The Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar, invites E-Bids in Two Bid System (i.e. Technical/Documentary and Financial Bid) from eligible manufacturers, authorised distributors or dealers or any other agencies-authorised to quote through E-procurement solution portal of AIIMS Bhubaneswar (<https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) on mutually agreed terms and conditions and satisfactory performance for **Rate Contract for Supply of Drugs at AIIMS Bhubaneswar** as per the Specifications. The quantity may be increased or decreased as per requirement of the Institution.

The Bidder is expected to examine all Instructions, Terms and Conditions, Forms, and Specifications in the bidding document. The bid should be complete and in the prescribed format as per the requirement of the bid document. **The bid should not be conditional.** Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding document or submission of a bid not responsive to the bidding documents in all respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the bid.

The Procurement of goods and services under this tender will be regulated as per the applicable provision of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), order 2017 and revised order on 04.06.2020 and 16.09.2020 of MoC&I (DIPP), Govt. of India and the condition of prior turnover and prior experience may be relaxed for start-ups (as defined by Department for Industrial Policy and promotion) subject to meeting of quality& Technical Specification.

Therefore, bidders who are claiming to be regulated under the said order are to submit documentary evidence in support of their claim.

The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and AIIMS, Bhubaneswar will in no case be held responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

Section-I
INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS (ITB)

1.1 The Bidders must go through the complete Tender Document for details before submission of their Bids. The bid submitted by Bidder and all subsequent correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged between Bidder and the Procuring Entity shall be written in English or the Official Language. However, the language of any printed literature furnished by Bidder in connection with its bid may be written in any other language provided a translation accompanies the same in the bid language. For purposes of interpretation of the bid, translation in the language of the bid shall prevail. Instructions to Bidders shall form part of this bid document and consequent contract out of this bid.

1.2 The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and AIIMS, Bhubaneswar will in no case be held responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

1.3 Bid Validity: The validity of the Bid/ Tender Document shall be for **90 days** from the date of opening of the bid.

1.4 Bidder' Eligibility Criteria: Tender should be quoted only by the original manufacturer (OEM) or by their authorized distributor or selling agent. Bidder other than OEM shall submit a current authority letter from the original manufacturer concerned in the format given at “**Annexure-III**”. In cases where the manufacturer has submitted the bids, the bids of authorised dealer will not be considered.

1.4.1 The bidder must be a natural person, private entity, or public entity (State-owned enterprise or institution).

1.4.2 The bidder must not be a Joint Venture/ Consortium (an association of several persons, firms, or companies - hereinafter referred to as JV/C).

1.4.3 The bidder must not be insolvent, in receivership, bankrupt or being wound up, not have its affairs administered by a court or a judicial officer, not have its business activities suspended and must not be the subject of legal proceedings for any of these reasons.

1.4.4 The bidder must not be convicted (within three years preceding the last date of bid submission) or stand declared ineligible/ suspended/ blacklisted/ banned/ debarred by appropriate agencies of Government of India from participation in Tender Processes of all of its entities.

1.4.5 The bidder must not be of the near relations of executives of Procuring Entity involved in this Tender Process.

1.4.6 Any bidder having a conflict of interest, which substantially affects fair competition, shall not be eligible to bid in this tender. Bids found to have a conflict of interest shall be rejected as nonresponsive.

1.4.7 Any bidder (as defined in paragraph 6 of the Order No. F.No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23.07.2020 issued by Ministry of Finance Department of Expenditure Public Procurement Division) from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in

this tender if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as prescribed in the aforesaid order. Proof of such registration should be enclosed with the bid documents.

- 1.4.8 In case where the manufacturer has submitted the bid, the bids of its authorised dealer will not be considered and EMD will be returned.

1.5 Bidders' Qualification Criteria:

- 1.5.1 Bidder should be a manufacturer/ authorised distributor or dealer/ selling agent or any other agencies-authorised to quote.
- 1.5.2 The bidder should possess valid **Drug License** issued by the State Licensing Authority/Central Licensing Approving Authority (wherever applicable) of the respective Bidder.
- 1.5.3 **If the bidder is other than Manufacturer**, then the **Bidder** should have average minimum Turn Over of **Rs. 5 Crore or more over last (3) three financial years**. The proof of Turn-over is to be furnished in Annexure-IV certified by the Chartered Accountant and supported by audited Financial statements. The bidder also has to furnish the Turn over Certificate of the respective manufacturer (in Annexure-IV certified by the Chartered Accountant and supported by audited Financial statements) of the quoted drug which should have minimum Turn Over of Rs. 25 Crore (Rupees Twenty-five Crore) or more in each year during the last (3) three financial years.
- 1.5.4 **If the Bidder is a Manufacturer**, the **manufacturer** should have minimum Turn Over of **Rs. 25 Crore (Rupees Twenty-five Crore) or more in each year during the last (3) three financial years**. The proof of Turn-over is to be furnished by the Bidder in Annexure-IV certified by the Chartered Accountant and supported by audited Financial statements.
- 1.5.5 Bidder to produce **manufacturer's GMP & GLP Certificate** of the quoted Drugs.
- 1.5.6 The Bidders should submit manufacturer's **02(Two) years market standing Certificate** for the quoted item(s) issued by the licensing authority. This would not be applicable to new drugs, a certificate from the Drug Controller General (India) shall be required for all new drug formulations to this effect in Form-46 for exemption.
- 1.6 Bidders are required to quote strictly as per specification of the Drugs. Deviation if any to specification, must be brought out clearly giving deviation statement in **Annexure-VI**.

1.7 Earnest Money Deposit (Bid Security):

1.7.1 The bidder needs to submit **Bid Security** as mentioned above in the form of FDR (duly endorsed by the issuing bank in favour of AIIMS Bhubaneswar) or Bank Guarantee in favour of **"AIIMS Bhubaneswar"** valid for a period of 180 days issued by a scheduled commercial bank and its legible scanned copy must be uploaded in the E-Tendering Solution and Hard copy of the EMD should be submitted along with Technical Bid in the Tender Box kept in the Office of Sr. Procurement-cum Store Officer, Academic Block, AIIMS Bhubaneswar -751 019 on or before the Date and Time of Submission of e-Bid.

The FDR or BG submitted as EMD are subject to verification from the issuing bank before its acceptance. If at any time the said instrument is found to be fake or not as a valid banking instrument, the bidder submitting such instrument shall be black listed and shall be debarred from participating in future tenders of the Institute.

The EMD of the successful bidder shall be returned after the successful completion of the contract (in case of failure by the bidder, EMD will be forfeited) and in case of unsuccessful bidders, the same will be returned after award of the contract. **AIIMS, Bhubaneswar shall not pay any interest on EMD to any bidder.**

1.7.2 Exemption: Firms registered with NSIC (for sale of Medical Equipment/Instrument/Apparatus) are exempted from submission of EMD (subject to the financial limits indicated in the NSIC certificate). Govt. of India/State Government departments/Undertakings are also exempted from EMD. However, the respective departments/ firm have to submit the relevant certificate (NSIC etc.) and financial limit to avail this exemption.

1.7.3 Further, to enjoy the benefits as per Public Procurement Policy of MSEs Order, 2012, the firms/ units registered as MSME vendor, declaration of UAM (Udyog Aadhar Memorandum) number by the vendor on CPPP is mandatory. The documentary evidence in support of UAM number must be attached with the bid document.

1.8 Clarification of bidding documents :

The Tender Inviting Authority shall not be responsible for individually informing the prospective bidders for any notices published related to this bid. Bidders are requested to browse e-Tender portal or website of the Tender Inviting Authority for information/general notices/amendments to bid document etc. on a day to day basis till the bid is concluded before submission of bid.

A prospective bidder requiring any clarification of the bidding documents shall contact the purchaser in writing at the purchaser's e-mail address i.e. stokee_gagan@aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in & aso.dkmahana@aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in & spo@aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in . The purchaser will respond in writing (through e-mail) to any request for clarification, provided that such request is received not later than 10 (ten) days prior to the deadline for submission of bids.

1.9 Amendments in Bidding Documents :

(i) At any time prior to the dead line for submission of Bid, the Tender Inviting Authority may, for any reason, modify the bid document by amendment and publish it in e-tender portal, tender wizard and AIIMS, BBSR website

(ii) At any time till **7 (seven) days** before the deadline for submission of bids, the AIIMS Bhubaneswar may, for any reason, whether at own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the bidding document through amendment. All amendments will be uploaded on the website regularly. AIIMS, BBSR shall not be responsible to notify the amendments to individual bidders. All amendments by the AIIMS, BBSR till 7 (seven) days before the deadline for submission of bids, shall be binding on the participatory bidders.

Section-II
TWO BID SYSTEM AND CONDITIONS

- 2.1 Technical Bid:** All required documents are to be submitted/ uploaded online.
- 2.1.1** The bidder must submit a statement of quoted drugs with columns like Sl. No., Drug code (as per technical specification), Brand name (as per Manufacturer), Formulation of Drug, Strength of formulation, Packing size of drug (like vial, ampoule, bottle, strip, sachet etc. indicating quantity of the same) along with the technical bid neatly typed on letter head of the firm without mentioning price.
- 2.2 Financial Bid:** The Financial Bid to be submitted on line as per prescribed format in Section VII. The Financial Bid of bidders, who qualify in Technical Bid Evaluation, will be opened thereafter.
- 2.2.1** The Rates are to be quoted in the given format “Section-VII”.
- 2.2.2** All quoted rates should be inclusive of freight, packing, forwarding & insurance & Labour charges and also percentage of GST etc.
- 2.2.3** The rates should be quoted in Indian Rupees in figure as well as in words only.
- 2.2.4** If a firm quotes NIL charges/consideration, the bid shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered.
- 2.2.5** **L-1 will be decided item wise on the lowest price including GST of product** for which the bidder has quoted. GST has to be mentioned clearly in percentage for the product. (DSIR certificate is not applicable)
- 2.2.6** The price in the Financial Bid to be quoted strictly against formulation unit.
- 2.2.7** The Tender Evaluation Committee may also verify the veracity of claims in respect of known performance of the item(s) offered, experience and reputation of the bidder in the field, the financial solvency etc.
- 2.2.8** An offer submitted in vague/ambiguous financial terms and the like, shall be termed as non-responsive and shall summarily be rejected.
- 2.2.9 Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India/MSEs/Start-ups):**
- 2.2.9.1** The Procurement of goods and services under this tender will be regulated as per the applicable provisions of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), order 2017 of MoC&I (DIPP), Government of India and revised orders issued on 04.06.2020 & 16.09.2020. As per said orders Bidders/Contractors are divided into three categories based on Local Content. Local content in the context of this policy is the total value of the item procured (excluding net domestic indirect taxes) minus the value of imported content in the item (including all customs duties) as a proportion of the total value, in percent.:
- a) 'Class-I Local Supplier' with local content equal to or more than 50%.
 - b) 'Class-II Local Supplier' with local content equal to or more than 20%, but less than that applicable for Class-I Local Supplier.
 - c) 'Non - Local Supplier' with local content less than that applicable for Class-II local Supplier, in (b) above.
- The 'Class-I Local Supplier'/ 'Class-II Local Supplier' at the time of bidding shall be required to indicate the percentage of local content and provide self-certification that the item offered meets the local content requirement for 'Class-I Local Supplier'/ 'Class-II Local Supplier', as the case may be.
- Bids with false declarations regarding Local contents shall be rejected as unresponsive, in addition to punitive actions under the MII orders and for violating the Code of Integrity as per the Tender Document.
- Bidders have to submit self-declaration of their local content and their status as Class-I/ Class-II/ Non-local Supplier and their eligibility to participate in this tender.

If a Bidder is claiming exemption (as obtained from relevant authorities) from meeting the stipulated local content on account of manufacturing the product in India under a license from a foreign manufacturer with the precise phasing of increase in local content, he must provide proof thereof.

2.2.9.2 Purchase preference as per Make in India will be exercised as follows:

(a) If the Goods are not divisible in nature:

Among all qualified bids, the lowest bid shall be termed as L-1. If L-1 is 'Class-I Local Supplier' (Under MII clause at 1.12.1), the contract shall be awarded to L-1.

If L-1 is not 'Class-I Local Supplier', the lowest bidder among the 'Class-I Local Supplier' shall be invited to match the L-1 price subject to Class-I Local Supplier's quoted price falling within the margin of purchase preference, and the contract shall be awarded to such 'Class-I Local Supplier' subject to matching the L-1 price.

If such lowest eligible 'Class-I local Supplier' fails to match the L-1 price, the 'Class-I local Supplier' with the next higher and so on, bid within the margin of purchase preference shall be invited to match the L-1 price, and the contract shall be awarded accordingly. If none of the 'Class-I local Supplier' within the margin of purchase preference matches the L-1 price, the contract shall be awarded to the L-1 bidder.

(b) If the Goods are divisible in nature:

Among all qualified bids, the lowest bid shall be termed as L-1. If L-1 is 'Class-I local Supplier', the contract for full quantity shall be awarded to L-1.

If the L-1 bid is not a 'Class-I local Supplier', 50% of the order quantity shall be awarded to L-1. After that, the lowest bidder among the 'Class-I local Supplier' whose quoted price falls within the margin of purchase preference shall be invited to match the L-1 price for the remaining 50% quantity, and a contract for that quantity shall be awarded to him, subject to matching the L-1 price. In case such lowest eligible 'Class-I local Supplier' fails to match the L-1 price or accepts less than the offered quantity, the next higher 'Class-I local Supplier' within the margin of purchase preference shall be invited to match the L-1 price for the remaining quantity and so on, and the contract shall be awarded accordingly. If some quantity is still left uncovered on Class-I local Suppliers, such balance quantity shall also be ordered on the L-1 bidder.

(c) Where contract is to be awarded to multiple bidders:

In Bids where contracts are to be awarded to multiple bidder's subject to matching of L-1 rates or otherwise, the 'Class-I Local Supplier' shall get purchase preference over 'Class-II Local Supplier' as well as 'Non-Local Supplier', as per following procedure:

If there is sufficient local capacity and competition for the item to be procured, as notified by the nodal Ministry, only Class I Local Suppliers shall be eligible to bid. As such, the multiple Contractors, who would be awarded the contract, should be all and only 'Class I Local Suppliers'.

In Bids, other than the sufficient local capacity and competition for the item to be procured, 'Class II local Suppliers' or both 'Class II local Suppliers' and 'Nonlocal Suppliers' may also participate in the tender process along with 'Class I Local Suppliers'.

If 'Class I Local Suppliers' qualify for the contract award for at least 50% of the tendered quantity in tender, the contract shall be awarded to all the qualified bidders as per award criteria stipulated in the Tender Documents. However, in case 'Class I Local Suppliers' do not qualify for the award of contract for at least 50% of the tendered quantity as per award criteria, purchase preference should be given to the 'Class I local Supplier' over 'Class II Local Suppliers'/'Non-local Suppliers' provided that their quoted rate falls within the margin of purchase preference of the highest bid considered for award of contract. To ensure that the 'Class I Local Suppliers' taken in totality are considered for award of contract for at least 50% of the tendered quantity.

First purchase preference has to be given to the lowest among such eligible 'Class-I local Suppliers', subject to its meeting the prescribed criteria for the award of contract as also the constraint of the maximum quantity that can be sourced from any single Contractor. If the lowest among such 'Class-I local Suppliers'

does not qualify for purchase preference because of aforesaid constraints or does not accept the offered quantity, an opportunity shall be given to next higher among such 'Class-I local Supplier', and so on.

To avoid any ambiguity during bid evaluation process, the procuring entity may stipulate its own tender specific criteria for award of contract amongst different bidders including the procedure for purchase preference to 'Class-I Local supplier' within the broad policy guidelines.

- 2.2.9.3 This tender will also be regulated under Public Procurement Policy for the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 as amended from time to time and Start-up Bidders under Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division OM No F.20\212014-PPD dated 25.07.2016 and subsequent clarifications. The condition of prior turnover and prior experience may be relaxed for start-ups (as defined by Department for Industrial Policy & Promotion) subject to meeting of quality & technical specifications. Therefore, bidders who are claiming to be regulated under the said order are to submit documentary evidence in support of their claim.

2.2.9.4 **Procurement outside GeM:**

As per the Circular No. F.6/18/2019-PPD issued by Ministry of Finance , Dept of Expenditure dated 23 Jan 20 and DO No.214/CEO-GeM/2020 dated 10.11.2020 regarding procurement of goods/ services outside GeM, bidders are required to submit documents in support of their registration with GeM i.e., Unique GeM Seller Id. with their bid. However, the bidder who is not registered with GeM at the time of submitting the tender needs to submit an undertaking on firm's letter head that GeM seller Id. will be provided at the time of award of contract positively failing which their contract will be treated as null & void and will be dealt suitably.

An undertaking also to be given in company letter head that **"Such already registered suppliers should be boarded on GeM as and when the item or service gets listed on GeM"**.

2.2.10 **Bid Opening:**

The Technical Bid will be opened as per schedule mentioned in E-Tender Schedule. The bidder(s) or their authorised representative(s) may remain present at the scheduled date and time. In case the scheduled date is declared Holiday, the tender shall be opened on next working day at same time.

2.2.11 **Evaluation of Bid :**

The bid will be evaluated as per the documents asked in this bid and contract will be awarded to the bidder who has quoted lowest price including GST for the drugs on each drug basis (each line wise).

Award of Bid will be guided as per Purchase preference clause under Make in India as mentioned under para 2.2.9 above.

Section-IV
GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- 4.1 Validity of Tender:** The validity of the Bid Tender Document shall be for **90(Ninety) days from date of opening.**
- 4.2 Rate Contract:** The contract arising out of this tender will be known as Rate contract for supply of common drugs to AIIMS Bhubaneswar. The contract will be initially for a period of ONE year and will/may be extendable for another one year on mutually agreeable conditions, subject to satisfactory performance of the contract. No minimum quantity is assured for procurement and procurement of drugs will be made and order will be placed to the successful bidders as per requirement of the Institute.
- 4.3 Fall Clause:** If at any time during the execution of the Purchase Order/Contract, the price of the subject item is reduced or brought down by any law or Act of the Central or state Govt. OR the Manufacturers reduces the sale price or sells or offers to sell such stores, as are covered under the contract, to any person/organization including the purchaser or any department of Central Government or any department of AIIMS Bhubaneswar/PSUs at a price lower than the price chargeable under the PO/contract during the Current Financial Year, he shall forthwith notify AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, The necessary difference amount about such reduction or sale or offer of sale to the purchaser and the price payable under the contract for the stores supplied after the date of coming into force of such reduction or sale or offer of sale shall stand correspondingly reduced and deposited to AIIMS Bhubaneswar by the Bidder or AIIMS Bhubaneswar will deduct from the pending bills/Performance Security Deposit to recover the loss to the Government.
- 4.4** The supply of **Drugs as per list** should be of required quality/ standard as per specification, having useful life as specified in this tender and supply should be made in good condition to the Central stores, AIIMS, BBSR by the bidder at their own cost i.e., F.O.R.at AIIMS Bhubaneswar. Any spurious/ to be expired/ sub-standard item has to be replaced by the bidder without any fail at their own cost.
- If the supplier, having been notified, fails to respond to take action to replace the sub-standard items within 3 (three) days on a 24 x 7 x 365 basis, the purchaser may proceed to take such remedial action(s) as deemed fit by the purchaser, at the risk and expense of the supplier and without prejudice to other contractual rights and remedies, which the purchaser may have against the supplier.
- 4.5 Delivery of supplies/Stores:** Delivery of stores shall be F.O.R to Central Store, AIIMS Bhubaneswar. The AIIMS Bhubaneswar is not liable for payments on account of Freight/Taxes/ allied expenditures, which are to be quoted inclusively by the suppliers.
- 4.5.1** The firm will be bound to supply the ordered items within **30 days of issuance of purchase order.** Extension shall not be allowed in ordinary course, except in cases of any natural calamities, All India Transportation strike (with sufficient proof). Any other genuine case of request of extension may be considered/allowed (subject to approval from Competent Authority) provided that the request is received within due date.
- 4.5.2** The supplier shall supply the materials along with copy of Invoice, Purchase Order, Test Report, Delivery Challan and other relevant documents at the Central Stores, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. The quantity supplied shall be in terms of the Units mentioned in the Tender Document/ PO. *The suppliers are cautioned that the variation in the description of product in the Invoice/analysis report and actual supplies will be considered as improper invoicing and will be dealt accordingly.*

- 4.5.3 If the supplier fails to deliver the goods on or before the stipulated date, then Liquidated damage(LD) charges at the rate of 0.5%per week or part there of shall be levied subject to maximum of 10%of the total order value. Purchaser may also resort to termination of the Purchase Order & even contract at any time after expiry of the allowable period for supply of the materials. The competent authority of the institute may also cancel the supply. In such a case, bid security of the supplier shall stand forfeited.
- 4.5.4 Part/Partial supply will not be accepted. However, in special circumstances, part supply may be accepted as per the institutional requirement with prior written permission and total delivery is to be completed within stipulated delivery period. The Part billing is strictly prohibited.
- 4.5.5 In case the quality of drugs supplied are not in conformity with the standard given in tender or the supplies are found substandard at any stage these goods shall immediately will be taken back by the supplier and will be replaced with the tender quality goods, without any delay. The competent authority reserves all rights to reject the goods if the same are not found in accordance with the required description/specifications and liquidates damages shall be charged.
- 4.5.6 In case the bidder on whom the purchase order has been placed, fails to make supplies within the delivery schedule and the purchaser has to resort risk purchase, the purchaser (AIIMS, Bhubaneswar) may recover from the bidder the difference between the cost calculated on the basis of risk purchase price and that calculated on the basis of rates quoted by bidder. The amount will be recovered from any of his subsequent/pending bills or Security Deposit & black listing of the firm may be initiated depending upon the circumstances of the default/merit of the case.
- 4.5.7 At the time of delivery, the drugs should have shelf life span of **at least 02 years or 75% before the date of expiry whichever is more from the date of supply**. And following text shall be printed or stamped in inedible ink on label/pack/cartoon “ **NOT FOR SALE, FOR USE BY AIIMS, BHUBANESWAR ONLY**”.
- 4.5.8 If the L-1 is a manufacturer, no frequent changes of distributor to be ensured and if such situation arises, then OEM/manufacturer must take the responsibility and supply to maintain the uninterrupted patient care service at this hospital.
- 4.6 **Payments:** 100% payment shall be released after successful delivery of the ordered goods against the satisfactory inspection report/taking charge report by the User Dept. and only after the submission of the performance security duly confirmed by issuing bank, within to 30 to 45 days subject to availability of funds.
- 4.6.1 Bills in triplicate for the items supplied by the selected firm(s), should be raised for payment. Payment shall be released after deducting TDS as per Income Tax Rules and any other deductions as per Government rules only after it is ensured that the items/quantity and quality of items supplied are to the entire satisfaction of this office and accepted. If any item is found to be sub-standard, or not of the desired quality at any point of time of the contract period, the same shall be replaced immediately, for which no extra payment shall be made by AIIMS Bhubaneswar.
- 4.6.2 The bills raised by the selected Bidder should have all tax registration numbers printed on bill. The bill shall be signed by the authorized signatory of the firm across a revenue stamp. Validity of the tax registration during the currency of contract shall be the sole responsibility of the tendering eligible Manufacturers. The bill shall be raised indicating permissible taxes separately and the copies of proof of GST or other applicable taxes deposited to Tax Authorities by the firm for recent period, just before the submission of Bills must also be enclosed for reference of AIIMS Bhubaneswar authorities.

- 4.7 The Bidder shall be bound by the details furnished by him/her to the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS)Bhubaneswar while submitting the tender or at subsequent stage. Upon selection of the Bidder, if at any stage, the documents furnished by him/her is found to be false or the quality of the articles are found of poor quality/different specifications, it would be deemed to be a breach of terms of contract, the contract shall be cancelled, legal action as deemed fit will be taken and performance security shall stand forfeited.
- 4.8 The selected firm(s) shall not be allowed to transfer, assign, pledge or sub-contract its rights and the contract will be valid from the date it is awarded/formalities completed. This office will, however, reserve the right to conduct performance review at any time during the contract period and deficiencies, if any, noticed shall be required to be rectified and compliance reported. This office reserves the right to suo-moto terminate the contract by giving one month's notices at any point of time.
- 4.9 The supplied drug should have life span of at least 2 years or 75% of shelf life from the date of acceptance. However, in exceptional cases the drugs with lower expiry may be accepted subject to approval of Competent Authority.
- 4.10 The AIIMS Bhubaneswar shall not be responsible for any financial loss or other damage or injury to any item or person deployed/supplied by the Supplier Agency in the course of their performing the duties to this office in connection with purchase order/purchase order for supplying of Stores/Goods/Items at AIIMS Bhubaneswar.
- 4.11 **Law governing the contract and Jurisdiction:** -The contract shall be governed under Indian Contract Act 1872 and instructions thereon from the government of India. The Court of Bhubaneswar shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract.
- 4.12 **Performance Security Deposit:** -The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Security Deposit of 3% of the value of Purchase Order (Subject to change as per Govt. Order) in favour of "AIIMS Bhubaneswar" by way of "Irrevocable Performance Bank Guarantee or Fixed Deposit Receipt" (in favour of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar) from Nationalized/Commercial Bank which is refundable. The performance security shall remain valid for a period of **14 months** from the date of contract agreement. Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or impairs or derogates the bid in any respect.
- 4.13 Conditional Bids will be treated as unresponsive and therefore shall be rejected.
- 4.14 The Institute reserves the right to accept in part or in full or reject any or more Tender/offer without assigning any reasons or cancel the tendering process and reject all Tender at any time prior to award of contract, without accepting any liability, whatsoever.
- 4.15 The Bidder shall be responsible for properly uploading the relevant documents in the e-Tender portal in the specific location and the Tender Inviting Authority shall not be held liable for errors or mistakes done while uploading the on-line Bid.
- 4.16 **Force Majeure :** If, at any time during the subsistence of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any war or hostility, act of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fire, floods, exception, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockout or act of God (hereinafter referred to as events) provided notice of happening of any such eventuality is given by party to other within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof. Neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and deliveries have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive.
Further, that if the performance in whole or in part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days, AIIMS, BBSR may, opt to terminate the contract.
- 4.17 **Debarment from bidding:**
- 4.17.1 A bidder shall be debarred if he has been convicted of an offence-
- under the Prevention of Corruption Act,1988 or

- the Indian Penal Code or any other law for the time being in force, for causing any loss of life or property or causing a threat to public health as part of execution of a public procurement contract.
- 4.17.2** A bidder debarred under sub-section 6.29.1 or any successor of the bidder shall not be eligible to participate in a procurement process of any procuring entity for a period not exceeding three years commencing from the date of debarment if it Misrepresents facts or submit fabricated / forged / tampered / altered / manipulated documents/ Withdraws bid after the opening of technical bid/ Fails to furnish performance security and agreement within 10 days of issuance of Letter of Award. Department of Commerce will maintain such list which will also be displayed on the website of Central Public Procurement Portal.
- 4.17.3** A procuring entity may debar a bidder or any of its successors, from participating in any procurement process undertaken by it, for a period not exceeding two years, if it determines that the bidder has breached the code of integrity. The Ministry/Department will maintain such list which will also be displayed on their website.
- 4.17.4** The bidder shall not be debarred unless such bidder has been given a reasonable opportunity to represent against such debarment.
- 4.18 Code of Integrity:**
- 4.18.1** No official of the bidder shall act in contravention of the codes which includes prohibition of
- a) making offer, solicitation or acceptance of bribe, reward or gift or any material benefit, either directly or indirectly, in exchange for an unfair advantage in the procurement process or to other wise influence the procurement process.
 - b) any omission, or misrepresentation that may mislead or attempt to mislead so that financial or other benefit may be obtained or an obligation avoided.
 - c) any collusion, bid rigging or anti-competitive behaviour that may impair the transparency, fairness and the progress of the procurement process.
 - d) Improper use of information provided by the procuring entity to the bidder with an intent to gain unfair advantage in the procurement process or for personal gain.
 - e) any financial or business transactions between the bidder and any official of the procuring entity related to tender or execution process of contract; which can affect the decision of the procuring entity directly or indirectly.
 - f) any coercion or any threat to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or its property to influence the procurement process.
 - g) obstruction of any investigation or auditing of a procurement process.
 - h) making false declaration or providing false information for participation in a tender process or to secure a contract.
 - i) disclosure of conflict of interest.
 - j) Disclosure by the bidder of any previous transgressions made in respect of the provisions of sub-clause with any entity in any country during the last three years or of being debarred by any other procuring entity.
- 4.18.2** The purchaser will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, Fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question.
- 4.19** The Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar, Odisha, India has the full and exclusive right to accept or reject, increase or decrease order quantity, any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof and also to cancel the supply at any time without assigning any reason.

4.20 Disputes & Arbitration: -All disputes or differences arising during the execution of the contract shall be resolved by mutual discussion, failing which the matter will be referred to an Arbitrator who will be appointed by the Director, AIIMS Bhubaneswar for Arbitration for settlement of disputes in accordance with Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 or its subsequent amendment, whose decision shall be binding on the contracting parties.

E-TENDERING INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

Instructions for Online Bid Submission:

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

1. REGISTRATION ON CPP PORTAL:

1.1 Bidders are required to enrol on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link “**Online bidder Enrolment**” on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.

1.2 As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.

1.3 Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.

1.4 Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.

1.5 Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC’s to others which may lead to misuse.

1.6 Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

2. SEARCHING FOR TENDER ENQUIRY DOCUMENT

2.1 There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.

2.2 Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective „My Tenders“ folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.

2.3 The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

3. PREPARATION OF BIDS

3.1 Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.

3.2 Please go through the tender advertisement and the Tender Enquiry Document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.

3.3 Bidder, in advance, should get ready the documents/BoQ to be uploaded as indicated in the Tender Enquiry Document and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Scanned documents to be uploaded may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document and resulting in fast uploading. It is the responsibility of the bidder to ensure that uploaded scanned documents are legible.

3.4 To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use "My Space" or "Other Important Documents" area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the "My Space" area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

4. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

4.1. Submission of Bids

4.1.1 Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.

4.1.2 The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the Tender Enquiry document.

4.1.3 Bidder has to select the payment option as "offline" to pay the Bid Security/ EMD as applicable and enter details of the instrument.

4.1.4 Bidder should prepare the Bid Security/EMD as per the instructions specified in the Tender Enquiry Document. The original should be posted/couriered/given in person to the concerned official, latest by the last date of bid submission or as specified in the Tender Enquiry Document. The details of the DD/any other accepted instrument, physically sent, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time. Otherwise the uploaded bid will be rejected.

4.1.5 Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BoQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BoQ file, open it and complete the white coloured (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details

have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BoQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.

4.1.6 The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.

5. All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid openers' public keys. Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

1) The uploaded Tender/Bid shall become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

2) Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (ie after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.

3) The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.

BETWEEN

M/s. _____, having its registered office at _____ (hereinafter called the '**Vendor**' which expression unless repugnant to the context shall mean and include its successors-in-interest assigns etc.) of the **Second Party**.

WHEREAS the '**Client**' is desirous to engage the '**Vendor**' for supplying **Common Drugs** on Rate Contract basis for AIIMS Bhubaneswar as per the terms and conditions stated below: -

1. **Period of Rate Contract:** The Rate contract shall be valid for one year from the date of execution of the contract by the firm. The contract may be extendable, subject to maximum period of 01 (One) year, on the same terms and conditions or with some addition/deletion/modification as mutually agreed upon by the Second Party and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Bhubaneswar.

2. The Vendor's services would be required to provide /supply of **Common Drugs** for All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Bhubaneswar through self or through its local authorized agency/stockiest/distributor M/s. _____, having Registered address at _____ & GSTIN No. _____ as and when required against a confirmed Purchase Order as per terms and conditions mentioned therein.

3. Order for items shall be placed on requirement basis and have to be delivered within the delivery period mentioned in the PO. Delivery of the ordered items shall be made on all working days between 09:30 A.M. to 05:30 P.M. (Monday to Friday). On Saturdays the delivery time shall be from 09:30 A.M. to 01:00 P.M. No separate charges for delivery of goods would be paid by the client. Part supply is prohibited. However, in exceptional circumstances part supply may be made with genuine reasons and prior intimation to Stores and Purchase Section. Part Billing is strictly prohibited. Bills in triplicate along with the bank details of the R/c holder/Agency/Authorized Dealers should be raised for payment.
