Item Rate Bids are invited on behalf of the Director, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar from approved and eligible Contractors of CPWD, BSNL, MES & State PWD registered contractors of appropriate class in **Two Bid System** for the following work:

1. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of Tender document carefully. He should only submit his bid if he consider himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents/certificates required.

2. Information and instructions for bidders posted on web site shall form part of bid document.

3. The bid documents consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and these to of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website www.aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in.

4. But the **Bid can only be submitted after depositing** (Non-Refundable, **Cost of Tender Paper**) for **Rs 1,000/-** (Rupees **ONE THOUSAND** only) in favor of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar in form of Demand Draft.

5. The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of sale of Tenders. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended; the contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids. Incase both the last date of receipt of application and sale of Tenders are extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on either of the two dates i.e. original date of sale of Tender or on the extended date of sale of Tenders.

6. The authority competent to approve NIT for the combined cost and belonging to the Major discipline will consolidate NITs for calling the bids. He will also nominate a committee which will deal with all matters relating to the invitation of bids. For composite bid, besides indicating the combined estimated cost put to bid, should clearly indicate the estimated cost of each component separately. The eligibility of bidders will correspond to the combined estimated cost of different components put to bid.

7 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:-

(a) **Criteria of eligibility for contractors.** 03 (Three) similar works (Civil Works) each of value **not less than 40%** (i.e. for Rs. 20,00,000/-) or 02 (Two) similar work (Civil Works) each of value **not less than 50%** (i.e. Rs. 25,00,000/-) or 01 (One) similar work (Civil Works) of value **not less than 80%** (i.e. Rs. 40,00,000/-) in last 05 (Five) Years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which the tenders are invited.

(b) The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 07% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bid.

8. **To become eligible for issue of bid, contractors shall have to furnish an affidavit as under :-**

"I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee".

9. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form of AIIMS, BHUBANESWAR which is available on website www.aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in. Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.

10. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **Three (03) Calendar months** from the date of start as defined in schedule "F" or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.

11. The site for the work is available.

12. The Tender should be submitted in 02 (Two) parts i.e. Technical Bid & Financial Bid. The Technical Bid and the Financial Bid should be sealed by the Bidder in 02 (Two) separate Covers superscripted with name of work in both the envelopes as "**Technical Bid**" and "**Financial Bid**" respectively. Both sealed envelopes should be kept in a main/bigger envelope superscripted as "**Tender for Provision & Fixing of Aluminium Mosquito Net with Sliding Aluminium Windows in all Corridors of Hospital Complex, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar**". All the document(s) should be properly tagged with page reference have to be quoted on the Index Sheet.

(a) **Envelope - 1.** Consisting of **(Technical Bid)** as follows (Refer Page 13) :-

(b) **Envelope - 2.** Consisting of **Financial Part** of Tender (Refer Page 28).

- (c) All the above 02(Two) Envelopes (i.e. Envelope - 1 & 2) shall **be put in 03rd Covering Envelope** and must be **“superscripted”** with the subject Tender (i.e. name of the work).
- (d) The Bidder(s)/Tenderer should also furnish their Office Address along with contact number on all the three Envelope(s) for reference.
- (e) The Tender paper/documents can be downloaded from Official website & submitted through speed Post/Courier Services or can be dropped on Tender Box available in Office of Executive Engineer (Civil), 1st Floor, academic Block, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar-751019. For any query, Executive Engineer (Civil), AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, Phone : 0674 - 2476068 may be contacted. Also if required a Pre-Bid Meeting shall be held. The date of which will be intimated through Official Website.
13. (a) **Tender Processing Fee : Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees ONE THOUSAND only) (Non Refundable)** shall payable to AIIMS, BHUBANESWAR through Demand Draft (DD)/Bankers Cheque (BC).
- (b) **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) : Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees ONE LAKH only)** shall payable to AIIMS, BHUBANESWAR through Demand Draft (DD)/Bankers Cheque (BC).
14. Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents like PAN Card issued by I/T department, Certificate of EPF registration(for works estimated cost put to tender above 5.00lakhs),VAT clearance to be deposited within the period of bid submission. However, certified copy of all documents as specified in NIT shall have to be submitted.
15. The bids submitted shall be opened **at 1530 hours on 23rd Mar 2017.**
16. The bid submitted shall be come invalid and cost of Tender processing fee shall not be refunded if :-
- (a) The bidders are found in eligible.
- (b) The bidders do not submit all the documents as stipulated in the bid document.
17. **The successful Contractor will** require furnishing a **Performance Guarantee of 05% (Five Percent) of Contract Value** after receiving notification of award, in the form of Demand Draft/Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any nationalized Bank duly pledged in the name of “All India Medical Science, Bhubaneswar” which shall be **kept valid for a period of 60 (Sixty) days beyond completion of all the Contractual Obligations.** The Security Deposit can be forfeited by order of this Institute in the event of any breach of negligence or non-observance of any condition of Contract or for unsatisfactory performance or non-observance of any condition of the Contract. Performance Security will be discharged after completion of Contractor’s Performance Obligations (including Warranty/Guarantee Period) under the Contract. In case the Contractor fails to deposit the said Performance Guarantee within the period including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the Contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the Contractor. The format for Performance Security/Bank Guarantee (Page 27 refers) is as per Appendix ‘A’.
18. Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the mean suffices to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

19. The Competent Authority on behalf of Director, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar does not bind itself accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
20. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
21. The Competent Authority on behalf of Director, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
22. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
23. The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of opening of financial bid incase bids are invited on 02/03 bid system if any bidders withdraws his bid before the said period or issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the said earnest money as aforesaid. Further the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the re-bidding process of the work. This notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidders/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of :-
- (a) The Notice Inviting Bid, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the bid at the time of invitation of bid and the rates quoted at the time of submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
 - (b) Standard and make C.P.W.D. Form 7/8 or other Standard and make C.P.W.D. Form as applicable.
24. Delayed/Late/Conditional quotations/Tenders shall not be accepted at all.
25. Security Deposit equal to 05% of the Contract Value will be deducted from the Bills of the Contractor @ 05% of Bill amount.
26. (a) The Income Tax as applicable shall be deducted from the Bill unless exempted by the Income Tax Department.
- (b) VAT @ 04% will be deducted from the Bill.
 - (c) Labour Cess @ 01% will be deducted from the Bill.
27. After the evaluation of the Bid(s), AIIMS, Bhubaneswar will award the contract to the lowest evaluated responsive tenderer. Conditional Bid will be treated as unresponsive and will be rejected.
28. All the work shall be completed within **03 (Three) Months** from the date of issue of work Order by the Institute. All the aspects of safe installation shall be the exclusive responsibility of the Contractor. If the contractor fails to complete the work on or before the stipulated date, than a penalty at the Rate of 0.50% per week of the total order value shall be levied subject to maximum of 10% of the total order value.

29. All arbitration shall be held in accordance with the provision of the arbitration and conciliation Act-1996 and the venue of arbitration shall be at Bhubaneswar. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the Parties.
30. The Technical Bid(s) shall be opened first in presence of Representatives of Bidders **on 23rd Mar 2017** at 1530hours. Financial Bid of Bidders, whose Technical Bid is found to be eligible, will be opened later in presence of Bidders or the Representatives. The Date & Time of opening of Financial Bid will be intimated to eligible Bidder(s) in time. After the evaluation of the Bid(s), AIIMS, Bhubaneswar will award the contract to the lowest evaluated responsive tenderer. Conditional Bid will be treated as unresponsive and will be rejected.
31. Any disputes are subject to exclusive jurisdiction of Competent Court and Forum in Bhubaneswar (Odisha), India only.
32. Bidder shall submit a copy of the Tender Document and Addendum/Corrigendum thereof if any, with each page of this document should signed and stamped to confirm the acceptance of the entire Terms & conditions as mentioned in the Tender Enquiry document.
33. All the work should be done as per CPWD Specification and relevant Codes.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Name of Work : **Provision of Aluminium Mosquito Net with sliding Aluminium Windows in all corridors of Hospital Complex, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.**

1. **Discrepancy between Specifications.** In case of discrepancy in the specifications or any other matter, the matter shall be brought by the contractor to the notice of the Engineer-in-Charge for further decision.
2. **Contractor to employ Qualified Supervisor.** The contractor shall employ Skilled Supervisor to supervise and execute the work.
3. **Inconvenience to the Public.** The Contractor shall not deposit or store any materials at any site without permission of the Engineer. The materials will be stored at such places only with prior approval of the Engineer as there is no obstruction in Traffic or other Agencies.
4. **The provision against Accident & Safety Measures.**
 - (a) The Contractor will take all necessary precautions against a Fire during the course of his work and will ensure the work against Fire at his own cost.
 - (b) He will also take all care against likely damage of Floor, Walls, Doors, Windows or any part of the Building. In case of any damage or loss, the contractor has to make good at his own cost.
5. **Specifications.** In the absence of specifications for any work or material, relevant Indian Standard (ISI) Specification shall be applicable.
6. **Cleaning the Site.** The site described and shown on the plans, shall be cleared off all the rubbish of all kinds etc. complete. After completion of the work and the site shall be handed over in neat and clean condition.
7. **Secrecy.** In a view to safeguard the Secrets & Confidential information relating to All India Institute of Medical Science, Bhubaneswar, the Tenderer binds himself and his successors to secrecy & contracts to bind to secrecy of his Officials, Managers, Technical Senior Staff & all other staff directly or indirectly concerned in or whom have to acquire information relation to the AIIMS, Bhubaneswar equipment and the Tenderer shall access to any such information.
8. **Security Rules.** The Contractor shall follow at Site Security rules regarding removal of materials from site, issue of materials from site, issue of materials from stores, issue of Identity Card etc., as may be framed from time to time by the Engineer. It is to note that the Security Section is empowered to carry out the checks.
9. **Care in case of occupied buildings.** Tenderer may also note that when the subject work is to be carried out in the premises of occupied residential and other buildings which are already under occupation, all care shall be taken to protect personal and/or Government materials fixtures, appliances, equipment's etc. In case of any damage to any of the existing arrangements, contractor is liable to do such work to its original and/or shall be liable to pay the cost of such damages/losses. The work shall be carried in close co-ordination with occupants of these buildings without any hindrance and interruption.

10. **Supply of Tools, Tackles & other materials.** For full completion of the work, Contractor shall at his own expense arrange and furnish all necessary work tools, tackles, scaffolding, tagaries, mugs, scrappers, wire brushes etc., that may be required to complete the work under contract.
11. **Inspection of Work.** Engineer or any person appointed by them shall have access and right to inspect the work, or any part thereof at all times and places during the progress of the work. The inspection and supervision is for the purpose of assuring owner and/or Engineer and their representative will extend to contractor all desired assistance in interpreting the plans and specifications, all such assistance shall not relieve contractor from any responsibility for the work. Contractor without delay shall correct any work, which proves faulty.
12. Contractor shall take all precautionary measures to avoid any damages to adjoining property. All necessary arrangement shall be made at his own cost.
13. The contractor shall take instructions from the Engineer-in-Charge regarding collection and stacking of materials at any place. No excavated earth or building rubbish shall be stacked on areas where other buildings, roads, services and compound walls are to be constructed.
14. Normally, Contractors shall not be allowed to work at night. Work at night shall, however, be allowed if the site condition/circumstances so demand. However, if the work is carried out in more than one shift or at night, no claim on this account shall be entertained. In such situations, the Contractor shall make available to the department in proper means of transport such as vehicle at his own cost.
15. The contractor shall be responsible for the procurement of all the materials required to complete the work.
16. The work included in this Contract consists of **“Provision of Aluminium Mosquito Net with sliding Aluminium Windows in all corridors of Hospital Complex, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar”** with extruded built up standards sections, appropriate Z Sections and other sections of approved make with float glass sheet of nominal thickness of 5mm and Aluminium Mosquito Net.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

Name of Work : **Provision of Aluminium Mosquito Net with sliding Aluminium Windows in all corridors of Hospital Complex, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.**

1. The work shall be carried out in accordance with CPWD Specifications Volume I & II and as per direction of Engineer-in-Charge.
2. Approval of the Engineer-in-Charge shall be taken well in advance for the materials to be used in the work by the contractor.
3. All repairs and patch work shall be neatly carried out to match with the original finish and to the entire satisfaction of Engineer-in-Charge. Any damage done to the building during the execution of Civil Work shall be the responsibility of the contractor and the same will be made good immediately at his own cost to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-Charge. Any expenditure incurred by the department in this connection shall be recovered from the contractor and decision of the Engineer-in-Charge about recovery shall be final.
4. The contractor has to make his own arrangement for store sand watch & ward and no extra claim for this will be entertained.
5. The contractor has to make his own arrangement at his own cost for the entire general and special T & P required on the work.
6. All the debris due to the Civil Works shall be removed from the site by the contractor as soon as the work is completed. Similarly, rejected materials should be immediately cleared from the site by the contractor. **Otherwise, a recovery @500/- per day shall be made.**
7. Central/state sales tax/contract tax excise duty, LABOUR CEss, etc. should be included as applicable in the rates tendered. Statutory deduction of contract tax at source shall be made while releasing payment through running/final bills. Recovery @ 01% on account of Labor Welfare CASS, ITDS, S.D. shall be made from the contractor's bill.
8. Work shall be carried out without causing any inconvenience to the occupants.
9. The materials used in the work shall be of approved make as per following list **and** shall be got approved from Engineer-in-Charge before use at site.
10. If the contract or fails to maintain the required progress to complete the work and clear the site on or before the contractor extended date of completion, he shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available under the law to the Government on account of such breach, pay as agreed compensation the amount calculated at the rates stipulated below as the authority specified in schedule 'F' (whose decision in writing shall be final and binding) may decide on the amount of tendered value of the work for every completed day/month (as applicable) or that the work remains incomplete. This will also apply to items or group of items for which a separate period of completion has been specified. Liquidated Damage @ 0.50% per week, will be claimed from the **Service Provider** for delay of work, to be computed on per day basis provided always that the total amount of Liquidated Damage for delay to be paid under this condition **shall not exceed 10%** of the Tendered Value.

SPECIFICATION

Preamble of General Specifications.

1. The work shall be carried out in accordance to the specifications where specifically mentioned or not No Extra in any form will be paid unless it is definitely stated as in item in the Schedule of Quantities.
2. **Materials.**
 - (a) Providing extruded Built-Up Standards Aluminium Tubular Sections/appropriate Z Sections and other sections of approved make conforming to IS-733 & IS-1285.
 - (b) Float Glass Sheet of nominal thickness of 05mm in aluminium door and partitions etc. with PVC/Neoprene Gasket.
 - (c) 12mm thick pre-Laminated Particle Board with decorative lamination on both sides, Flat Pressed three layer or graded wood particle board conforming to IS-12823 Grade-I Type-II, in paneling fixed in Aluminium doors, Window Shutters and partition frame with stainless steel screws etc., complete as per directions of Engineer-in-Charge.
3. **Temporary Protection.** All entrances shall be without thresholds. All aluminium surfaces in contact with masonry shall be given a thick coat of bit mastic paint. After fabrication, Aluminium Sections shall be protected from construction hazards that may damage their appearance or finish. All exposed surfaces of Aluminium Doors/Windows entrance shall be protected by masking tape during transshipment and erection. The glass brought to site shall be protected against damage.
4. **Quality of Work.** Materials, tools and plants and workmanship shall be the best of the several kinds obtainable in the market and as approved by the Engineer. Rejected materials, if any, shall be removed from site as desired by the Engineer.
5. **Level Clean.** On completion, all the materials must be cleaned down, surplus materials/debris and other accumulations and everything left in a clean and orderly condition.
6. **Samples.** Samples of each class of materials required shall be submitted by the Contractor for the approval of the Engineer, and after such approval, these samples shall be deposited at a place chosen by the Engineer. The Contractor will be required to perform all work under this contract in accordance with these approved samples.

Preamble

WHEREAS, the Principal/Owner has floated the Tender (NIT No.) (herein after refer red to as **“Tender/Bid”**) and intends to award, under laid down organizational procedure, contract for **Provision of Aluminium Mosquito Net with sliding Aluminium Windows in all corridors of Hospital Complex, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar**, hereinafter referred to as the **“Contract”**.

AND WHEREAS the Principal/Owner values full compliance with all relevant laws of the Land, Rules & Regulations, Economic use of resources and of fairness/ transparency in its relation with its Bidder(s) and Contractor(s).

AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose afore said both the parties have agreed to enter to this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as **“Pact”**), the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part and parcel of the Tender/Bid documents and Contract between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, inconsideration of mutual covenants contained in this Pact, the parties hereby agree as follows and this Pact witnesses as under :-

Article - 1 : Commitment of the Principal/Owner.

1. The Principal/Owner commit itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:

(a) No employee of the Principal/Owner, personally or through any of his/her family members, will in connection with the Tender, or the execution of the Contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.

(b) The Principal/Owner will, during the Tender process, treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal/Owner will, in particular, before and during the Tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential/additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the Tender processor the Contract execution.

(c) The Principal/Owner shall endeavor to exclude from the Tender process any person, whose conduct in the past has been of biased nature.

2. If the Principal/Owner obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the Indian Penal Code (IPC)/Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (P C Act) or is in violation of the principles herein mentioned or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can also initiate disciplinary actions as per its internal laid down policies and procedures.

Article - 2 : Commitment of the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s)

1. It is required that each Bidder/Contractor (including their respective officers, employees and agents) adhere to the highest ethical standard and makes, and report to the Government/Department all suspected acts of **fraud or corruption or Coercion or Collusion** of which it has knowledge or becomes aware, during the tendering process and throughout the negotiation or award of a contract.

2. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the Tender process and during the Contract execution :-

(a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of the Principal/Owner's employees involved in the Tender process or execution of the Contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind what so ever during the Tender process or during the execution of the Contract.

(b) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to cartelize in the bidding process.

(c) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act. Further the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not use improperly, (for the purpose of competition or personal gain), or pass on to others, any information or documents provided by the Principal/Owner as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.

(d) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the names and addresses of agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall disclose names and addresses of foreign agents/representatives, if any. Either the Indian agent on behalf of the foreign principal or the foreign principal directly could bid in a tender but not both. Further, in cases where an agent participate in a tender on behalf of one manufacturer, he shall not be allowed to quote on behalf of another manufacturer along with the first manufacturer in a subsequent/parallel tender for the same item.

(e) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to, or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the Contract.

3. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

4. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm indulge in fraudulent practice **means a willful misrepresentation or omission of facts or submission of fake/forged documents in order to induce public official to act in reliance thereof, with the purpose**

of obtaining unjust advantage by or causing damage to justified interest of others and/or to influence the procurement process to the detriment of the Government interests.

5. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm use Coercive Practices (means the act of obtaining something, compelling an action or influencing a decision through intimidation, threat or the use of force directly or indirectly, where potential or actual injury may befall upon a person, his/her reputation or property to influence their participation in the tendering process).

Article - 3 : Consequences of Breach.

Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal/Owner under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal/Owner shall have the following rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) and the Bidder/Contractor accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal/Owner's absolute right :-

1. If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s), either before award or during execution of Contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Article-2 above or in any other form, such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal/Owner after giving 14 days notice to the contractor shall have powers to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the Tender process or terminate/determine the Contract, if already executed or exclude the Bidder/Contractor from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/Owner. **Such exclusion may be in vigor for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.**

2. **Forfeiture of EMD/Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit :** If the Principal/Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Contractor has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article-3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit, Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder/Contractor.

3. **Criminal Liability :** If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder or Contractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Contractor which constitutes corruption within the meaning of IPC Act, or if the Principal/Owner has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

Article - 4 : Previous Transgression.

1. The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 05 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the Tender process.

2. If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the Tender process or action can be taken for banning of business dealings/holiday listing of the Bidder/Contractor as deemed fit by the Principal/Owner.

3. If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted/recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/ Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

1. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all sub-contractors a commitment in conformity with this Pact. The Bidder/Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Sub-contractors/sub-vendors.
2. The Principal/Owner will enter in to Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
3. The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process, from the Tender process.

Article - 6 : Duration of the Pact.

1. This Pact begins when both the parties have legally sign edit. It expires for the Contractor/Vendor 12 months after the completion of work under the contractor till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.
2. If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.

4. Should one or several provisions of this Pact turnout to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intensions.
