Training program for Nurses on Management of Substance Use Disorder

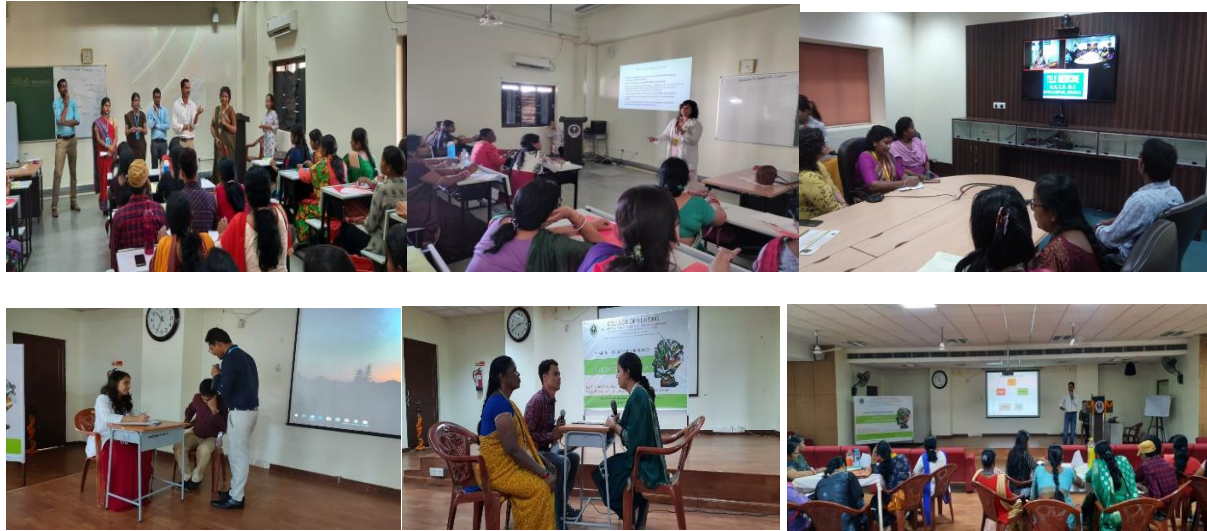

WORKSHOP REPORT

Training programme for Nurses on “Management of Substance Use Disorder” was conducted under the aegis of MOH&FW, GOI, under the scheme “Development of Nursing Services” Training of Nurses (Plan) for the year 2019-20. Nurses from AIIMS Bhubaneswar and various districts of Odisha attended this workshop. Registration and Pretest for the workshop was conducted for the participants before the commencement of the inauguration ceremony. The program was inaugurated by the Chief guest Dr. Gitanjali Batmanabane, Director AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. Guest of honor Dr. Sushil Kumar Kar, Director of Nursing, Odisha, Guest of Honor, Dr Asha P Shetty, Principal, College of Nursing, Dr. Sachidananda Mohanty, Medical Superintendent, AIIMS Bhubaneswar, Mr. P K Ray, DDA, AIIMS Bhubaneswar and Dr. Susanta Kumar Padhy, HOD Psychiatry, AIIMS Bhubaneswar addressed the gathering.



Scientific sessions of first two days were focused on sensitizing the delegates about the basic concepts of addiction, assessment and diagnosis of substance use disorder, conducting brief intervention and motivation enhancement therapy. Dr Shree Mishra, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Psychiatry, Mr Nandakumar Paniyadi, Asst Prof, College of Nursing, Dr Debadutta Mohapatra Asst. Professor, SUM Hospital deliberated the sessions. Video conferencing sessions were conducted with the nurses and mental health team of city hospital, Berhampur.



Third day sessions focused on management of alcohol dependence syndrome, sessions were handled by Dr Santanu Nath, Asst.Prof, Dept. of Psychiatry and Dr Renju Sussan Baby, Associate Professor, College of Nursing. Skill training sessions on management of alcohol withdrawal and seizures were conducted in the afternoon session.



Scientific sessions on fourth day focused on handling patients with opioid dependence syndrome, dual diagnosis and relapse prevention by Dr Russel Raven, Dr Tanay Maiti and Dr Susanta Kumar Padhy, HOD Dept. of Psychiatry, AIIMS. Dr Renju Sussan Baby taught about disulfiram counseling and handling violent behavior and de-escalation techniques. Fifth day sessions focused on handling cannabis dependence syndrome, nicotine dependence and behavioral addiction. sessions were handled by Dr Jitendra Biswal, SUM hospital, Dr Saurin Bhunia,

Pulmonologist, Dr Idrees, Dr Samapika Routray, and Dr BR Mishra, Dr Suravi Patro, consultant Psychiatrist, AIIMS BBSR.



Sixth day session focused on legal aspects of substance use, substance use and its effects on pregnancy, substance related emergency management handling craving in inpatient setup and prevention of SUD in Community. The sessions were taken by Dr Sudipta Ranjan Singh, forensic medicine, Dr Sweta Singh, dept of OBG, Dr Jigyasa Ipsita, Dr Sritam Jena, emergency medicine and Dr Manish Taywade, CMFM.



During the last day of the workshop a skit competition was conducted for the delegates on the theme “Role of Nurse in Management of Substance Use Disorder” which had 7 teams, each team had 6 members. During the valedictory session Dr Sushil Kumar Kar, Director of Nursing
