Order/Purchase Order/Contract on your agency as a Sub Vendor/Sub-Contractor after the date of Banning even though the name of the party has been approved as a Sub-Vendor/Sub-Contractor earlier.
